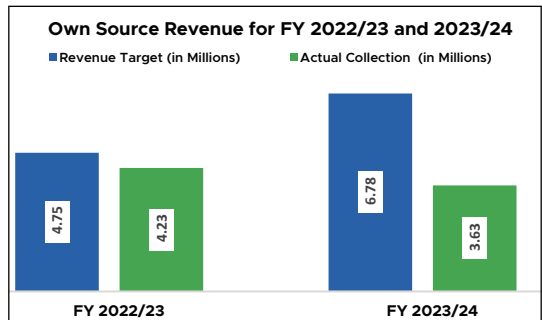
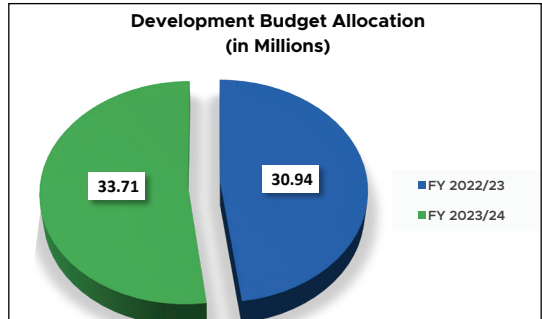
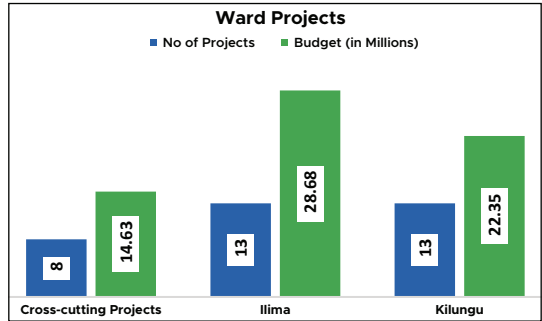

## MILESTONES



### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

#### Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Infrastructural developments at Kyambeke and Kavatanzou Health Centers, with monthly workloads of 2,500 and 650 patients, respectively.
- Conducting 2 outreach campaigns which include Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and medical outreach within the wards
- Engagement of 161 community health promoters in offering primary health care



### PUBLIC SANITATION

#### Promoted sanitation through : -

- Construction of toilets at Wautu and Kyambekele markets
- Market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 10 markets.



### AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

#### In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed 306 bags of organic fertilizer to 314 beneficiaries to cushion on high cost of farm inputs.
- vaccinated 3,254 livestock in FY 2023/24, benefiting 909 households, and 2,554 livestock in FY 2022/23, benefiting 514 households, as part of efforts to enhance disease surveillance and control.
- Facilitated the formation and registration of Ilima Ward SACCO, which received a grant of KSh 1 million under the NAVCDP program
- Supported 51 groups with chicks, poultry feeds, and incubators to enhance productivity, under NARIG program.



## ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

### Enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 66 km of road, grading 107.2km and gravelling 1.5Km across the ward
- Installation of drainage structures; 98m of culverts, 38 gabion boxes and 23 scour checks which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season
- Installation of 673m cut off meter drains, implemented through Miradi Kwa Jamii as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure, improving agricultural production and creating job opportunities for 500 community members.
- Installation of Kyambeke market flood light enhancing security and extended trading hours.



## WATER ACCESS

### The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across Ukia ward through the following: -

- Desilting of Kwa matolo earth dam benefiting approximately 400 households
- Further distribution of Kyakithuku borehole which has a yield of 12m<sup>3</sup>/Hr to Kyamanza market, Kyakithuku market and Kyakithuku primary school. Benefits approximately 1,000 households.
- Construction of Mukilitwa sand dam with a 100m<sup>3</sup> sump tank. Benefits approximately 500 households



## MILESTONES



### SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

**The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -**

- Supported 112 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,158.
- Provided water tanks to 23 elderly vulnerable households for water harvesting and storage
- Organized Safe spaces forums benefitting 153 school going children
- Supported Ndolo small home with foodstuff benefitting 50 PWD children
- Supported ward teams to participate in ligi mashinani and provided uniforms and balls to nurture talent and promote sports development.



### EDUCATION ACCESS

**Access to education and training was enhanced through: -**

- Conversion of 27 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 36 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 782 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Construction of Isovyia CTTI dormitory providing conducive accommodation environment for 80 trainees.
- Enhanced access to vocational training by providing capitation to three CTTIs namely; Isovyia, Kyangee and Nzukini.
