INTRODUCTION

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Desilting of Mulilii Earth Dam to enhance water availability for five villages, benefiting around 300 households.
- Drilling and equipping the Makindu Borehole with a yield of 18m³/hour supplying water to Makindu Town and surrounding areas.



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed 6.048MT of green grams seeds to 3,024 beneficiaries cushioning them from the high cost of purchasing farm inputs.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Improved road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 52km of road, grading of 83.5Km and gravelling 5.5Km enhancing road network connectivity across the ward
- Installation of drainage structures such as 64m of culverts and 25 gabion boxes.
- Excavated 1,620m catch water mitre drains as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- Electrification of Ngakaa dispensary
- Installation of flood lights at Makindu upper market enhancing security and stimulated economic development
- Installation of 28 street lights along Kiambani primary, secondary schools and makindu town, improving security and safety for the students and traders.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Rehabilitation of Yimwaa dispensary which has a catchment population of 2,496.
- Electrification, fencing, and construction of a new staff house at Kai dispensary, serving a catchment population of 1,950
- Conducting two outreach campaigns focused on Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and general medical outreach, reaching 500 people. These projects contributed to reduced maternal, infant, and child mortality, improving health awareness in the community.

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education through: -

- Conversion of 39 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 57 ECDE centers to enhance access to quality education
- Supporting 467 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 4.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,714.
- Organized safe spaces benefiting 115 (63 boys and 52 girls) school going children
- Supported ward teams with soccer, volleyball, handball and basketball to promote sport development.
