#### **AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN**

# In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Vaccinated 3,034 cattle against Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) and 1,600 goats against Contagious Caprine Pleuropneumonia (CCPP) to improve livestock health.
- Vaccinated 3,500 dogs against rabies to safeguard public health and prevent the spread of disease
- supported 56 groups focusing on mango, tomato and poultry value chains through provision of agricultural equipment and machines such as feed formulation equipment, threshers, incubators, brick making machines and water tanks under NARIGP
- Provided farm inputs at a subsidized price to 1,800 farmers, enhancing their productivity under KCEP CRAL program

The county government undertook the following interventions, to

YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowernment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.5% of the ward's elderly population of 2,067.
- Supported Kakuswi school for deaf with food benefiting 53 learners.
- Organized Safe spaces forums benefitting 242 school going children
- Facilitated 18 teams to participate in ligi mashinani ward league enhancing sports and talent development
- Levelled Iviani playground providing a sporting facility to nurture talents and enhance sports development



#### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

# Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Distribution of essential medical commodities to all the health facilities across the ward with a total catchment population of 39,809.
- Construction of an outpatient Block and installation of hospital Processor/Digital X-ray to enhance health care access at Tawa sub county hospital with a catchment population of 27,128
- Supporting of 124 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) in promotion of health education and primary health care within the community.



#### **EDUCATION ACCESS**

### In efforts to enhance access to education, the County Government: -

- Constructed classrooms at three ECDE centers namely; Ngaa , Kalimani and Songeni ECDE centers providing conducive learning enviroment.
- Converted 42 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education
- Provided 64 ECDE centers with teaching and learning materials to enhance access to quality education
- Supported 634 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.

#### WATER ACCESS

### The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through: -

MILESTONES

- Drilling and equipping of Songeni borehole with a yield of 7.8M<sup>3</sup>/hr benefiting approximately 700 households
- Drilling, solarization and distribution of Kwa Matinga borehole with a yield of 2 M<sup>3</sup>/hr benefitting community across 4 villages.
- Distributing of Kwa Kimandi borehole with a yield of 5.6m3/hr. Benefits approximately 600 households.

## ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

#### URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC SANITATION

## Enhanced and improved road network connectivity through: -

- Construction of Ngwani drift enhancing connectivity for transporting farm products thus stimulating economic development in Tawa market.
- Opening of 25km of road and graded 123.5km increasing access to markets and institutions.
- Installation of drainage structures such as 50 gabion boxes and 20 scour checks which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season, improving all-weather access for the community
- Excavation of 4,030m cut off mitre drains executed through the Community-Driven Development (CDD) programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure. This initiative also created employment opportunities for 400 local residents.

### To boost development, the county government : -

- Established Mbooni-Kee Municipality to streamline local governance and enhance urban services within the Mbooni-Kee region.
- In partnership with the National Land Commission (NCL), distributed title deeds to public institutions (RGC church Mbumbuni, Kisau Farmer Co-operative, Kiseki women group, Kyambusya GFBC church) schools, and markets, strengthening land ownership and security of tenure.
- Held Land Clinics to provide residents with guidance on land-related issues, allowing them to access information and support on land management practices.
- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in the 10 markets utilizing 32 resident casuals across the ward.
