CHAPTER ONE: INTRODUCTION

1.1 County Background Information

Makueni County is one of the forty-seven (47) counties in Kenya that was established pursuant to Article 176(1) of Kenya Constitution,2010 with functions and powers outlined under Schedule 4 of the Kenya Constitution,2010. It is situated in South Eastern part of the Country and borders Machakos to the North, Kitui to the East, Kajiado to the West, and Taita Taveta to the South. It is located between Latitude 1° 35′ south and Longitude 37°10′ east and 38° 30. It covers an area of 8,176.7 KM² with a population density of 121 persons per square kilometer.

According to Kenya National Population and Housing Census of 2019, the County has a population of 987,653 comprising of 489,691 males and 497,942 females.

The County is administratively divided into six sub-counties (6) which are also the parliamentary constituencies namely Makueni, Mbooni, Kibwezi East, Kibwezi West, Kaiti and Kilome. The six sub-counties are further delimited into 30 wards and 60 sub wards.

1.2 The Legal Framework for Participatory Budgeting

Public participation is a constitutional requirement in the County Governance. Article 1 of the Constitution of Kenya,2010 states that sovereign power belongs to the people and in Article 10 (2) (a) and the Fourth Schedule Part 2 (14) of the Constitution of Kenya,2010 public participation is stipulated as a function of the County Government. Section 115 (1) and Section 87 of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012 also provides that citizen participation in county processes as mandatory and principles of citizen participation in Counties. Section 184 of Urban Areas and Cities Act,2012 provides for participation by residents in the governance of urban areas and cities.

Sections 125 (2) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 outlines that the County Executive Committee Member for Finance shall ensure that there is public participation in the budget process.

Public participation in the budgeting process leads to allocation of resources to community priority projects and programs thus attributing to sustainable development

1.3 Objectives Of 2024/25 Budget Public Participation

The budget participation objectives were to;

- a) To facilitate community feedback on projects and programs implemented in FY 2022/23 & 2023/24 budgets as a basis for equity and prioritization of FY 2024/25 budget.
- b) Mapping of development partners implementing projects in the County.
- c) Prioritization interventions and projects/programs linked CIDP III, ADP 2024/25, development tours and Sector working groups reports
- d) Enhancing the public participation quality and legitimacy

1.4 FY2024/25 Budget Participation Guiding Principles

The participation and identification of projects for FY 2024/25 budget was guided by the following principles;

- **a) Equity and Social Justice.** The facilitators ensured priority projects reduced disparities, addressed inequalities, and promoted inclusivity. The identification of projects and resource allocation ensured that there was equity in the two sub wards.
- **b) High Impact Project.** Facilitators and technical officers ensured communities prioritized high impact projects which have high number of beneficiaries, high economic or social gains or high ripple effect.
- c) **Technical Guidance.** The technical advice of the officers both at the HQ, Sub County and Ward level emphasized and encouraged before the final submission of budget estimates. The key sectors were facilitated by technical officers.
- **d) Aligning with the Government priorities.** The County Government FY2024/25 main focus areas were:
 - a. Increase access to potable water.
 - b. Increased agricultural production and food security.
 - c. Enhance access to universal healthcare.
 - d. Develop urban infrastructure.
 - e. Automate government services, procedures and innovation.
 - f. Mobilize resources through strategic partnerships

CHAPTER TWO: 2024/25 BUDGET PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

2.1 Public Participation Approach

The public participation of the FY 2024/25 introduces a new paradigm emerging from the review of our county public participation model. The Paradigm demonstrates improvements in the model of public participation informed by challenges, lessons learnt and opportunities in the county practice of public participation for development/Devolved Service Delivery.

2.2 Linkages Between County Plans and Budgets

The Public while prioritizing key interventions and projects were guided by CIDP III, ADP 2024/25 and CFSP development focus areas as follows:

- 1. Promotion of water agenda through last mile water infrastructure programme across all wards to address water shortages and promote irrigation farming.
- 2. Agricultural value chain development to ensure support economic livelihoods.
- 3. Promotion of comprehensive health coverage by Upgrading (Remodeling) 6 rural health facilities to provide 24-hour healthcare services and implement the universal and primary health care programme

- 4. Focus on phased and underfunded projects in FY 2023/24 which also considers ongoing underfunded projects.
- 5. Alignment of strategic projects to conditional allocations and grants
- 6. Mobilization of resources for Appropriation in Aid through major SAGAs and Healthcare insurances and UHC registration.

- 2. The fora will provide avenue for linking community needs and interventions prioritized during CIDP III public participation fora.
- 3. The forums will provide a large audience for the County Government to disseminate information and feedback on the programmes and projects that have been implemented since August 2022.
- 4. County statistical data is disintegrated per sub-locations and therefore this ensures evidence-based decision making on priority interventions.
- 5. The participation at the cluster block level will lead to improved equity of County Government resources in the wards.

2.9 Mapping of Key Development Partners

At the 256 cluster blocks participation, the participants guided by the facilitators mapped 291 projects/interventions being implemented by the development partners that are complete and ongoing in different sectors namely; Water, Agriculture, Education, Health, Environment, Trade. The detailed report is annexed in this report as ANNEX **5.7.**

2.10 Community Feedback on FY 2022/23 & 2023/24 Projects

The community gave the following feedback on the FY 2022/23 & 2023/24 budget projects;

- Projects be implemented in public lands or private lands legally transferred to the community to avoid land conflicts which delay project implementation e.g Kamuthini water kiosk
- ii. Many of the projects allocated funds have not started and therefore county departments should fastrack implementation and
- iii. Ensure drainage structures and gravelling especially in the road improvement programme
- iv. Ensure timely provision of funds to support programmes such as sports; eg teams that participated in ligi mashinani are yet to be paid.
- v. Timely implementation of projects
- vi. There was inadequate involvement of citizens in selection of beneficiaries for soft programs and projects implemented.
- vii. The community feedback forums should be adequate and timely.
- viii. There is delay in implementation of projects with allocated funds by some county department
- ix. PWDs should be given a special kit from the ward allocation for mapping and registration of the groups
- x. All feeder roads were not graded within the Wote/Nziu ward
- xi. Proposals given by the community were interfered with and in future budget estimates should be done based on proposals
- xii. There was no equity in allocation of resources across the sub ward (Kalawa)
- xiii. underfunding of some projects and programmes by departments
- xiv. Some contractors have deserted project sites after site handover eg Kakuswi CTTI.
- xv. Complete projects should be commissioned and handover to the communities
- xvi. Reported low turnout during vaccination of dogs
- xvii. There is still vandalism of county project eg Kwa Nthii water project
- xviii. Change of projects proposed during the budget making process at the assembly validation forums thus leading to low turnout as their proposals are short changed.
- xix. No flagship project in the Kibwezi East sub county. There was proposed construction of wards at kambu sub county hospital
- xx. High cost of ambulance services to the Community.
- xxi. Itumbule resource centre to be converted to an ECDE centre
- xxii. Sports money to be reviewed for proper management
- xxiii. Low enrolment in the county ECDEs.
- xxiv. Inequality in distribution of resources
