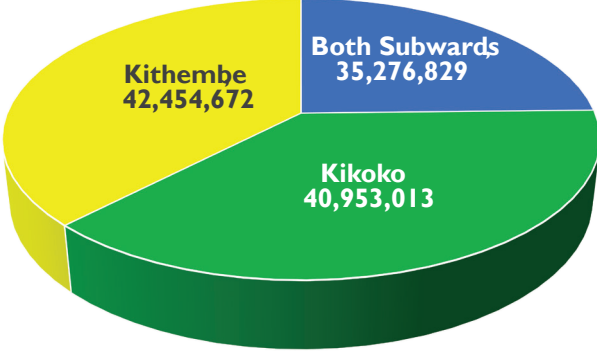
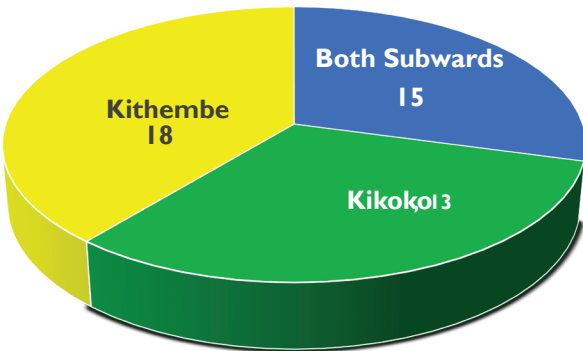
The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.

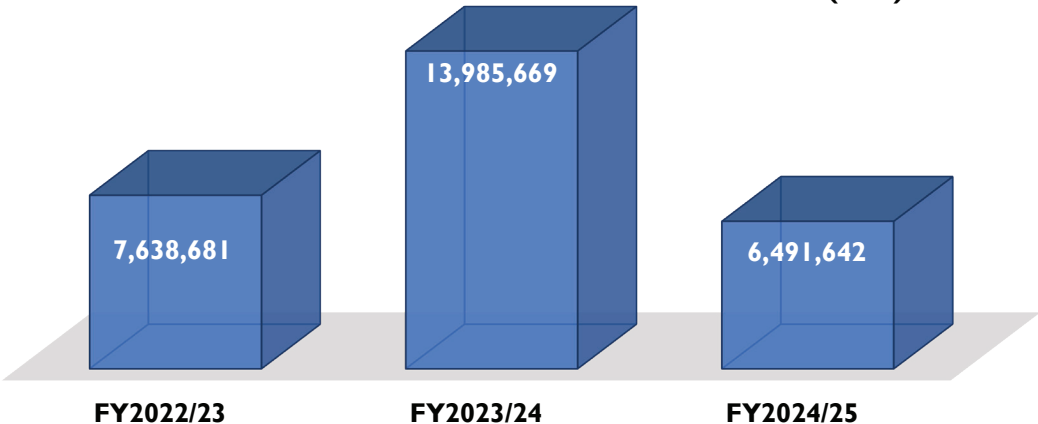


No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce the distance to reliable water sources, the County Government implemented the following interventions;

- Solarization of Ndiani water project, construction of two water kiosks, and laying of a 2.2km of pipeline extension, benefitting approximately 300 households.
- Enhancement of Ilovoto water project by constructing 2 additional weirs/sand dams and two gravity-fed distribution systems with seven communal water points, benefitting approximately 1,000 households under the FLLoCA programme.
- Distribution of Usi Uasa water project through a 4.5km pipeline to Mwanyani & Kyamatheka, benefitting 200 households.
- Construction of a 2.4km distribution line of Kikoko borehole with a yield of 2m³/hr, benefitting approximately 400 households and Kikoko Mission Hospital.

Road Access and Connectivity

To improve road access and strengthen connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 18.6 km, graded 60 km and graveled 6.9km of roads across the ward, improving accessibility to markets and institutions.
- Installed drainage structures including 281 meters of culverts, 158 gabions and 182 scour checks, which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season and minimized erosion.
- Constructed three drifts in the ward, namely Kyaka drift, Nduu drift and Kyangonye drift, enhancing connectivity between villages and supporting local economic activities.
- Excavated 3,406m³ of cut-off mitre drains through Miradi Kwa Jamii programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production as well as creating job opportunities for 156 community members.

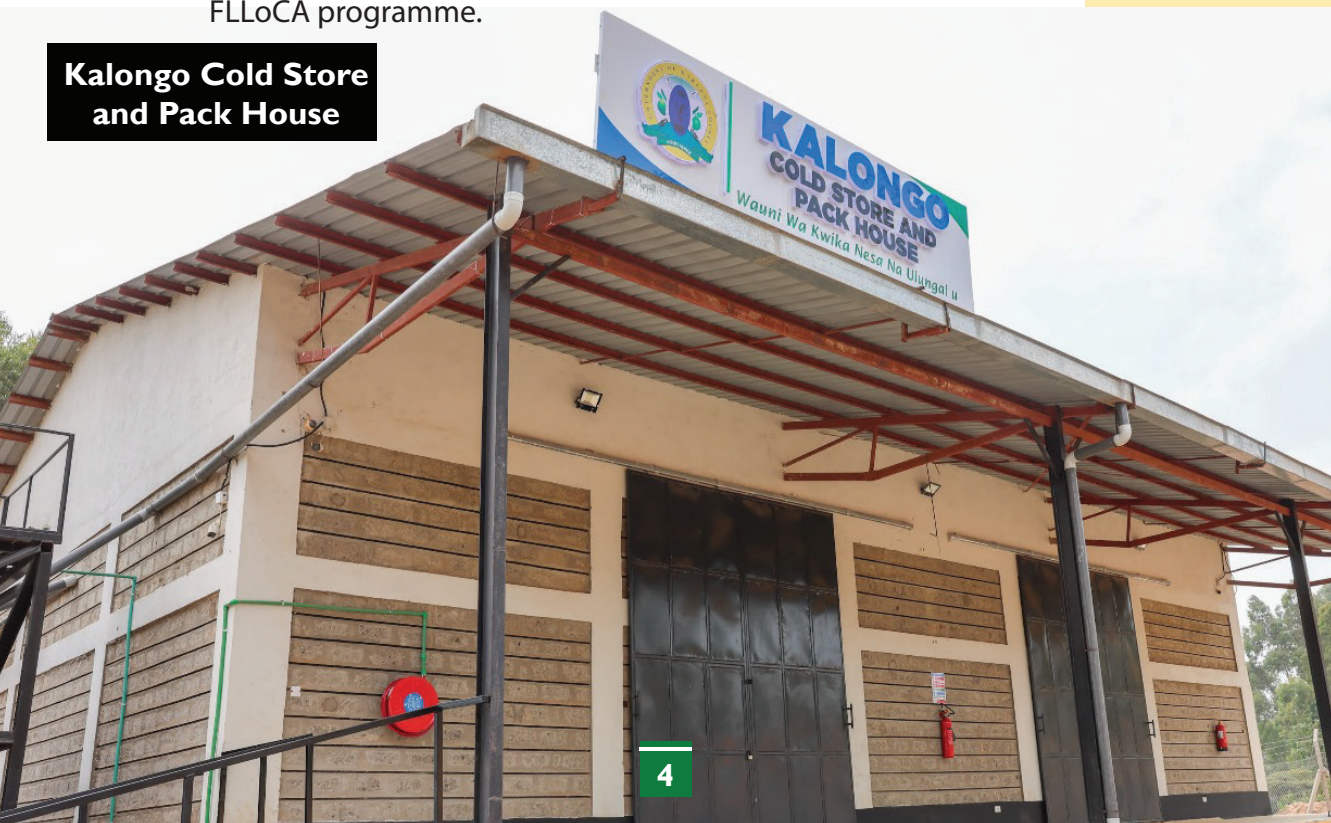


Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government;

- Distributed 20,606 scions of Hass Avocado for grafting to 1,200 beneficiaries under the Avocado Value Chain development program.
- Constructed Kalongo cold room and pack house to control post-harvest losses. The project is set to benefit 30,000 farmers once fully operational.
- Promoted Disruptive Agricultural Technologies such as biodiversity, climate smart technologies among others in 8 Cohorts resulting to a total of 6,500 farmers under NARIGP.
- Distributed 9.756 MT of certified maize seed to 4,878 beneficiaries with a yield of 29,270 MT, valued at approximately KSh 878 Million.
- Vaccinated 4,918 livestock; 1,804 against CCPP and 1,948 against Lumpy Skin Disease, benefiting approximately 1,404 farmers.
- Formed a ward-based SACCO and provided seed capital of Kshs 1,000,000 to enable farmers access credit.
- Promoted Climate Smart Agriculture by distributing 50 vertical sacks and 50 conical gardens as well as 600 avocado seedlings to farmers under the FLLoCA programme.

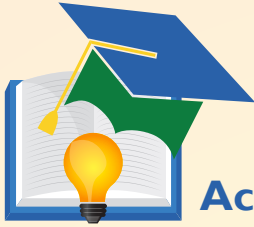
Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare, the county government

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Renovated and fenced Nyaani and Kyanganda dispensaries and installed gates, enhancing security and improving service delivery
- Engaged 97 Community Health Promoters in primary health care activities.
- Conducted two medical outreach campaigns within the ward, benefitting 120 people.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed classrooms in five ECDE centres: Muthethe, Kyakituku, Mutungu, Mutongu and Mutanda, providing a more conducive learning environment for young learners.
- Converted 26 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 38 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved a 6.4% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,257 in 2022 to 1,338 in 2025, as a result of the ward's ECDE interventions.
- Supported 1,523 bright and needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, ensuring retention and transition in learning institutions.
- Equipped Kauti CTTI enhancing access to quality vocational training.

Security of Land Tenure

To enhance access to secure and legally recognised land ownership, the county government:

- Regularized 104 commercial plots in Nunguni, issuing letters of allotment and initiating the processing of leasehold titles to ensure rightful ownership and investment confidence.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Supported 23 organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for hire, enhancing economic empowerment.
- Trained 65 beneficiaries in motor vehicle driving and issued them with licenses to secure transport related jobs.
- Supported 113 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 3.9% of the ward's elderly population of 2,921.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 144 school-going children, identifying key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention.
- Facilitated 37 ward teams to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward leagues games and issued sporting equipment promoting sports development at grassroots' level..

Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation and provide a conducive trading environment, the county government;

- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in six markets, engaging 22 local residents across the ward



Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Facilitated the organization and execution of elections for development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels.
- Established ward sand management committees, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
