## 1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




### No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

### Water Access and Environmental Conservation

The County Government has enhanced access and reduced distance to water points through the following interventions:

- Constructed over 115 farm ponds with average capacity of 40,000 cubic meters, enhancing water harvesting at household level for climate smart agriculture.
- Drilled a replacement borehole for Kathamboni water project with a yield of 18 cubic meters/hr, benefiting 750 households, Kathamboni Primary and secondary schools and Kathamboni dispensary.
- Rehabilitated Kwa Ng'ondu borehole pumping system serving 600 households, Kwa Ng'ondu & Kateiko primary schools, Kwa Kavisi dispensary, and Kateiko market.
- Rehabilitated and enhanced Kikuu-Kiangini Water Project, benefiting 400 households as well as St. Bakhita and Kiangini Primary schools.
- Solarized and rehabilitated Itumbule borehole, enhancing supply of water to 300 households, Itumbule primary & secondary schools and Itumbule market.
- Desilted Kyambusya earth dam, benefiting 150 households.
- Enhanced and rehabilitated Kaiani borehole water project through the installation of additional solar panels and a new pump, benefiting 350 households, Kaiani Primary School, and Kaiani Market.
- Installation of solar-powered pumping system and distribution of Kwa Mbila earth dam, serving 300 households.
- Desilted Londokwe earth dam to increase water harvesting for 100 households.
- Desilted Kikuu/Kiangini water sump to restore its 225 m<sup>3</sup> capacity and expanded water supply by connecting five community water points, Kiangini Health Centre and four schools Under FLLoCA program.

## Public Sanitation

To improve public sanitation, the county government;

- Constructed 3 modern public toilets at Ikaasu, Yemulwa and Kavumbu markets, enhancing access to sanitation services.
- Constructed a modern public sanitation facility in Kathonzweni town.



## Road Access and Connectivity

The county government improved road network connectivity and electrification through the following interventions:

- Opened 48.8km, graded 96.8km and graveled 5.8km of roads, improving accessibility and transportation of people and goods.
- Promoted conservation agriculture through construction of 660m<sup>3</sup> of mitre drains.
- Installed 11 solar powered floodlights at Mutini, Kiangini, Kyunyu, Ngomano, Thavu, Mburo, Nzau, Kavumbu, Kiluluini markets, enhancing security in markets.
- Installed 20-meter solar-powered high-mast floodlights in 3 markets, improving security, and business activities while promoting renewable energy use.



## Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government:

- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand conservation and utilization.
- Supported the organization and elections of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening governance at grassroots level.
- Supported election of market committees responsible for the management of market activities.




## Agricultural Production and Productivity

In an effort to enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed 1,064 Kgs of Sorghum and 712 Kgs of Green grams seed to 665 farmers, contributing to increase in agricultural production.
- Promoted dairy value chain through provision of 729 Artificial Insemination services through cooperatives.
- Vaccinated 67,746 livestock, poultry, and dogs against pests and diseases, benefiting 2,574 farmers.
- Mapped, trained and issued fruit fly control baits and solar bags to 1,004 farmers, creating low pest prevalence zones.
- Excavation of Kwa Kilui and Kwa Mbuta earth dams to support irrigation, serving approximately 550 households under KCEP CRAL program.
- Formed ward-based SACCO that was awarded an inclusion grant of Kshs 1,000,000 to support its operations
- Supported climate-smart agriculture (CSA) interventions through the establishment of a demonstration farm, distribution of 153 kg of pasture grass seed, 50 vertical sacks, and 75 conical gardens, enhancing household food security, under FLLoCA.

## Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare, the county government implemented the following interventions;


- Distribution of essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Construction of staff quarters at Kiangini Dispensary with a catchment population of 1,458
- Fencing of Itumbule dispensary with a catchment population of 2,091
- Renovation of Kathonzweni Health Centre and Kwa Kavisi Dispensary with a catchment population of 9,843
- Engaged 114 Community Health Promoters supporting and offering primary health care services across the ward.

## Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed Ngomano and Kaiani ECDE centres, providing conducive learning environment
- Converted 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 42 ECDE centers, enhancing the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 820 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one, enhancing retention in learning institutions.

## Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To enhance the well-being and improve the livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Provided 4 groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for socio-economic empowerment.
- Supported 43 PWDs with assistive devices to enhance their self-reliance.
- Trained and issued tools of trade under Ujuzi Teke Teke programme to 10 youth (2 welding kits, 1 Mechanic toolkit, 2 Kinyozi kits, 2 Salon kits, 2 Carwash machines and 1 Water pump).
- Supported 113 elderly persons representing 4.9% of the ward's elderly population of 2,324 with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscription, enhancing access to health services.
- Provided dignity packs to 89 pupils, promoting menstrual hygiene for girls and personal hygiene for all learners.
- Mapped and assessed 600 persons with disabilities to acquire certificates and enable them access essential services

## Security of Land Tenure

To promote sustainable land use and urban development, the county government:

- Prepared a Physical and Land Use Development Plan for Kathonzweni town to enhance land security of tenure, promote investment, and support orderly market development.
- Conducted legal advisory clinics, focusing on land and succession matters reaching 740 People. This programme will ensure that, 100 households benefit from the program, promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes
