





INTRODUCTION





URBAN DEVELOPMENT

▼ To boost development, the county

 Conducted land clinics where citizens got help on land issues from the experts

government: -

- Planned Kalawa and Kathulumbi markets awaiting approval by the County assembly
- Renovated the ward revenue office

PUBLIC SANITATION

To boost sanitation, the county government: -

- Conducted market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 14 markets creating jobs for 45 local casuals across the ward
- Constructed Kavumbu market toilet serving over 200 traders



WATER ACCESS

The County Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through: -

- Expansion and desilting of Kyamakuthi earth dam with a capacity of 47,233M³ serving approximately 10,000 people,
- Desilting Muambe ,Muthama and Kwa Ivali earth dams with a total volume of 95,000M³ serving a population of approximately 6,200 people.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Renovation of Kathulumbi and Mutembuku health centres providing a conducive environment to offer health services to a total catchment population of 11,800.
- Engagement of 322 CHPs under the 15 community health units whose main function is to implement primary health care at community level.

EDUCATION ACCESS

The county government enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening 30Km of road, grading 190Km and gravelling 5Km improving accessibility
- Excavation of 3,352m catch water miter drains as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- Connecting 64 households with electricity through REREC Matching grant, improving living standards and boosting local economic activities by enabling access to power for homes and businesses.

Enhanced access to education through: -

- Construction of classrooms at six ECDE centers namely; Ngamu, Mweleli ,Ngugi, Syongungi, Mwaani and Syokilati ECDEs providing a conducive learning enviroment.
- Conversion of 39 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 41 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 487 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity the government: -

- Distributed 7,884 kilograms of certified green gram seeds to 3,942 farmers to help alleviate the burden of high farm input costs
- Mapped and profilled of 7,081 farmers to enhance access to extension services.
- NARIGP programme: supported 50 groups in four (4) value chains i.e. Tomato, mango, green grams & poultry.Provided Agricultural equipment and machines i.e feed formulation equipment, threshers, Incubators, brick making machines and water tanks.
- KCEP CRAL: supported farmers with farm inputs such as seeds, fertilizer, agro-chemicals and Hermetic bags, tarpaulins and aggregation centers with weighing machines and moisture meter

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.1% of the ward's elderly population of 2,205.
- Establishment of Safe space engaging 173 (78 boys, 95 girls) school going children
- Supported 8 ward teams with sets of uniform in an effort to enhance development
