





INTRODUCTION





ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY



EDUCATION ACCESS

To enhance road network connectivity and electrification, the County Government: -

- Opened 20km of road and graded 46km enhancing access and connectivity within the ward.
- Installed 162m of culverts and 108 gabions which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season
- Constructed Kyaviti and Ngwani drift connecting institutions, markets and villages.
- Excavated 4,250m cut off mitre drains as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- Connected 76 households in Makuu village and Mulooni primary with electricity through REREC Matching grant to increase reliable and safe access to electricity.

Enhanced access to education through: -

- Construction of classrooms at 2 ECDE centers, namely; Kathokani and Kiatineni ECDE, providing conducive learning environment.
- Conversion of 32 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistence access to education
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 43 ECDE centres enhancing access to quality education
- Supporting 311 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Provision of capitation to two CTTIs namely; Wambuli and Tulimani CTTIs.

SECURITY OF LAND TENURE

WATER ACCESS

To ensure security of land tenure county government: -

- In partnership with the National Land Commission (NCL), title deeds were distributed to public institutions, schools, and markets, strengthening land ownership and security
- Held Land Clinics to provide residents with guidance on land-related issues, allowing them access to information and support on land management practices.

The County Government increased water access and volumes through implementation of the following: -

- Desilting of Kooi earth dam benefiting approximately 1,000 households
- Rehabilitation of Kakima pipeline along Upper Ngwani Water Project benefiting approximately 400 households.
- Rehabilitation of Wanzauni Kikima pipeline pumping system for the Lower Ngwani Water Project benefiting approximately 250 households
- Construction of Masyonyeki Earth dam benefitting approximately 200 households in Wanzauni.



UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Construction of Uvaani staff house to ensure that medical staff are readily available, enhancing healthcare access for a catchment population of 1,614
- Distribution of essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Engagement of 147 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) in primary health care promotion

SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed mango and avocado seedlings to 800 farmers, aimed at boosting fruit production and diversifying income sources
- Supported 52 groups through NARIGP on tomatoes, mango and poultry value chain, benefiting 5,000 households; Provision of agricultural equipment such as incubators, water tanks, generators and water pumps
- Supported 41 groups through KCEP CRAL with farm inputs such as fertilizers and certified seeds (maize and beans) at a subsidized price to 2,000 households, enhancing food security and resilience to climate change.
 - Excavated farm ponds to 4 farmers
 - Supported Kayamba group with feed mill
- In partnership with SIVAP constructed honey refinery factory adding value to honey production
- In collaboration with FAO distributed pasture seeds to 30 farmers through Master Card Foundation

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowerment: -

- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 3.6% of the ward's elderly population of 3.150.
- Issued dignity packs to 175 (70 boys and 105 girls) as an initiative to keep both boys and girls in school
- Supported 10 vulnerable groups each with a 100 seater tent and 100 chairs to start income generating activities
- Provided ward teams with 30 balls and supported to participate in ligi mashinani ward leagues.
- Trained 45 youth on driving course enabling them to acquire related job opportunities.
