1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce the distance to reliable water sources, the County Government:

- Rehabilitated Wautu-Kyangaati water project through construction of a sand dam, 100m³ reinforced concrete intake sump tank and a 100m³ masonry reservoir tank at Kwa Chief, installed a solar-powered pumping system, and laid a gravity distribution line serving two communal water points. This has provided potable water for domestic use. Additionally, 5,000 high-value fruit tree seedlings were distributed and 400 riparian trees planted to support catchment rehabilitation and strengthen ecosystem resilience, through the Financing Locally-Led Climate Action (FLLoCA) program.
- Desilted Kwa Matolo earth dam to a capacity of 10,330 cubic meters and distributed water to Wautu market, Wautu Primary, and Wautu Secondary Schools, benefiting approximately 400 households.
- Distributed Kyakithuku borehole which has a yield of 12m³/hr to Kyamanza market, Kyakithuku market and Kyakithuku Primary School, benefitting over 1,000 households.
- Constructed Mukilitwa sand dam, with a 100m³ sump, enhancing water harvesting for domestic and irrigation use, benefiting 500 households and 100 farmers.
- Rehabilitated Kiusyi water project through solarization and distribution to an existing water kiosk at Mwaani, benefiting 120 households.
- Rehabilitated and distributed Kwa Mwili sand dam water through a 6km pipeline to Katikomu and Kyangunzu-Nzeveni villages, reinstating water supply to 600 households.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government;

- Vaccinated 3,462 livestock against pests and diseases.
- Distributed 306 bags of organic fertilizer to cushion farmers against the high cost of farm inputs.
- Facilitated the formation and registration of Ilima Ward SACCO, which received a grant of Ksh 1,000,000 and one motorcycle under the NAVCDP program.
- Supported 51 groups, including two poultry groups, one VMG group, one business development group, and one nutrition group. These groups received 300 chicks, poultry feeds, and incubators to enhance productivity under the NARIG program.





Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Upgraded Kyambeke and Kavatanzou Health Centres through infrastructural developments, with the facilities serving average monthly workloads of 2,500 and 650 patients respectively.
- Engaged 161 community health promoters in offering primary health care services.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed new classrooms for Mwaani, Inyokoni, Kiluluini and Kathangathini ECDE centres, enhancing conducive learning environment.
- Confirmed 29 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 36 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 1,612 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, enhancing retention in learning institutions.
- Constructed a 40-bed dormitory at Isovya Vocational Training Centre, providing conducive accommodation for the trainees.
- Enhanced access to vocational training by providing capitation to Isovya, Kyangee and Nzukini Vocational Training Centres.

Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation and provide a conducive trading environment, the county government;

- Constructed public sanitation blocks at Wautu and Kyambekele markets, enhancing market sanitation
- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 10 markets across the ward.



Road Access and Connectivity

To improve road access and strengthen connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 66 km, graded 182.2 km and graveled 3.5 km of roads across the ward, improving access and connectivity to markets and institutions.
- Installed drainage structures including 98 m of culverts, 38 gabions and 23 scour checks, ensuring roads remained passable during the rainy season.
- Excavated 673m³ of cut-off mitre drains through Miradi Kwa Jamii Programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure, supporting agricultural production, and creating job opportunities for 500 community members.
- Installed four floodlights at Kyambeke, Mitini, Musalala, and Kwa Mwave markets, enhancing security and extending trading hours.
- Installed Wautu solar powered floodlight in partnership with the State Department of Housing and Urban Development.



Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Facilitated election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward and ward levels enhancing coordination and service delivery.




Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Provided six organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for rentals enhancing socio-economic empowerment.
- Trained 45 young people in motor vehicle driving and issued them with driving licenses, enabling them to access driving-related employment opportunities.
- Sensitized 347 community members on gender based violence.
- Supported 112 elderly individuals with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,158.
- Provided water tanks to 23 elderly vulnerable households for harvesting and storage of water enhancing their wellbeing
- Organized safe spaces forums benefiting 153 school going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention.
- Supported Ndolo small home with foodstuffs, benefiting 50 PWD children.
- Facilitated 44 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward league games promoting sports development at grassroot level.
