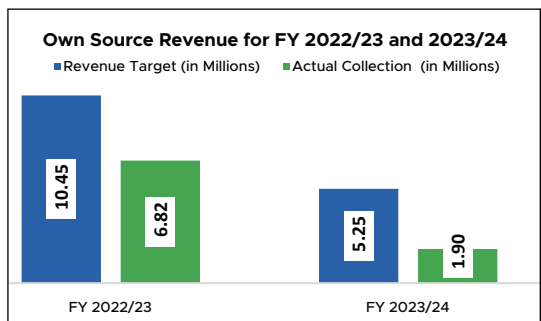
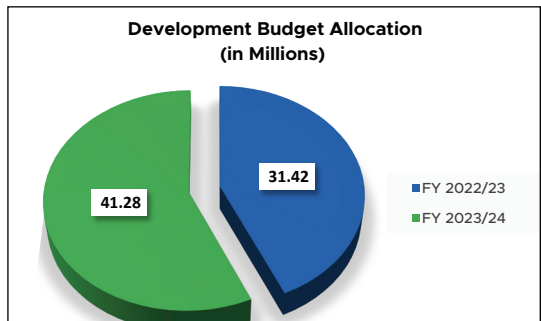
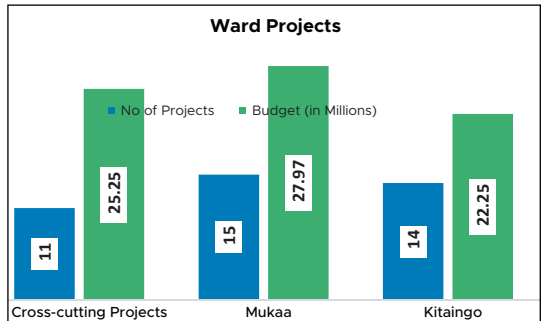

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

The county government enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 40km of road, grading 44km and gravelling of 3km to improve access and enhance road network connectivity within the ward.
- Installation of 54m of culvert to manage storm water and prevent flooding, enhancing road safety and accessibility during the rainy season.
- Excavation of 1,250m cut-off mitre drains executed through the Community-Driven Development (CDD) programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure. This initiative provided income to 1,680 community members.
- Installation of solar flood lights in 6 markets which include; Kamuthini, Kiongwani, Kyandue, Kyangala, Mutiluni and Maiani markets, to enhance security and extend trading hours.



EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education through: -

- Construction of classrooms at 3 ECDE centres, namely: Kyandue, Kwa Kaseke and Kwa Muatha ECDEs, providing conducive learning environment.
- Conversion of 38 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 46 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 293 needy and bright students in FY2023/24 with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Supporting Enzai and Kitaingo CTTIs with capitation to subsidize training costs.
- Provision of training tools to Kitaingo CTTI to equip trainees with practical skills.

PUBLIC SANITATION

Public sanitation was enhanced through: -

- Market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 8 markets utilizing local residents across the ward



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased volumes of water harvested and reduced distance to water sources through: -

- Distribution of Kamuthini borehole with a yield of 7.2m³/hour to Katalani and Muthitha. Benefits approximately 350 households.
- Enhancement and distribution of Kwa Maulu water project benefitting approximately 10 villages in Mukaa sub ward.
- Construction of Kwa Mbisi Sand Dam benefitting approximately 200 households
- Rehabilitation of Mutiluni borehole with a yield of 1m³/hour benefitting approximately 300 households

UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Equipping and renovation of a ward at Uvete health centre which currently supports maternity services
- Completion of Kamuthini dispensary injection room and equipping of maternity wing, serving a catchment population of 1,100 with an average monthly workload of 327.
- Fencing of Mutiluni health centre and equipping of the maternity ensuring security and rendering services to a population of 3,800
- Renovation of Enzai health facility serving a catchment population of 2,200 with an average monthly workload of 515 patients.

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5% of the ward's elderly population of 2,238.
- Organized Safe spaces forums for school going children reaching 55 boys and 50 girls.
- Supported ward teams to participate in ward league games, issued with balls and cash awards.
- Levelled Uvete playground, providing sporting facility to nurture talents
