## MILESTONES



### ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

#### Enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 27kms of road, grading 44.5kms and gravelling 4kms to improve road accessibility and connectivity across the ward, facilitating smooth transportation and trade.
- Installation of drainage structures such as 116m of culverts, 50 scour checks, and 40 gabion boxes to ensure better water management, prevention of flooding and soil erosion improving road durability
- Installation of solar light systems at Mavivye market improving security and spurring economic activities by extending operating hours in the market.



### EDUCATION ACCESS

#### Enhanced access to education through: -

- Construction of classrooms at 4 ECDE centers namely; Kwa Kea, Ulu, Kisse and Kilombo ECDEs with total enrolment of 114 learners.
- Conversion of 38 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 46 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 300 needy and bright students in FY 2023/24 with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.

## MILESTONES



### PUBLIC SANITATION

**Public sanitation was enhanced through: -**

- Market cleaning and waste collection in 8 markets engaging 33 local residents across the ward
- Construction of public toilets to enhance sanitation in 2 markets (Ngiini and Marwa)



### WATER ACCESS

**The county Government increased volumes of water harvested and reduced distance to water sources through: -**

- Desilting and expansion of 3 earth dams (Kyunguni, Makaa and Katatu) benefitting approximately 1,100 households
- Solarization of Kiu borehole water project which benefits approximately 1,000 households

### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

### SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

#### Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction of Ulu dispensary and Kavuko maternity block
- Engagement of 115 community health promoters to implement primary health care at community level.

#### The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.7% of the ward's elderly population of 1,995.
- Organized Safe spaces forums for children programme reaching 95 boys and girls
- Facilitated 36 teams in the ward to participate in 'ligi mashinani' ward games and issued 34 teams with uniform and balls.
- Levelled Kiu play ground to provide reliable space to nurture sport talents



### DEVOLUTION

#### To enhance service delivery, the county government: -

- Constructed Kilome sub county office to provide conducive working environment and offer services to the community
