1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.






No. of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

The county government enhanced access to water through the following interventions;

- Rehabilitated Kwa Mutombi water project through construction of 100m³ sump, and distribution network. The project has five kiosks serving seven villages, Kako market, Kako health centre, Kako primary and secondary school and Kako special school.
- Constructed 3Km of pipeline extension from Miau earthdam serving a population of approximately 800 persons, Nduundune shopping centre, Miau primary and secondary school.
- Equipped and distributed Kyaluma borehole serving approximately 300 households, Kyowani and Kyaluma market
- Solarized and distributed Makaia borehole with a 34m³/hr yield, serving approximately 500 households in Sakai sub location, Sakai primary and Baselona shopping centre.
- Rehabilitated Waia earthdam and constructed 4Km of pipeline extension benefitting approximately 1,000 people, Kavingo, Malatani, Kwa Masai and Kasanova markets

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:

- Constructed new classrooms in three ECDE centers (Itulu, Kyaume and Kilungu), creating a conducive learning environment.
- Confirmed 31 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable
- Distributed teaching and learning materials to 36 ECDE centres enhancing access to quality early childhood education
- Achieved 8.3% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,001 in 2022 to 1,084 in 2025, as a result of the ward's ECDE interventions.
- Supported 811 bright and needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 Form One entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Road Access and Connectivity

The county government improved road network accessibility and connectivity through the following interventions:

- Opened 37.5Km and graded 124.4Km of road across the ward enhancing connectivity.
- Installed drainage structures such as 184m of culverts and 40 gabion boxes improving road conditions during the rainy season.
- Constructed five drifts i.e Kwa Mwanzau, Savani, Kyamangatu and Miseseteni-Malatani drifts connecting institutions and villages as well as stimulating economic development in the ward.
- Excavated 15,361m³ of catch water mitre drains across the ward as a way of transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- In partnership with REREC, connected 95 households and Kako warehouse with electricity increasing safety, security and promoting green cooking.
- Installed Kitongu market floodlight to enhance security in the area.
- Through Wote Municipality, installed solar-powered high-mast floodlights in Kako, Kyaluma & Uviluni markets, improving security and business activities while promoting renewable energy use.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

In efforts to enhance food security, household income and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed 6.602MT of certified seeds to 4,598 farmers improving household food security, income, and resilience against high input costs.
- Vaccinated 40,502 livestock and birds against pests and diseases benefitting 3,217 farmers.
- Stocked Miau Earth Dam with 2,000 fingerlings promoting aquaculture development.
- Supported Angukia Youth Group with 12 beehives to promote sustainable beekeeping and honey production.
- A ward SACCO was inaugurated and granted Kshs 1,000,000 inclusion grant.
- Under the NARIGP program, supported 800 farmers in mango and poultry value chains. Excavated 20 farm ponds for water conservation and constructed a sump tank at Kwanguni Sand Dam to improve access to water for irrigation.
- Under KCEP CRAL, constructed Kako warehouse to support farmers in reducing post-harvest loses. It also supported 56 groups in poultry value chain.

Universal Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare, the county government:

- Distributed essential medical commodities to all health centers across the ward to improve access to healthcare services.
- Installed water harvesting structures at Mituvu Dispensary, Kisoi Munyao Dispensary, and Kaseveni Health Centers.
- Fenced Kyaluma Health Center and Mituvu Dispensary.

Security of Land Tenure

Conducted legal advisory clinics on land and succession matters, reaching 652 People. 100 households are expected to benefit from the program promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of succession disputes.





Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Supported 22 persons with disabilities with assistive mobility devices promoting self-reliance.
- Benefited 113 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.5% of the ward's elderly population of 2,067.
- Supported Kako special school with foodstuff benefitting a total of 40 children enhancing their well-being.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 148 (60 boys, 88 girls) school going children.
- Facilitated 51 teams in various disciplines to participate in ward Ligi Mashinani games and provided sporting equipment promoting sports development at grassroots level.

- Supported the election of development committees across village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels.
- Established ward sand management committees, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
