





### ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

# The county government enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening 94.5 Km of road, grading 112.2KM, installing 32 meters of culverts and 18 gabion boxes- These efforts have significantly improved road access and connectivity across the ward
- Promotion of roads for water through excavation of 1,124M3 of mitre drains
- Installation of 8 floodlight in the following markets: Maau eli, manza, mbata, munathi, kikome, kyuasini, kiambani and Kimundi.
- Electric power connection to 12 beneficiaries through REREC.

In efforts to increase crop/ livestock production and productivity, the county government has undertaken the following interventions: -

- Mapped, trained, and provided 990 farmers with fruit fly control baits and solar bags, creating zones with low pest prevalence
- Assisted farmers with pond liners of average capacity of 800m3 under KCEP CRAL.
- Supported 52 groups with demonstration materials, training, and sensitization to join SACCOs under the NARIGP
- Promoted dairy value chain through provision of 84 Artificial Insemination (AI) services through cooperatives
- Vaccinated 23,335 livestock against pest and control diseases.

### SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowernment: -

- Supported 113 elderly persons with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 6.3% of the ward's elderly population of 1,786.
- Supported 33 teams to participate in ligi mashinani and provided with uniforms, balls and nets
- Trained and supported youth with tools of trade under ujuzi teketeke programme
- Assessed 511 PWDs to enable them access certificates and government services.

WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

 Desilting of Kwetui and Mitooni earth dams benefitting approximately 400 households.





## Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of classrooms at Ngunguuni and Matheani providing a conducive learning environment.
- Conversion of 34 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 34 ECDE centers
- Supporting 618 needy and bright students in FY 2023/24 with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.



### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

# Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Renovation of Kithuki health Centre maternity which records approximately 15 deliveries per month
- Engagement of 109 Community Health Promoters.
