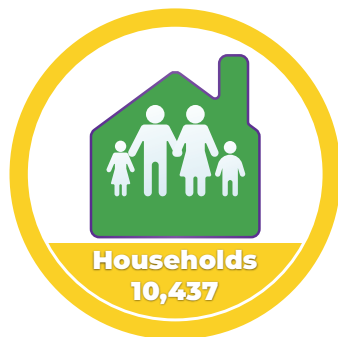

1.0 Introduction

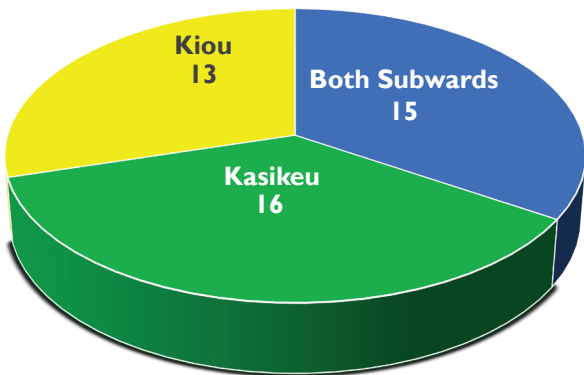

The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.

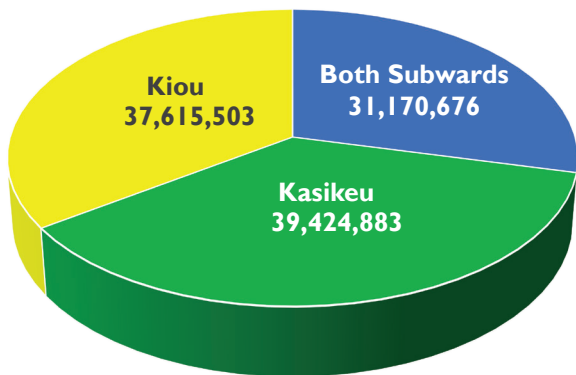

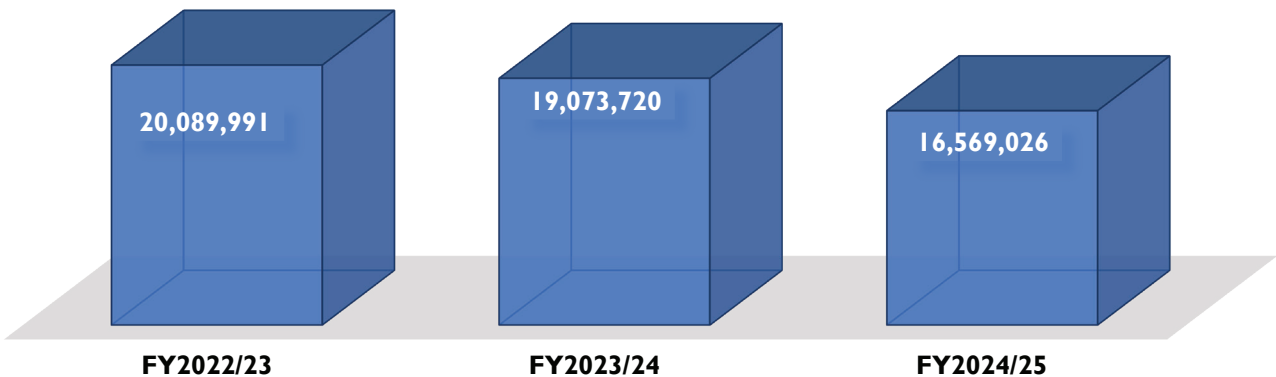
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

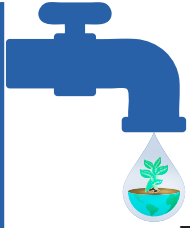


Budgets Allocation for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25 (Ksh)

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce distances to water sources, the county government:

- Distributed Kisaulu borehole which has a yield of 5m³/hour to Yale shopping centre, benefitting approximately 250 households.
- Drilled Muatineni borehole with a yield of 30m³/hour and distributed water to Sultan Hamud Hospital and Kwa Mbita village in partnership with Water Mission Kenya, benefitting approximately 200 households.
- Replaced Mikuyu II pump and distributed water to Uvilani village and Kasikeu health center, benefitting approximately 500 households
- Drilled Masokani borehole with a yield of 1.5m³/hour and installed 800m pipeline with one water point, benefitting approximately 250 households, Masokani market, Masokani primary and secondary.

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the County Government:

- Opened 103.5km of roads, graded 241.2km and graveled 7.3km, improving road accessibility and connectivity across the ward.
- Installed 126 m of culverts, 9 scour checks, and 169 gabions to manage water flow, prevent erosion, and enhance road resilience to adverse weather conditions.
- Excavated 1,139 m³ of mitre drains, contributing to climate-resilient infrastructure and improved drainage
- Constructed three drifts: Kating'ila, Mutweamboo and Kwothithu drifts, improving road connectivity and accessibility during the rainy season.
- Installed Kasikeu market floodlight improving security and promoting economic activities by extending operating hours.
- Connected 48 households and Kandolo borehole with electricity enhancing access to reliable power sources.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Vaccinated 21,921 cattle and dogs against diseases, benefiting 3,121 persons.
- Distributed 3.8 MT of certified maize and bean seeds to 1,552 farmers, cushioning them against the high cost of farm inputs.
- Formed Kasikeu ward-based SACCO and provided seed capital of Kshs.1,000,000 to enable farmers to access credit.
- Through SIVAP, 16 farmers and 16 groups benefited from small solar driers, including the supply and delivery of assorted equipment and materials to support solar drying of vegetables and fruits
- Expanded and fenced Chief Kiamba earth dam through KCEP CRAL programme to provide water for irrigation and livestock.

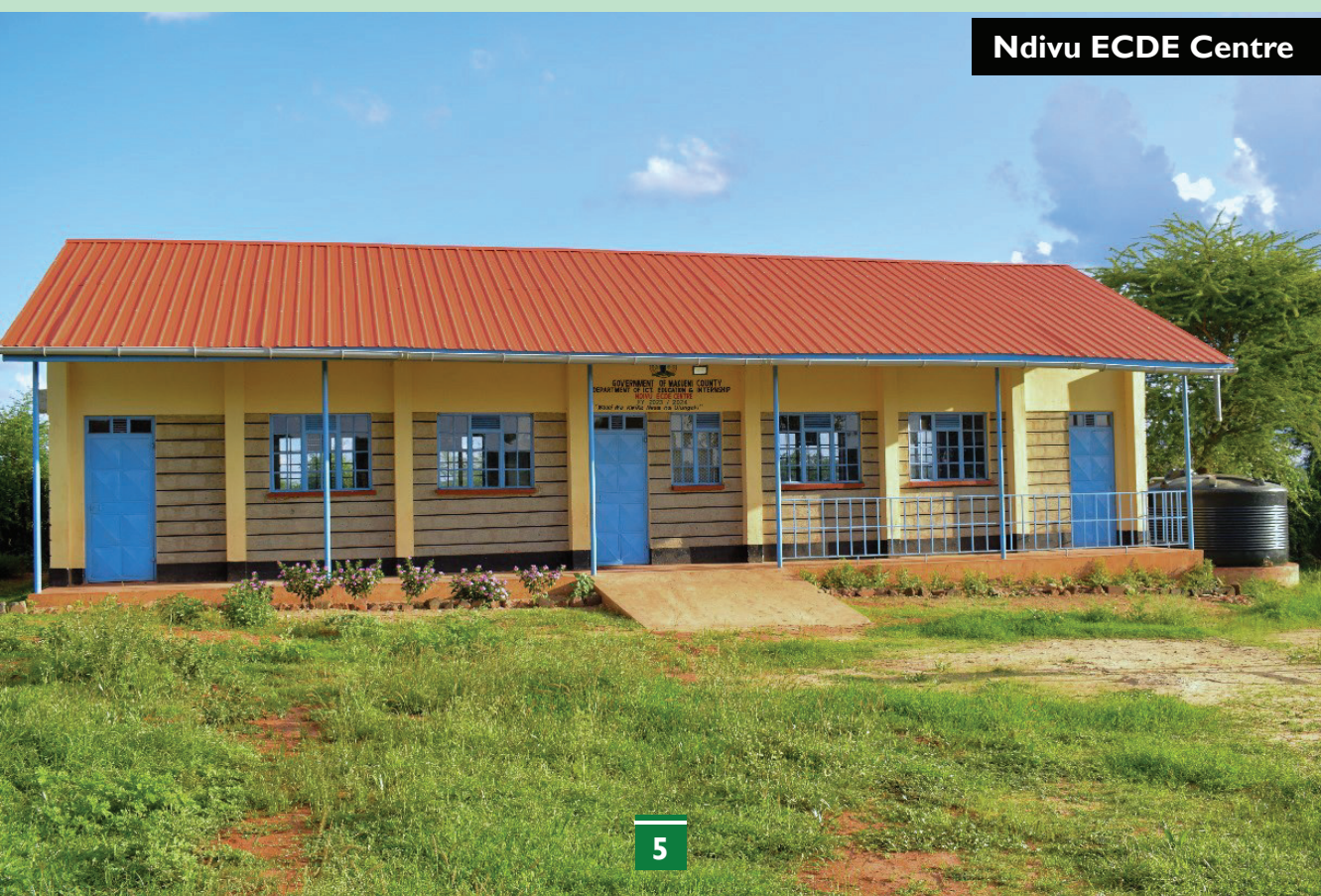


Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed five (5) new ECDE classrooms at Ndivu, Kathikwani, Kwa Mbumbu, Kwa Kalelo, and Ngiluni ECDE centres, providing a conducive learning environment for learners
- Converted 43 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 53 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 737 needy students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Health Services

Efforts to enhance access to healthcare services were achieved through the following interventions:

- Distribution of essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities
- Infrastructural development in four health facilities namely: Fencing and staff house for Mbiini dispensary, Ngalana dispensary fencing, renovation of Kasikeu health centre and completion of Kiou top dispensary with construction of a staff house, serving a total catchment population of 12,444.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Benefited 114 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 3.9% of the ward's elderly population of 2,902.
- Organized safe spaces forums for school going children reaching 112 boys and girls to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention
- Provided foodstuffs to PWD institutions, including Landu Small Home and Mutweambo Small Home
- Facilitated 25 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward league games and provided sports items promoting sports development at grassroot level



Security of Land Tenure

To enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Conducted a legal clinic and identified 50 households for land succession support, with drafting and filing of succession petitions.



Public Sanitation

To promote trade and stimulate economic growth, the county government:

- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in eight (8) markets namely: Sultan Hamud, Kasikeu, Muangini, Mbiini, Kayata, Kiongwani stage, Kima market and Ngokomi while engaging local residents across the ward.
- Surveyed and planned Kayata market enabling future construction and investment to promote local trade, improve livelihoods, and support economic growth



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Facilitated the organization and execution of elections for development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels.
