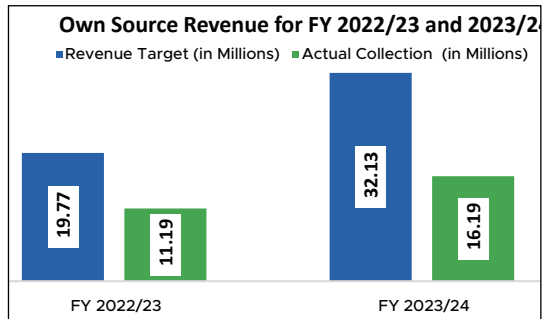
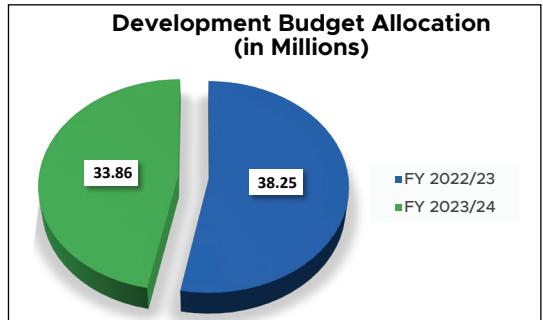
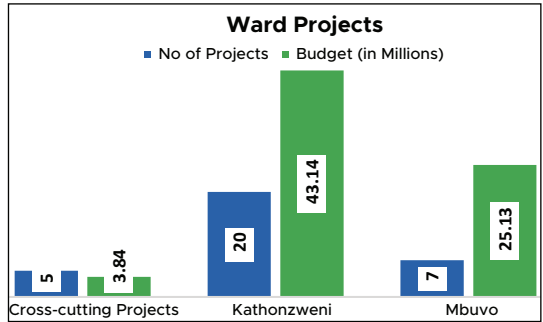

INTRODUCTION

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Purchase of a Backhoe: This facilitated construction of 115 farm ponds each with average capacity of 40m³
- Desilting of Kyambusya earth dam benefiting approximately 100 households.
- Enhancement of Kaiani borehole of yield 2.5m³/hr through installation of additional solar panel and pumpset benefiting approximately 320 households, Kaiani primary and market.
- Distribution of Kwa Mbila water project to Mbuvo-Ikaasu-Makutano- Milute line serving 250 households
- Solarization and rehabilitation of Itumbule borehole with a yield of 4.5m³/Hr benefiting approximately 250 households, Itumbule primary and Sec schools and Itumbule Market.



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed 1,064 Kgs of Sorghum and 712 Kgs of Green grams seeds to 665 farmers contributing to increase in agricultural production.
- Promoted dairy value chain through provision of 729 Artificial Insemination (AI) services through cooperatives
- Mapped, trained and issued fruit fly control baits and solar bags to 1,004 farmers creating zones of low pest prevalence
- Excavated Kwa Kilui and Kwa Mbuta earth dams to support irrigation serving approximately 550 households through KCEP CRAL
- Vaccinated 8,895 livestock against pest and control diseases.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Improved network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening 21.4 Km of road and Grading 52.5Km improving accessibility and transportation of people and goods hence promoting economic growth
- Excavation of 300M³ of mitre drains
- Installation of solar powered floodlights at 6 markets (Mutini, Kiangini, Kyunyu, Ngomano, Thavu, and Kathamboni markets enhancing) enhancing security and extending trading hours.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction of staff quarters at Kiangini Dispensary facilitating seamless delivery of health care services, serving a catchment population of 1,458.
- Renovation of Kathonzweni Health Centre and Kwa Kavisi Dispensary enhancing conducive environment to offer services to a catchment population of 9,843 people,
- Engagement of 114 Community Health Promoters supporting and offering primary health care services



PUBLIC SANITATION

Enhanced public sanitation through: -

- Construction of toilets at Kathonzweni market (modern toilet), Ikaasu and Kavumbu markets.
- Market cleaning and waste collection initiative in selected markets within the ward



URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND SECURITY LAND TENURE

The county government : -

- Conducted land clinics to assist citizens on land issues from the land experts
- Surveyed Kathonzweni market in efforts to promote security of land tenure (Awaiting allotment)

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education through: -

- Construction of Ngomano ECDE providing conducive learning environment for the learners.
- Conversion of 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 42 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 324 needy and bright students in FY 2023/24 with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Construction of Kiangi Youth Empowerment Centre, will equip the youth with ICT skills once operationalized.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 21 PWDs with wheelchairs to enhance self-reliance
- Supported a total of 113 elderly persons through social protection initiatives such as provision of food, non-food items and NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access,
- Provided dignity packs to 89 pupils to enhance menstrual hygiene
- Assessed and mapped 600 PWDs to enable them acquire certificates and access government services
