1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Own Source Revenue Collected in the Ward (Ksh)




2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

The County Government has enhanced access to water and reduced distance to water points through the following interventions:

- Drilled, solarized, and distributed Kwa Matinga water project with a yield of 2m³/hr, serving 4 villages: Kwa Matinga market, Minzyoka and Kakuswi market.
- Rehabilitation of Kimandi borehole with a yield of 5.6m³/hr, benefiting approximately 600 people, Kimandi primary school and Kyambusya market.
- Drilled, equipped and distributed Kithongo borehole which has a yield of 7m³/hr benefiting approximately 720 households and Lung'u borehole which has a yield of 7.8m³/hr serving approximately 550 households.
- Expanded Ndumanu earth dam serving 500 households.
- Drilled and equipped Songeni water project which has a yield of 7.8m³/hr benefitting approximately 600 households.
- Solarized and distributed water from Kinze earth dam through Financing Locally-Led Climate Action (FLLoCA) program, serving approximately 1,800 people.

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government has:

- Constructed Ngwani drift, enhancing connectivity and transportation of farm produce to Tawa market.
- Opened 37Km and graded 245.5Km of roads, improving access and mobility to markets and public institutions.
- Installed 50 gabions to protect roads that were previously impassable during the rainy season.
- Excavated 4,899m³ of cut-off mitre drains, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure, while creating employment for 400 local residents.
- Installed five integrated solar floodlights at Nthongoni, Katungoli, Mbiiiani, Kwa Kulomba and Kavutini markets to enhance security and promote extended business hours.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To boost food security, improve farmers' incomes, and promote sustainable farming, the county government rolled out the following initiatives:

- Vaccinated 29,494 livestock, birds and dogs against pests and diseases benefiting approximately 1,930 farmers.
- Supported 56 groups in the mango, tomato and poultry value chains through provision of agricultural equipment and machines including, feed formulation equipment, threshers and incubators.
- Provided subsidized farm inputs to 1,800 farmers under the KCEP-CRAL programme, enhancing agricultural productivity.
- Formed Ward-based SACCOs, each awarded an inclusion grant of KSH.1,000,000 to support their operations.
- Capacity build farmers on Climate Smart Agriculture practices, pasture management, and aquaculture for sustainable climate adaptation under FLLoCA program.

Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Constructed an outpatient block and installed hospital Processor/Digital X-ray to improve health care access at Tawa sub county hospital, serving a catchment population of 27,128.
- Engaged 124 CHPs whose main function is to implement primary health care at community level.
- Constructed outpatient block at Kisau Sub-county hospital.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Supported 12 organized groups each with a tent and 100 chairs for social-economic empowerment.
- Provided 113 elderly individuals with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.5% of the ward's elderly population of 2,067.
- Supported Kakuswi school for the deaf with food items enhancing the wellbeing of the learners.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 242 school going children
- Facilitated 39 ward teams with sports items to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward games and provided sporting items promoting sports development at grassroot level.
- Levelled Iviani and Kiteta play grounds providing a sporting facility to nurture talents and enhance sports development.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:


- Constructed new classrooms in six (6) ECDE centers namely; Ngaa, Kalimani, Songeni , Kyooni, Muluti and Mulasya, creating conducive learning environment.
- Constructed dormitory at Kakuswi Vocational Training Centre to provide conducive accommodation for the boarding trainees.
- Confirmed 42 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education.
- Provided 64 ECDE centers with teaching and learning materials to enhance access to quality education.
- Supported 1,260 bright and needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 new form one entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Trade Development

To enhance production capacity and improve community-level value addition, the county;

- Supported Kingongi–Mivuko Women Group with a posho mill



Security of Land Tenure

To enhance urban development, access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Prepared Tawa town Urban Land Use Plan that will enhance development in the town.
- Conducted Legal advisory clinics focusing on land and succession matters reaching 600 People. 100 households are expected to benefit from the program promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes.



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
- Supported the organization and elections of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels strengthening governance at grassroots level
- Supported election of market committees responsible for the management of market activities.
