1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.






No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25


2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access to water and reduce distance to water sources, the county government:

- Distributed Katheka Kai borehole which has a yield of 12m³/hour benefiting over 300 households, 5 schools and 3 shopping centres.
- Drilled and equipped Kwa Kalekye borehole with a yield of 5.5 m³/hr, and extended a 4.2km distribution pipeline with three water points, benefiting over 600 households.
- Drilled and equipped Maundu borehole with a yield of 2.2m³/hour benefiting approximately 200 households.
- Rehabilitated and equipped Utu borehole which has a yield of 1m³/hr to reinstate supply of water to 200 households in utu village.
- Developed Kwa-Nzoongo earth dam under Financing Locally-Led Climate Action, including earthworks, protection structures, and auxiliary components.





Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government:-

- Opened 62.5km of new roads, graded 70.6km and gravelled 62.5km, connecting almost all markets and shopping centers within the ward and improving accessibility for residents and traders.
- Installed 48m of culverts along four major roads that interconnect the ward, improving drainage and overall road accessibility.
- Connected 31 households with electricity under the REREC matching grant in Kativani village

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To boost food security, improve farmers' incomes, and promote sustainable farming, the county government rolled out the following initiatives:

- Vaccinated a total of 16,322 livestock against diseases reducing mortality and disease incidences. This has improved productivity, directly benefiting 2,830 farmers.
- Distributed a total of 6.58 MT of certified green gram seed to 3,290 farmers, cushioning them from the high cost of farm inputs.
- Formed a ward-based SACCO and awarded inclusion grant of Ksh 1,000,000 to support farmers in saving and accessing credit.
- Established a $\frac{1}{4}$ -acre Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) demonstration farm at Kwa Nzoongo under FLLoCA and equipped with a solar pumping system.
- Conducted training for farmers on CSA, pasture management, and breed improvement to enhance adaptive capacity and sustainable resources use under FLLoCA.
- Promoted household food security and climate resilience through the distribution of 140 kitchen garden units (70 vertical sacks and 70 conical gardens) and 300 kg of pasture grass seeds for improved livestock feed under FLLoCA.
- Strengthened livelihood diversification via breed improvement, providing six gala goats to organized community groups under FLLoCA.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government has:

- Constructed new classrooms for five ECDE centers namely; Syandani, Kikwasuni, Ndivuni, Matulani and Ilani ECDE centres, providing conducive learning environment,
- Confirmed 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 38 ECDE centers enhancing the quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved an increase of 8.7% in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,213 in 2022 to 1,318 in 2025, attributed to the ward's ECDE interventions.
- Supported 606 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 Form One entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Constructed and operationalized Ivingoni dispensary serving a catchment population of 915, with an average monthly workload of 336.
- Engaged 168 Community Health Promoters to foster primary health care.





Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Provided assistive mobility devices to 22 persons with disabilities to enhance self-reliance
- Supported 13 young people with tools of trade under Ujuzi Teketeke to start their own businesses.
- Supported 114 elderly individuals with food and non-food items to enhance their well-being, along with medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,211.
- Organized safe spaces forum benefiting 246 school-going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention
- Facilitated 37 ward teams to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward league games and provided sports items enhancing sports development at grassroot level.

Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Constructed Ivingoni/Nzambani ward Office block to enhance service delivery at the ward level.
- Facilitated the election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening coordination, citizen engagement, and service delivery.

Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation within market centers and provide a conducive trading environment, the County Government:

- Engaged 27 cleaners to support market cleaning and waste collection across 12 markets, enhancing sanitation while enabling them to earn an income and improve their livelihoods.
