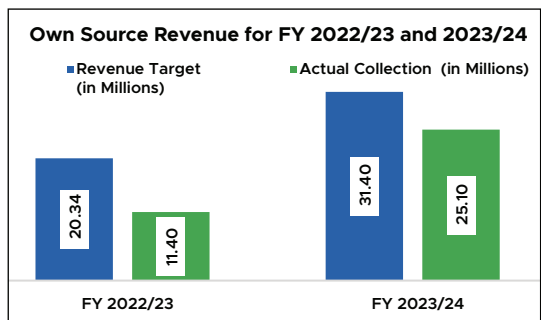
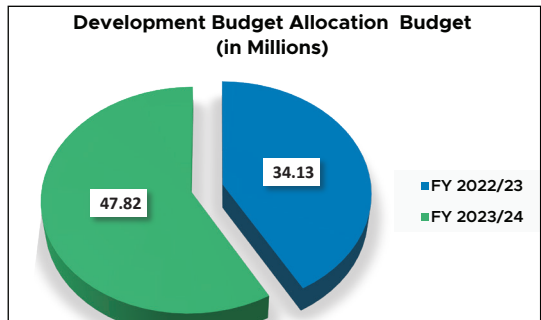
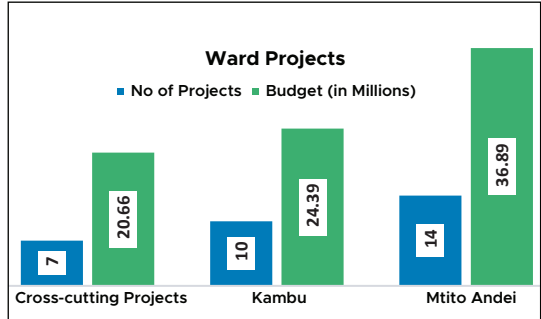

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Solarization and extension of Kwa Diana water project to Misuuni and Mavindini benefiting approximately 3,000 people
- Extension of KIMAWASCO water project to Jua Kali Village benefiting approximately 1,250 individuals
- Extension of Kathekani borehole to Mbetwani market benefiting 1500 individuals and 3 shopping centres.



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Supplied 1MT green grams seeds to 1,000 beneficiaries to boost production
- Vaccinated livestock against pest and diseases (LSD 1448 Cows, RVF to 1948 cows, and CCPP to 4733 goats) benefitting 365 Households and
- Vaccinated 1,194 dogs against rabies which benefitted 769 households.



URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC SANITATION

To boost development, the county government : -

- Surveyed and beaconed Mtito Andei Market to reduce encroachment and pave way for urban development.
- Improved public sanitation through Market cleaning.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Enhanced road connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening 27 Km of road, grading 62.1 Km and gravelling 11.1 Kms across the ward.
- Installation of drainage structures such as 8m culverts and 20 gabions which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season
- Excavation of 2,235M3 cut-off mitre drains through Community Driven Programme as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure.
- Connection of Lukenya University School of medicine community with electricity through REREC Matching grant.
- Installation of solar market flood lights at Kyusyani, Mbeetwani, Songea, Kalimani, Mavindini, Makutano, Misuuni and Kwa Kinyuti to enhance security.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction & equipping of X-ray block and theatre at Kambu sub-county hospital
- Conducting of outreach campaigns for Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and medical outreach within the wards
- Engagement of 138 community health promoters in offering primary health care.

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of 5 ECDE centers namely: Kavungwa, Nzoila, Mavindini, Kathekani, and Kilumilo ECDEs.
- 35 ECDE teachers converted to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 45 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 470 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 students improving retention in learning institutions.
- Improved access to vocational training by equipping the Mtito Andei Resource Centre and constructing a twin workshop at Ngwata CTTI
- Increased access to ICT services through construction of Daranjani Community Information Center providing conducive learning environment.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Provision of food and non-food items to 114 individuals enhancing their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,202.
- Supporting 9 groups each with 100-seater tent and 100 chairs for income generating activities.
- Organized safe spaces forum benefitting 145 school going children
- Supported 59 teams to participate in ward games and provided with sports gear and balls to nurture talent and promote sports development.
