The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Distribution of Kamuithi borehole which has a yield of 13m³/hr benefitting approximately 1,000 households
- Solar installation and distribution of Kiaoni borehole benefitting approximately 700 households.
- Desilting of Harambee and Kwamboo earth dams benefitting approximately 700 households
- Drilling and distribution of Kiimani and Kanthuni borehole benefitting approximately 800 households
- Distribution of Musini borehole benefitting approximately 600 households



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Mapped, trained, and provided 1,009 farmers with fruit fly control baits and solar bags, creating zones with low pest prevalence
- Assisted four farmers with pond liners with an average capacity of 800M3 under KCEP CRAL.
- Supported 49 groups with demonstration materials, training, and sensitization to join SACCOs under the NARIGP
- Excavated Ngosini earth dam for supply of water for domestic, livestock and irrigation serving parts of Mavindini and Muvau/kikumini ward under NARIGP.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Improved road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 32.4 Km of road, grading 92.1 KM, gravelling 1.8km and installing 190 meters of culverts and 38 gabion boxes.
- Promotion of roads for water through excavation of 1,381M3 of mitre drains
- Installation of solar flood lights in 3 markets: Kanthuni, kamuithi and nzeveni markets
- Installation of High mast street lighting at liani market.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Renovation of liani dispensary creating a conducive working environment to serve a catchment population of approximately 2,000 with an average monthly workload of 600 patients.
- Engagement of 61 community health promoters whose main function is to implement and promote primary health care at community level



DEVOLUTION

To enhance service delivery and bring service close to the citizenry, the county government: -

- Constructed Mavindini ward administrator's office to create a conducive working environment for county staff at the ward level and facilitate community access to government services.



PUBLIC SANITATION

Public sanitation was enhanced through: -

- Construction of public toilets at Mavindini and Katithi Markets
- Cleaning of 9 markets (Yekanga, Nzeveni, liani, Ivinga Nzia, Kanthuni, Mavindini, Yemulwa, Muusini, Katithi)

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Conversion of 25 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistency access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 29 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 315 needy and bright students in FY 2023/24 with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining from one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Construction of Mavindini CTTI dormitory to provide conducive accommodation for 80 trainees.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 6% of the ward's elderly population of 1,871.
- Supported 31 teams to participate in Ligi Mashinani and provided them with balls to foster sports development.
- Assessed and mapped 422 PWDs to enable them acquire certificates and access government services.
