

#### INTRODUCTION





### **WATER ACCESS**

# The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Extension of Ngwata, Kativani, Kiange, Yumbuni, and Kyuasini line from umanyi springs to 3 clusters benefiting approximately 9500 peoples
- Extension of water pipeline for Makutano- Makongeni- Masimbani
   Mbondeni (Kwa Kalee) to Mwaani market by KIMAWASCO, benefiting approximately 6,300 people.

### **AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN**

# In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Constructed Ulilinzi livestock yard benefiting over 400 traders
- Vaccinated 3,580 livestock against diseases benefiting 523 household.



### URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC SANITATION

# To boost urban development and promote public sanitation, the county government: -

- Facilitated planning of Kyumani market- The market plan was approved allowing space for survey and tilting.
- Constructed Makutano and Yumbuni Public toilet improving public sanitation.

### ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY



### UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

### Enhanced Road connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 18.5 Km of road, grading of 222.4 Km and gravelling of 29Km
- Promoting conservation agriculture through construction of 138M3 of mitre drains
- Construction of Isunguluni- Cutline-Kyanguli- Masaku Ndogo road drift connecting institutions and villages as well as Installation of 132m culverts drainage structures
- Connecting Mukaange aggregation center with electricity through REREC Matching grant
- Installation of market streetlights at Kativani, Makutano and Ndauni Markets to enhance security and safety.

# Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Upgrading of Ngwata maternity block and Katulye Dispensary
- Engagement of 128 Community Health promoters in provision of primary health care services

### **EDUCATION ACCESS**

### SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

### Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of 5 ECDE centers ( Ulilinzi, Yikitaa, Kiange, Kathito, and Kalima Koi ECDE) providing conducive learning environment
- Conversion of 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 41 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education
- Supporting 312 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 students improving retention in learning institutions.
- Operationalization of Uutini CTTI to enhance access to vocational training.

### The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -


- Supported 213 elderly persons with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5% of the ward's elderly population of 2.270.
- Supported 6 vulnerable groups with a 100-seater tent and 100 chairs each for rental purposes, aimed at enhancing their socio-economic empowerment.
- Trained and issued tools of trade to 9 youth under Ujuzi teke teke programme
- Supported 27 teams to participate in ward games to nurture talent and promote sports development.
