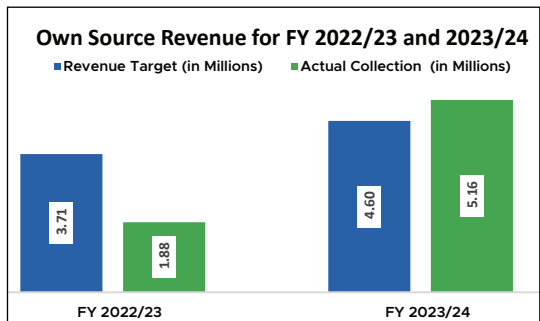
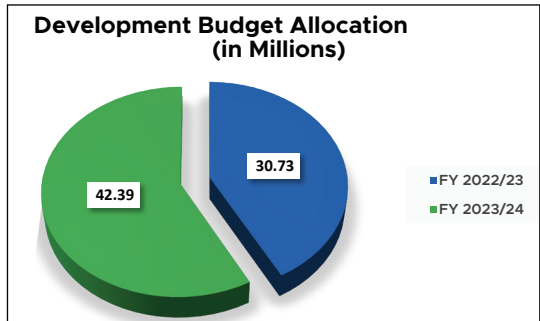
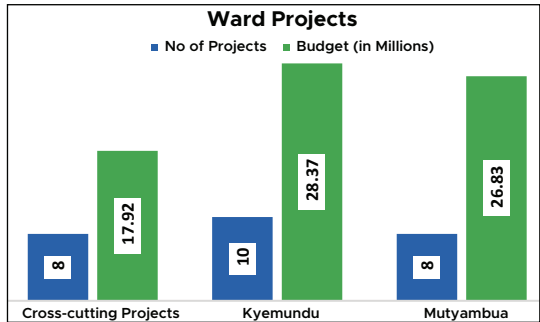

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed certified seeds (600 kg of beans and 2,112 kg of maize) to 1,356 farmers to ease the high cost of farm inputs.
- Promoted dairy value chain by providing 431 Artificial Insemination (AI) services through cooperatives.
- Vaccinated 16,270 livestock to control pests and diseases.
- Supported farmers with pond liners, each with an average capacity of 800m³, under the KCEP-CRAL program to promote irrigation.
- Assisted 30 groups with demonstration materials for the Farmer Field School project and trained them to join SACCOs under the NARIGP program.



EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of Muambwani and Kyumbuni ECDE classrooms providing conducive learning environment
- Conversion of 34 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 38 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 332 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Provision of 2 CTTIs with a capitation and water harvesting equipment; Masokani and Kithumani CTTIs

MILESTONES



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction of Mbitini dispensary outpatient block which serves a catchment population of 1,469
- Engagement of 90 Health promoters in provision of primary health care services at community level.
- Conducting of outreach campaigns contributing to reduced maternal, infant, and child mortality and improved health awareness.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.1% of the ward's elderly population of 2,211.
- Supporting 37 teams to participate in 'ligi Mashinani ' ward leagues promoting sports development.



WATER ACCESS

The County Government increased water access in the ward through: -

- Solarization and distribution of Ilgeni water project which is expected to benefit approximately 1,000 Households and 2 institutions; Ngoto primary and Secondary.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

Environmental conservation was enhanced through: -

- Planting of trees at Muambwani forest, Masue and Mutisywa area.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

The county government enhanced and improved road network connectivity through: -

- Opening 35.6Km of road, grading 26.2Km, gravelling 5.6 km, installation of 64m of culverts, construction of 6 drifts and 31 gabion boxes.
- Promotion of roads for water through construction of 420m³ of mitre drains
- Construction of Kwa Kitei Drift connecting Mbitini and Kasikeu wards.



PUBLIC SANITATION

Promoted public sanitation through: -

- Cleaning of 6 markets (Kithumani, Mbenuu, Mutula, Barazani, Mutyambua and Kavuthu)
