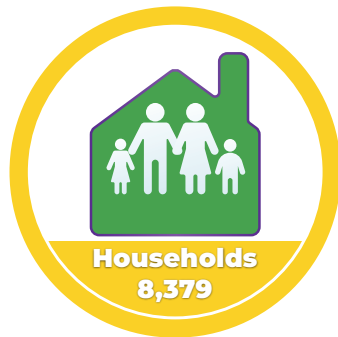

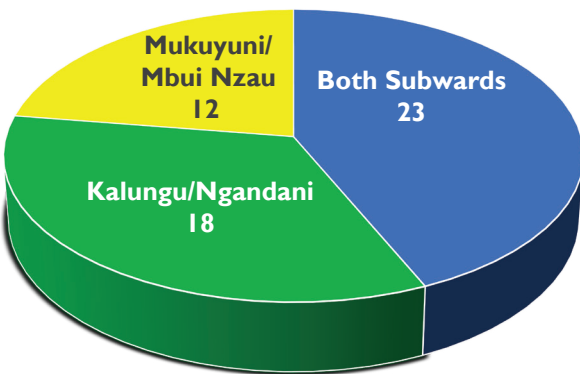
# 1.0 Introduction

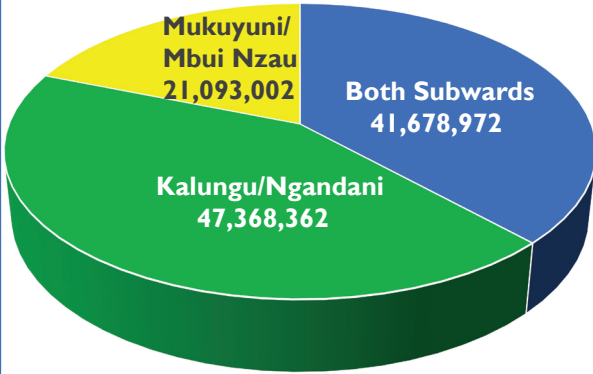

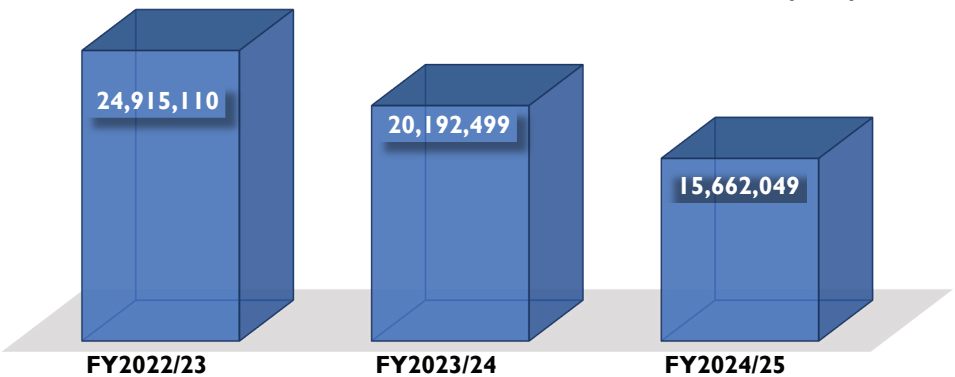
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

## 2.0 Achievements



### Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce distance to water sources, the county government:

- Extended Mbeetwani distribution line under KIBWASCO, increasing water access for households along the line.
- Connected Kilui Water project to electricity and expanded distribution, improving water supply for residents of Kalungu/Ngandani Sub-ward.
- Distributed Kithokoosyo water project to Miambani enhancing water access.
- Under Environmental Conservation: Constructed gabions along Mbeetwani road, reducing soil erosion, restoring degraded land, and enhancing agricultural productivity and road accessibility




Issuance of Water Extension Material



## Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road accessibility and connectivity, the county government:

- Opened 93km, graded 130km and graveled 7km of roads across the ward, enhancing accessibility to markets, schools, and villages.
- Installed 98m of culverts and 45 gabion boxes, improving drainage and ensuring roads remain passable during the rainy season.
- Constructed Kwa Kitavu slab, improving connectivity and easing movement for residents and traders.
- Excavated 5,550 m<sup>3</sup> of mitre drains, making roads more climate-resilient and supporting improved agricultural productivity.
- Installed 15 streetlights from Kibwezi BP to Posta, enhancing road safety and visibility.
- Installed Matundani grid electricity high mast floodlights and 6 solar floodlights at Kwa Kyai, Hola, Syembeni, Posta and Masalani markets, improving security and safety within the trading centres.

## Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Upgraded Kalungu dispensary through construction of a staff house and renovation of dispensary block, providing health services to a catchment population of 2,718.
- Renovated the old outpatient block at Kalulini health facility, which serves a catchment population of 5,823 with an average monthly workload of 1,478 clients.
- Paid medical bills to vulnerable population enhancing access to healthcare, easing the burden of high medical bills for the vulnerable population.
- Constructed Kyanginywa dispensary block to enhance access to health care services.



## Agricultural Production and Productivity

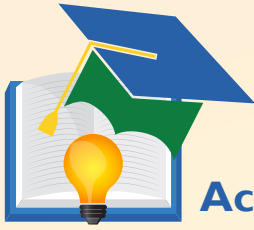
To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government;

- Vaccinated 6,194 livestock against diseases benefiting approximately 905 farmers.
- Promoted dairy value chain by issuing galla goats to 166 beneficiaries to boost household income.
- Constructed farm ponds through KCEP CRAL to promote irrigation.
- Rehabilitated Kalamba micro irrigation site to benefit over 800 households under SIVAP.
- Established a ward-based SACCO and awarded Kshs 1,000,000 inclusion grant to enhance farmer savings and access to credit.

## Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed Kwa Kyai ECDE center, creating conducive learning environment.
- Converted 15 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education
- Distributed teaching and learning materials to 26 ECDE centers, enhancing access to quality education.
- Achieved a 2.6% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,280 in 2022 to 1,313 in 2025, as a result of the ward's ECDE interventions.
- Supported 1,602 bright and needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6, enhancing retention in learning institutions.

## Governance

To strengthen governance, coordination, citizen engagement, overall service delivery and citizen participation at the ward level, the government:

- Facilitated the election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery.
- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand conservation and utilization.
- Equipped Kibwezi Resource Centre, providing the community with improved digital resources and a conducive environment for skills development and knowledge sharing.
- Responded to and successfully managed one fire incident in the ward through the Special Programmes Unit.



## Security of Land Tenure

To promote sustainable land use and enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Regularized informal settlements in Mjini, Kibwezi Town, covering 349 plots and improving security of tenure for low-income residents.
- Facilitated a legal clinic and succession-rights awareness campaign, assisting 50 households (approximately 355 residents) and initiating the drafting and filing of succession petitions





## Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Supported 20 organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for rental services, enhancing income generation and economic empowerment.
- Provided 26 youth with tools of trade through Ujuzi Teketeke program, promoting job creation and self-employment.
- Issued 253 beneficiaries with 6kg LPG gas cylinders, promoting clean cooking solutions.
- Supported 200 elderly persons with mattresses and blankets
- Supported Faith Based Organizations with a total of 1,375 chairs, enhancing socio- economic empowerment
- Supported 113 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions, representing 7.3% of the ward's elderly population of 1,558.
- Engaged 102 children under safe spaces programme, identifying key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention.
- Facilitated 45 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in Ligi Mashinani ward league games and provided sports items, enhancing sports development at grassroot level.
- Supported bobaboda sector through provision of motorcycles.

## **Trade Development and Cultural Promotion**

To provide a conducive environment for business operations, nurture talent and strengthen culture, the county government;

- Ensured cleaning and waste collection services in 5 markets through 32 resident casual workers, improving their livelihood.
