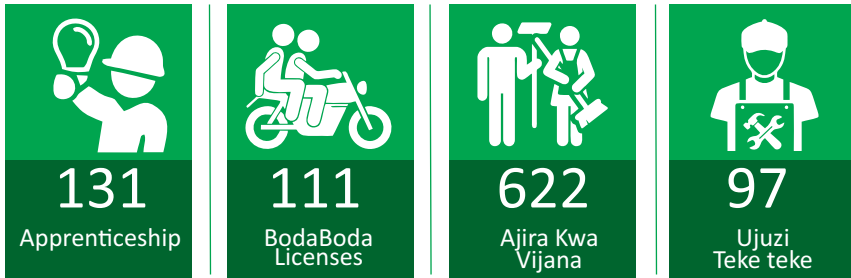

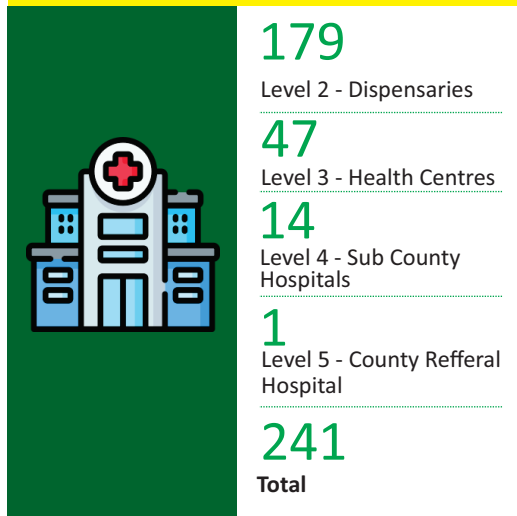

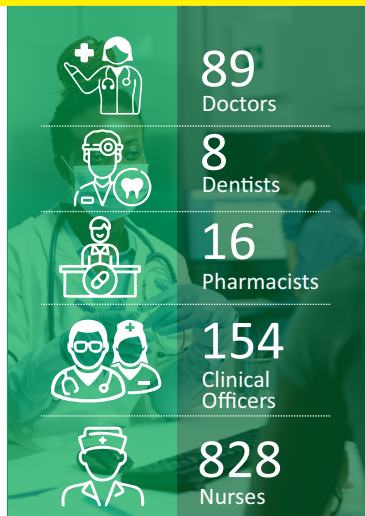

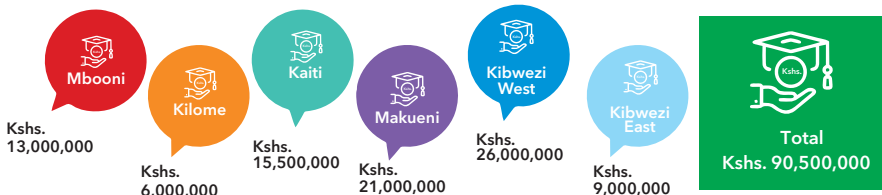

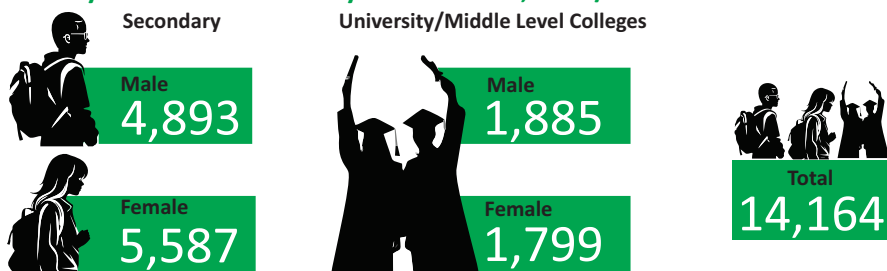

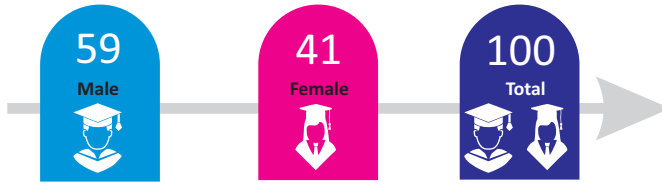
### County Government Bursary Allocation by Sub County, 2023/2024



### County Government Bursary Beneficiaries, 2023/24



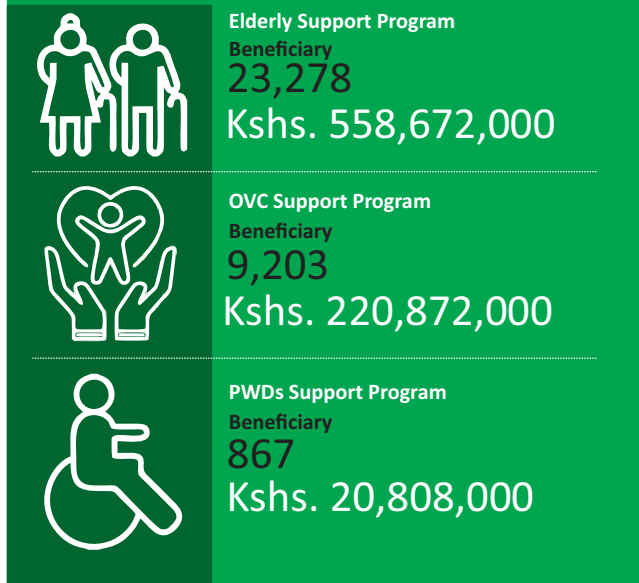

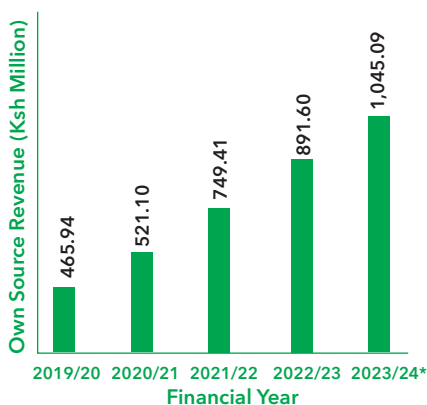

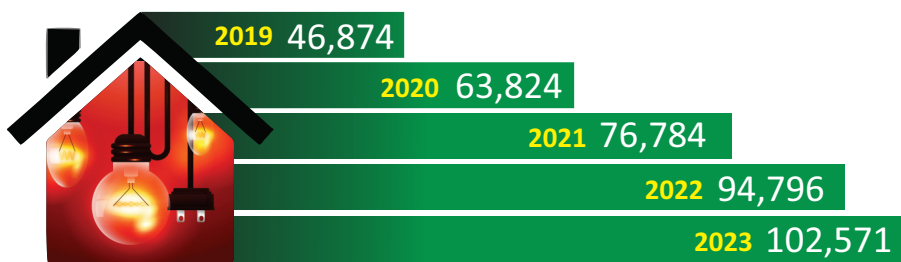

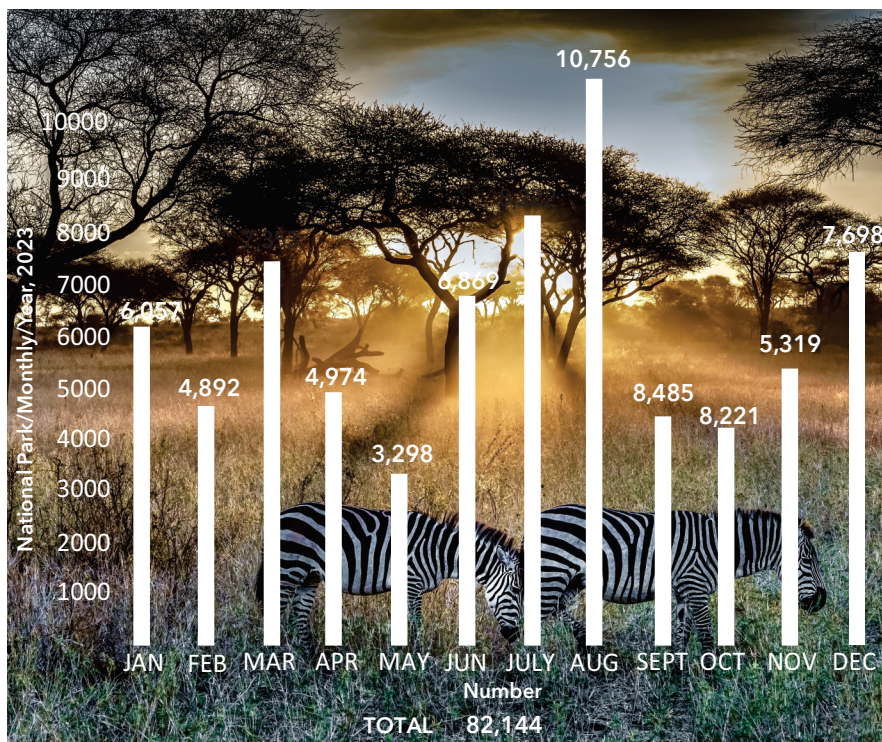

### Monthly Visitors to National Parks (Chyulu Hills and Tsavo), 2023



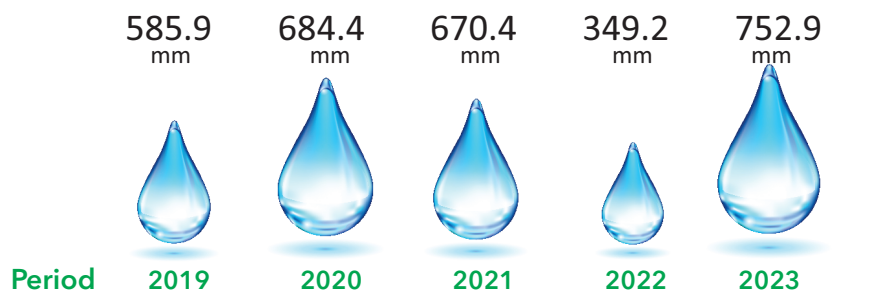

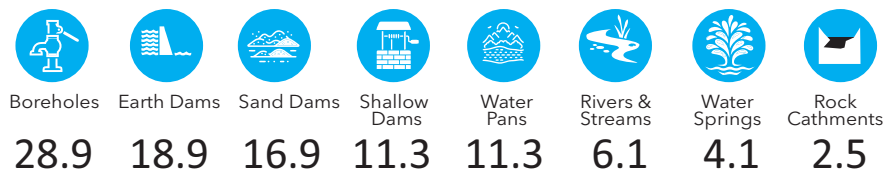

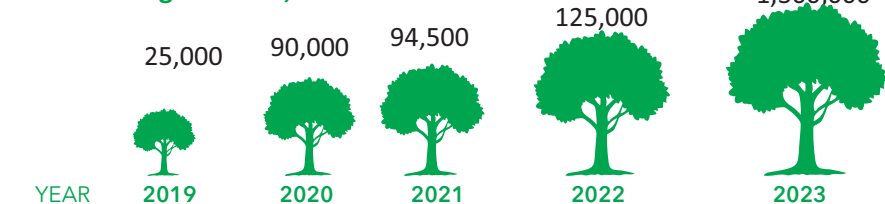
### Mean Annual Rainfall

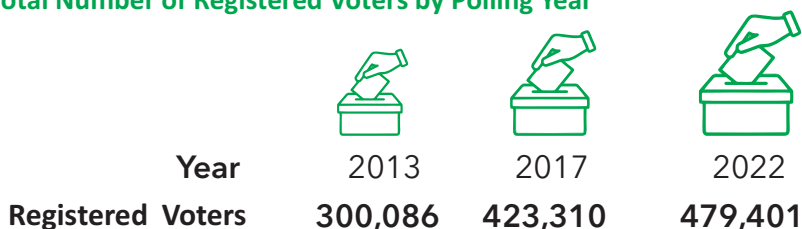

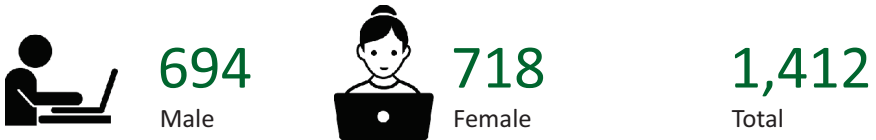
