1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No. of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce the distance to water points, the county government:

- Desilted Kyamakuthi earth dam to a capacity of 47,233m³, serving a population of approximately 10,000.
- Desilted and rehabilitated Kwa Ivali earthdam to a capacity of 35,000m³ benefiting approximately 3,000 people.
- Desilted Kwa Muthama earthdam to a capacity of 30,000m³, serving a population of approximately 1200 people.
- Constructed Muambe earth dam with a capacity of 30,000m³, serves a population of approximately 2,000 people.
- Drilled and equipped Mukelenzu borehole with a yield of 12.6m³/hr, alongside the construction of a 12.6km pipeline network and 11 water points, expected to serve approximately 3,200 residents and six shopping centres.

Road Access and Connectivity

The county government improved road network accessibility and connectivity through the following interventions:

- Opened 30km, graded 266km, and graveled 10km of roads, improving accessibility and connectivity across the ward.
- Promoted “roads for water” initiative through excavation of 3,352m³ catch water mitre drains, contributing to climate-resilient infrastructure and enhancing water availability for agricultural production.
- Connected 81 households and 2 institutions to electricity through the REREC matching grant programme, improving living standards and boosting local economic activity by providing reliable power for homes and businesses.

Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation within the market centers, the county government:

- Implemented cleaning and waste management in 14 markets, creating jobs for 45 people
- Constructed sanitation blocks at Syokilati and Syotuvali markets improving hygiene in the market



Agricultural Production and Productivity

To boost food security, enhance farmers' incomes, and promote sustainable farming, the county government implemented the following initiatives:

- Distributed 10.64MT of certified green gram seed to 5,320 beneficiaries to promote pulse production.
- Mapped and profiled 7,081 farmers to enhance access to agricultural extension services.
- Through NARIGP, supported 50 groups across four (4) value chains i.e. Tomato, mango, green grams & poultry through provision of Agricultural equipment and machines i.e Feed formulation equipment, threshers, incubators and brick-making machines and water tanks.
- Established a Ward-based SACCO that was awarded an inclusion grant of Kshs 1,000,000 to support operations.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;


- Supported 142 elderly persons and persons with disabilities with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscription enhancing access to health care services.
- Facilitated 73 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward games and issued with sports items promoting sports development at grassroot level.
- Organized safe space engaging 173 school going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention



Health Services

Access to essential primary healthcare was achieved through:

- Engaging 322 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) under 15 community health units to implement primary healthcare at the community level.
- Renovation of Kathulumbi and Mutembuku Health Centres, and construction of Katangi dispensary maternity block with a total catchment population of 31,800.
- Distribution of essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.



Security of Land Tenure

- Prepared Kathulumbi & Kalawa market plans which were approved by the County Assembly. Implementation of the plan will guide future construction and investment to promote local trade, improve livelihoods, and support economic growth.
- Conducted Legal advisory clinics focusing on land succession matters reaching 561 People. 100 Households are expected to benefit from the program promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes



Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:

- Constructed new classrooms for Seven (7) ECDE centers - Ngamu, Mweleli, Ngungi, Syongungi, Mwaani, Syokilati and Kasooni primary schools - creating conducive learning environment.
- Confirmed 40 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring stable service delivery and improved livelihoods.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 41 ECDE centres, improving access to quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved 12.3% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from the year 2022 to year 2025, as a result of targeted interventions.
- Supported 809 needy and bright students with bursaries, including full scholarships for 6 Form One entrants, to enhance retention and progression in learning institutions.

Governance



To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government:

- Supported the organization and election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels.
- Established ward sand management committees, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
