



INTRODUCTION
















MILESTONES





WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Supply of 5 water tanks to 2 institutions and 3 water projects to enhance water harvesting and storage.
- Electrification of Kilumbu borehole and Kwa Moto borehole; Benefiting approximately 900 Households
- Solarization and distribution for Kwa Koki, Kwa Kavuki and Isololo water project benefitting approximately 1,500 households
- Rehabilitation of 2 boreholes: Kwa Muthama and Mulenyu boreholes benefiting 250 households
- Repair of 4 Shallow wells: Kwa kimaa, muthwani, matiliku police station and Ngolya benefitting approximately 200 households.
- Water distribution: From Kalatu borehole to Kaukuswi. benefits approximately 400 households
- Distribution of Ithetheni water project benefitting approximately 100 households

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed 4,000 Mango seedlings, 4,000 Citrus seedlings and 1,350 Pawpaw seedlings to 567 farmers
- Mapped, trained and distributed fruit fly control baits to 1,478 farmers creating zones of low pest prevalence
- Promoted dairy value chain through provision of 234 Artificial Insemination (AI) services through cooperatives
- Vaccinated 24,336 livestock against pest and diseases.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

The County Government enhanced and improved road network connectivity through: -

- Opening 31.4Km of road, grading 132.4KM, installing 24 meters of culverts and 5 gabion boxes across the ward
- Promotion of roads for water through excavation of 200M³ of mitre drains
- Construction of Nzeeni drift enhancing access to institutions and markets.

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Renovation of Matiliku Sub County Hospital and the operationalization of the dental unit benefiting a catchment population of 11,412 with a monthly workload of 2,500
- Engagement of 109 Community Health Promoters in provision of primary health care services.

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of classrooms at 2 ECDE centers namely; Yuima and Kalamba ECDEs, providing conducive learning environment.
- Conversion of 40 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 56 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 1,527 (1,321 in FY2023/24 and 206 in FY2022/23) needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- ICT training to 99 community members at Matiliku Community Information Centre


SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowernment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 4.3% of the ward's elderly population of 2.628.
- Issued 23 vulnerable groups with tents and chairs to enhance social economic empowerment.
- Supported 37 teams to participate in ligi mashinani drawing cash awards
