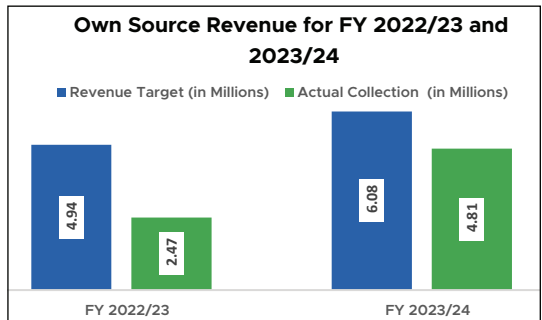
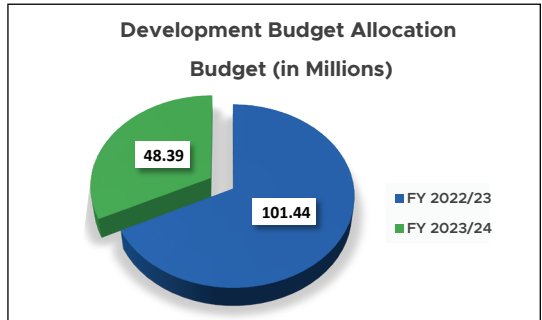
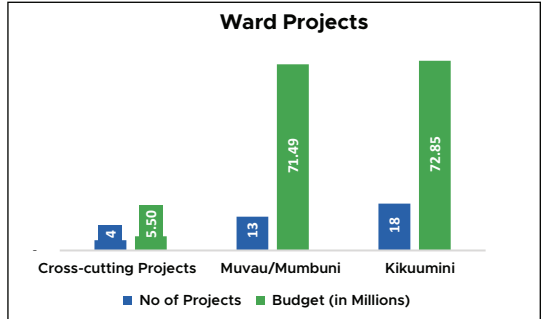

INTRODUCTION

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

BACKGROUND INFORMATION



FLAGSHIP PROJECT: NDUKUMA EARTH DAM

Desilted and expanded Ndukuma earth dam with a capacity of approximately 365,000m³. Currently benefiting 1,520 Households. On distribution, it will serve 4,080 households and 9 public institutions

Constructed Ngosini earth dam under NARGIP with a volume of 55,000m³. It is targeted to support irrigation for approximately 3,000 farmers from in Muvau/Kikumini and Mavindini wards.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

To enhance and improve road network connectivity, the county government: -

- Opened 20km of road, graded 127.7 Km and graveled 5 km across the ward.
- Installed drainage structures such as 70M of culverts and 4 gabion boxes rendering the roads passable during the rainy seasons.
- Excavated 550m of cut off mitre drains as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- Constructed Kwa Kateli drift and Mangauni - Kikumini drift connecting institutions and villages which stimulated economic development in Kitonyoni, Sia and kavingo shopping centres.

WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Distribution of water from Kwa Kamweli to Mulaani market, and from Kwa Ng'uuta to Kwa Kasaka, benefitting a population of approximately 6,000 and 4 shopping centres.
- Solarization and distribution of Kwa Mwenga borehole with a yield of 14M3/hr benefitting approximately 105 households, Kivani and Muambani shopping centers.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction of new outpatient blocks at Kambi mawe, Mumbuni and Kikumini health centers serving a total catchment population of 8,753 persons.
- Engagement of 52 Community Health Promoters in provision of primary health care services at the community level.
- Conducting of two outreach campaigns: one on Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) at Kwa Kathoka and a medical outreach, reaching 450 people. These initiatives contributed to reduced maternal, infant, and child mortality, and improved health awareness.



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

To enhance environmental conservation, the government: -

- Supported 5 groups with inputs and 3 water tanks with a capacity of 5,000M3 to establish tree nurseries.

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Provided 1,912 farmers with green gram certified seeds to enhance crop production and productivity
- Mapped, trained and issued fruit fly control baits and solar bags to 2,000 farmers creating zones of low pest prevalence
- Promoted dairy value chain through provision of 115 Artificial Insemination (AI) services through cooperatives
- Profiled 5,496 farmers, and formed Muvau Kikumini SACCO, set to benefit from a Ksh. 1,000,000 grants under NAVCDP
- Vaccinated 1,726 cows and 982 goats against Lumpy skin and contagious caprine pleural Pneumonia respectively
- Trained 60 learners across the county on dairy, poultry and horticulture value chain at ATC Kwa Kathoka
- Drilled Kaseve borehole with a yield of 2m³/h serving approximately 240 households under KCEP CRAL programme.
- Supported 49 groups with demonstration materials for farmer field school project, trained and sensitized to join SACCO under NARIGP.

MILESTONES



EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of classrooms at four ECDE centers namely; Kyaka ECDE, Kambi Mawe ECDE, Ndukuma ECDE and Kimuumo ECDE, providing a conducive learning environment.
- Conversion of 24 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistency access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 24 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 311 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining from one to enhance retention in learning institutions.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 106 elderly persons with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being and NHIF subscriptions annually enhancing access to health care services. This initiative benefits 6% of the ward's elderly population of 1,755.
- Mapped and assessed 232 Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) to enable them acquire certificates and access to government services.



URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC SANITATION

To attract investors and stimulate growth, the government: -

- Planned Kwa kathoka market to attract investment and guide sustainable future development.
- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 8 markets across the ward
