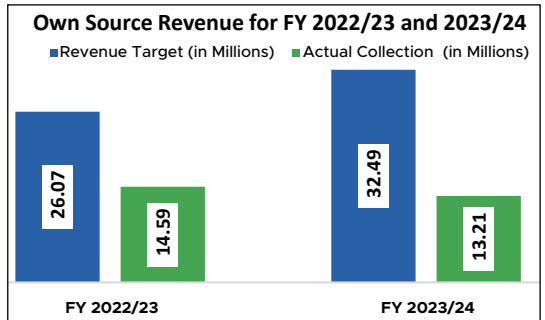
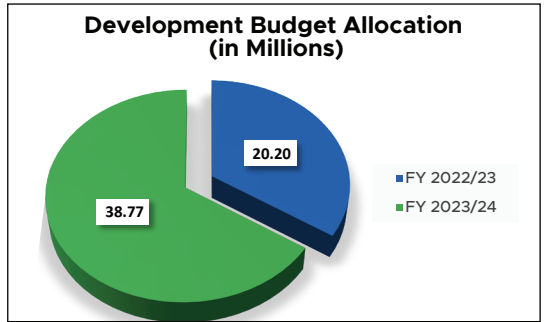
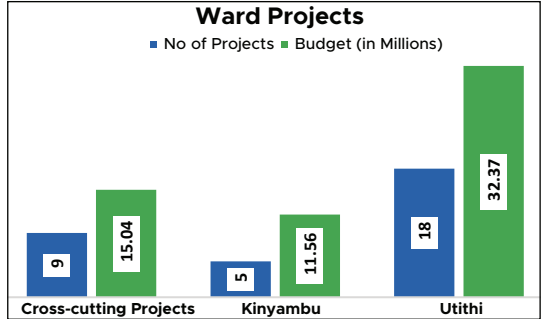

The Ward Development Profile provides an overview of milestones achieved in County for the FY 2022/23 and FY 2023/24. It documents all programmes/projects implemented across the ward, highlighting key benefits to the citizens of Makueni County

MILESTONES



WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across the ward through the following: -

- Solarization and rehabilitation of Ithayoni borehole serving 5 villages and Ithayoni ECDE
- Extension of Mbulutini springs water pipeline, benefiting approximately 500 households
- Drilling and equipping Nzouni borehole serving 80 households.



AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Supplied 58 Galla goats to 12 groups to improve the goats' breed and earn a livelihood.
- Distributed 2,464MT of certified green gram seeds to 1,232 farmers
- Profiled 6,244 farmers under NARIGP and formed Thange SACCO, set to benefit from a Ksh. 1,000,000 grant
- Vaccinated 1,666 livestock enhancing animal health benefiting 141 household



URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC SANITATION

To boost urban development and public sanitation, the county government: -

- Surveyed Machinery and Kinyambu markets to enhance urban development
- Constructed toilets at Thange market, Metava and Kithasyu Library, and facilitated market cleaning to improve sanitation.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

Enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening 5Km of road, grading 61Km and gravelling 7km across the ward
- Installation of drainage structures such as 64m of culverts and 10 gabion boxes which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season
- Excavation of 2,425M³ cut-off mitre drains through Community Driven Programme as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and embracing advanced agricultural techniques.
- Installation of 12 floodlights in 10 markets to improve security in the shopping centres
- Construction of 2 drifts along major roads connecting the two-sub ward (Kamunyuni & Yumbuni to Veneti)
- Connection of 100 households with electricity in Usalama market, improving living standards and boosting local economic activities by enabling access to power for homes and businesses.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Fencing and electrification of Ivoleni dispensary to enhance security and service delivery
- Conducting outreach campaigns for Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and medical outreach within the wards
- Engagement of 78 Community Health Promoters in offering primary health care at the community level.

EDUCATION ACCESS

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of Ngokolani and Nzouni ECDEs centers, providing conducive learning environment
- Conversion of 23 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 37 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 510 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY 2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 students improving retention in learning institutions.
- Equipping of Kiumoni CTTI to provide trainees with hand-on experience through practical training.



SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.4% of the ward's elderly population of 2,085.
- Supplied 6 vulnerable groups each with a 100 seater tent and 100 chairs for rentals, aimed at promoting socio-economic empowerment.
- Organized safe spaces forum benefitting 184 school-going children
- Supported 45 teams to participate in ward games, with 41 receiving sporting equipment to nurture talent
- Trained and issued tools of trade to 24 youth enabling them start income-generating activities under Ujuzi teketeke programme.
- Trained 45 youth in driving course, improving employment opportunities to the transport sector.
- Engaged 132 youth in labor-based activities, earning income through Ajira Kwa vijana programme
