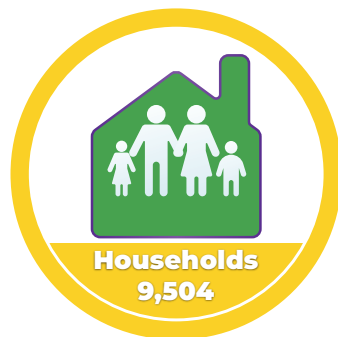

## 1.0 Introduction

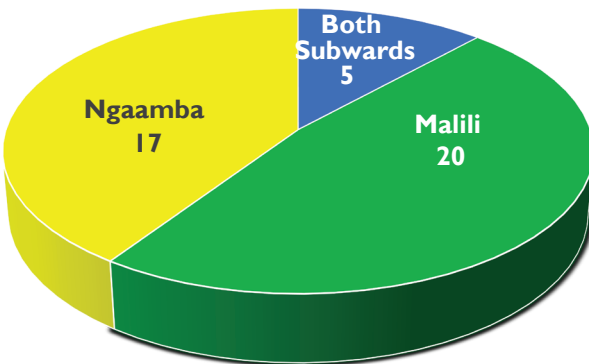

The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.

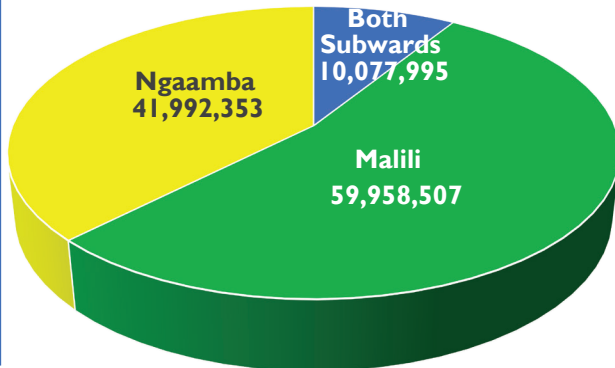

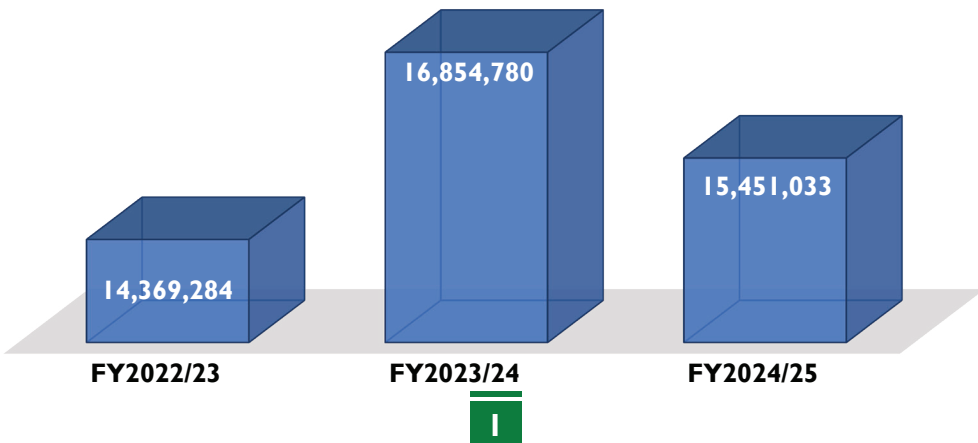
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

### Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce the distance to reliable water sources, the County Government:

- Desilted and expanded four earth dams (Kwa Loa, Kyunguni, Makaa and Katatu), benefitting approximately 1,100 households.
- Solarized Kiu borehole water project, which now serves approximately 1,000 households.
- Constructed Kwa Nditu sand dam in partnership with the local community, benefitting 350 households across eight villages by enhancing water retention and supporting ecosystem restoration.
- Rehabilitated Kwe Kuyu Gulley in Kalembwani, reducing soil erosion, restoring degraded land, and enhancing agricultural productivity and accessibility in the affected areas.

## Road Access and Connectivity

To improve road accessibility and enhance connectivity, the county government:

- Opened 65 kms of roads, graded 153km, and graveled 11.5kms, improving road accessibility and connectivity across the ward and facilitating smooth transportation and trade.
- Installed drainage structures including 156m of culverts, 50 scour checks, and 80 gabions, enhancing water management, preventing flooding and soil erosion, and improving road durability.
- Excavated 126m<sup>3</sup> of mitre drains, contributing to climate-resilient infrastructure and supporting sustainable road maintenance.
- Installed Mavivye market solar floodlight systems to improve security and spur economic activities by extending operating hours in the market.

## Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government;

- Distributed 1.3MT of certified maize and beans seed to 400 farmers, and 2.5MT of certified sorghum seed to 3,087 farmers, helping cushion them against the high cost of farm inputs.
- Formed Kima-Kiu/Kalanzoni ward-based SACCO and provided seed capital of Kshs 1,000,000 to enable farmers access credit.
- Provided one farmer with a Posho mill and supported other six farmers with pond liners under the KCEP CRAL programme.
- Issued solar driers to 16 groups, through SIVAP.

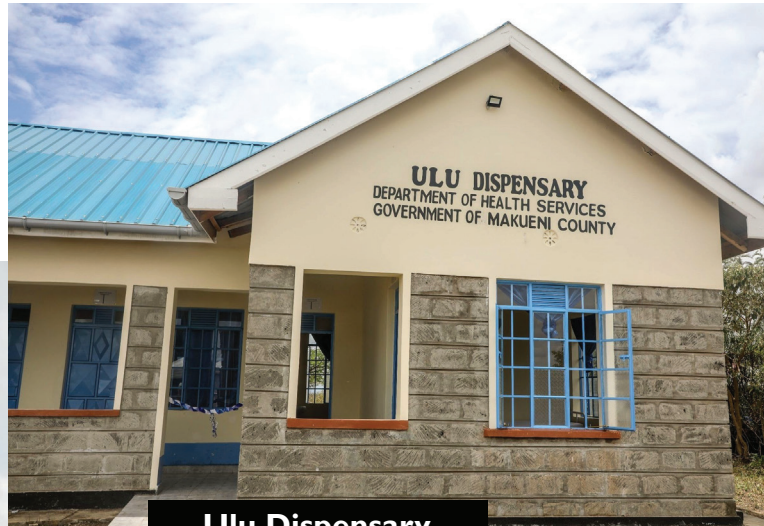




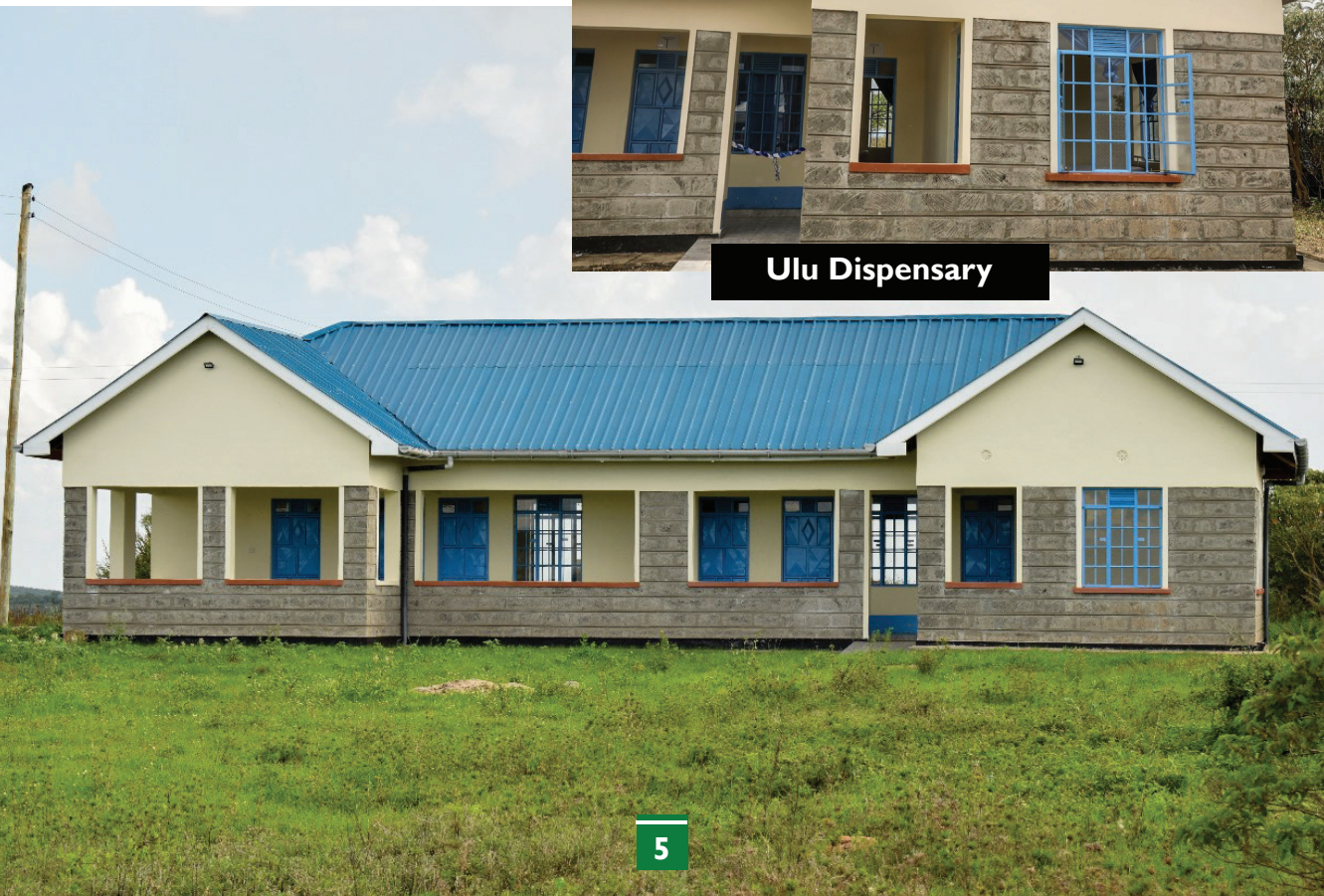
## Health Services

To enhance access to health care services, the county government;

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities
- Constructed Ulu dispensary and maternity block at Kavuko dispensary serving a total catchment population of 3,000.
- Engaged community health promoters to bridge the gap between the community and health systems.

## Access to Education and Training

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed new classrooms in 8 ECDE centers (Kwa Kea, Ulu, Kisse, Kilombo, Kwa Ndeke, Mwanyani, Marwa and Mawani centres), providing a conducive learning environment for early childhood education.
- Converted 38 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistence access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 46 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 598 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, enhancing transition and retention in learning institutions.

## Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Facilitated election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward and ward levels, enhancing coordination and service delivery.
- Constructed Kilome sub-county office to provide conducive working environment and enhance service delivery.







## Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Supported six organized groups by providing each with a 100-seater tent and 100 chairs, enhancing their capacity to conduct income-generating activities.
- Provided assistive mobility devices to 22 persons with disabilities to enhance self-reliance
- Supported 113 elderly persons with food and non-food items to improve their well-being, along with medical insurance subscriptions to enhance access to healthcare, benefiting 5.7% of the ward's elderly population of 1,995.
- Organized safe spaces forums for children, reaching 95 boys and girls
- Facilitated 28 ward teams to participate in ward league games and provided sport items, enhancing sports development at grassroots' level.
- Levelled Kiu play ground to provide reliable space to nurture sport talents.

## Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation within market areas and other public places, the county government;

- Conducted market cleaning and waste collection initiative in 8 markets, engaging 41 local residents across the ward.
- Constructed six public toilets to enhance sanitation at Ngiini playground, Mavivye primary, Kilome market, Marwa market, Kwa DC and Ulu market improving the trading environment and access to sanitation facilities
