



INTRODUCTION



BACKGROUND INFORMATION
















WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested through the following: -

- Drilling and equipping of Kwa Kalekye borehole with a yield of 5.5m³/hr benefitting 5 villages (Kwa Mbata, Makokani, Mbenuu, Nzambani and Muthingiini villages)
- Drilling and equipping of Maundu borehole with a yield of 2.2m³/hr benefitting approximately 300 households.

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Supplied 3.824MT of certified green gram seeds and distributed to 1,912 beneficiaries cushioning them from the high cost of farm inputs.
- Vaccinated 1,919 dogs against rabies benefitting 1,277 Households
- Vaccinated 1,811 cattle and 3,442 goats in livestock disease control benefitting 418 farmers.

DEVOLUTION

Enhanced service delivery through: -

 Construction of Ivingoni/Nzambani Ward Office block at Makutano to bring service close to ward residents (Serving a ward population of 35,827)

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Enhanced road connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 32.8km of new roads connecting almost all the markets and shopping centers within the Ward
- Installation of culverts in 4 major roads that interconnect the Ward
- Connecting 98 households with electricity under the REREC matching grant in Kiundwani market

UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

 Construction of new block at lvingoni dispensary, serving a catchment population of 915



PUBLIC SANITATION

Promoted public sanitation through: -

- Construction of Eco toilet at Nthongoni market improving market sanitation
- Market cleaning and waste collection in 4 markets; Nthongoni, Makutano, Nzambani and Kambu, utilizing 11 casuals across the ward





EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of classrooms at three ECDE centers namely; (Syandani, Kikwasuni & Ndivuni) providing conducive learning environment
- Conversion of 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 38 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 141 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowernment: -

YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

- Supported 114 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,211.
- Organized safe spaces forum benefiting 246 school going children
- Supported ward teams to participate in Ligi Mashinani.
