

INTRODUCTION





WATER ACCESS

The county Government increased water access and volumes of water harvested across Ukia ward through the following interventions: -

- Distribution of water from Kithamba Borehole, with a yield of 17m³/hour, to Kyumu and Mbalani, benefiting approximately 250 households.
- Extension of Kyeng'eethe water project to Utati. Project benefits approximately 500 households.



URBAN DEVELOPMENT

To boost urban development, the county government: -

- Facilitated Land clinics in Itangini, Kaumoni, Kilala markets
- Improved access roads and drainage within Kilala & kaumoni estates.

ROAD ACCESS AND CONNECTIVITY

The county government enhanced road network connectivity and electrification through: -

- Opening of 16Km of road, grading 169km and 1km of gravelling to enhance access within the ward.
- Installation of drainage structures: 148m of culverts, 22 gabion boxes and 16 scour checks which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season
- Construction of nzouni mutambukoni and kaumoni thangathi drifts.
- Excavation of 1,880m cut off metre drains through 'Miradi Kwa Jamii' programme providing income to 200 community members and transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure.
- Connection of 91 households around Ukia diary with electricity through REREC Matching grant, improving living standards and stimulating local economic activities.

EDUCATION ACCESS

AGRICULTURAL VALUE CHAIN

Enhanced access to education and training through: -

- Construction of classroom at Mumbuni ECDE to enhance conducive learning environment
- Conversion of 46 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provision of teaching and learning materials to 50 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supporting 467 bright and needy students with bursaries in FY2023/24 and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One students over the past two financial years, aiming to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Provision of capitation to 3 CTTIs (Ukia, Kyuasini and Ukaatuni).

In efforts to increase agricultural production and productivity, the county government: -

- Distributed 500 bags of certified seeds; maize & beans (rose coco) to 500 beneficiaries in FY2022/23
- Distributed 21,500 certified Hass avocado scions for grafting and provision of extension service benefiting over 1,745 households
- Promoted irrigation through excavation of 42 farm ponds benefitting 60 households.
- Rehabilitated kyamea water project under SIVAP to enhance access to irrigation for 212 households.
- Formation of Ukia Ward Farmers SACCO with a grant of 1 million under NAVCDP.

UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

Efforts to enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare were achieved through: -

- Infrastructural development of Mukuyuni, Kilala, Nthangu and Kyuasini health facilities to enhance delivery of health care services.
- Conducting outreach campaigns which includes medical outreach and Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) within the ward,
- Engagement of 126 CHP in provision of primary health care.

SOCIAL PROTECTION AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The county government undertook the following interventions, to enhance social well-being and youth empowernment: -

- Supported 115 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with NHIF subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 3.9% of the ward's elderly population of 2,921.
- Provided 2 PWD institutions (Makongo and Kaumoni) with foodstuff, benefitting a total of 85 beneficiaries.
- Organized Safe spaces forums benefitting 76 school going children
- Provided 35 teams with uniforms and balls to nurture talent and promote sports development.
