

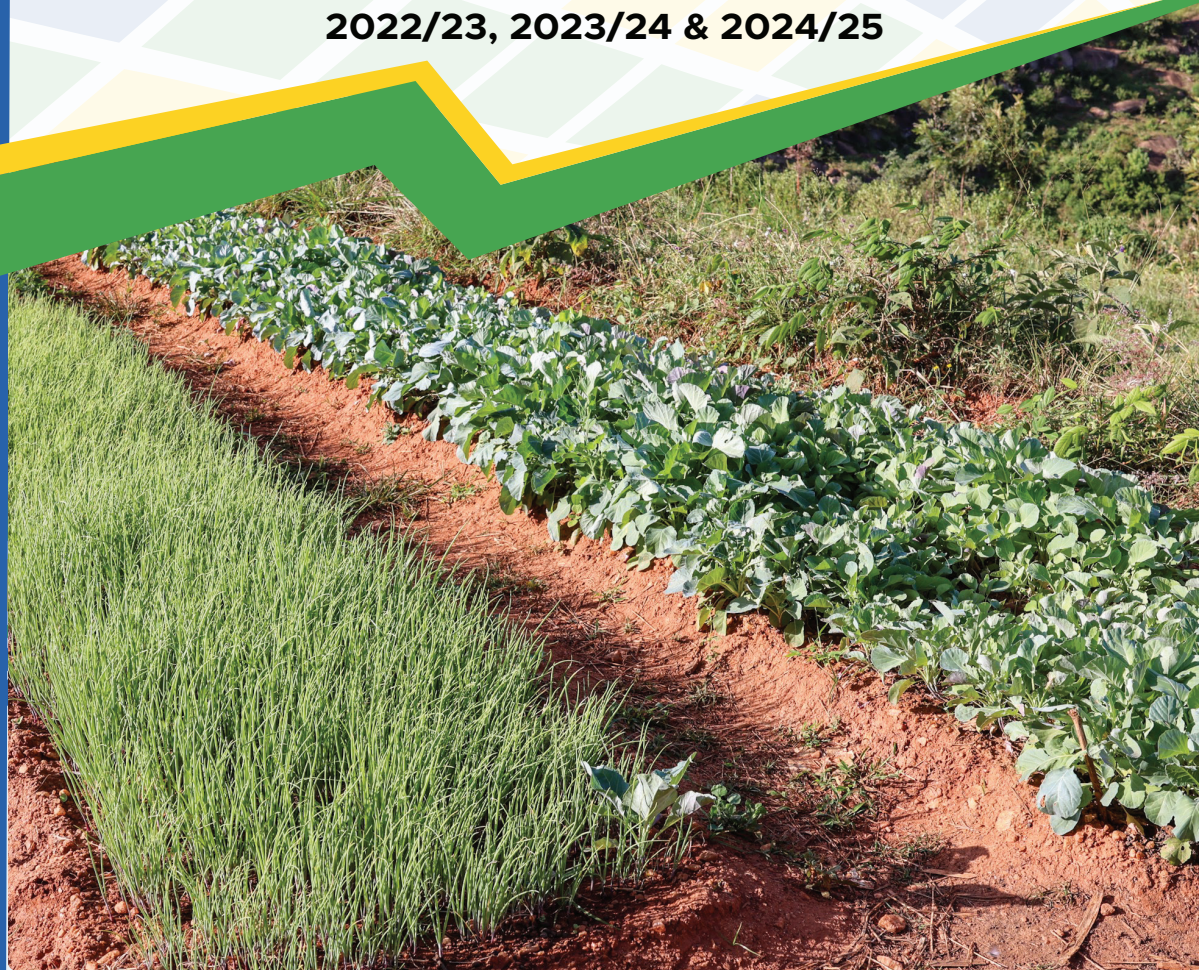

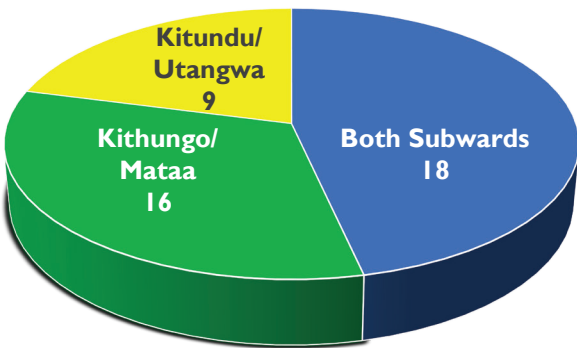
1.0 Introduction

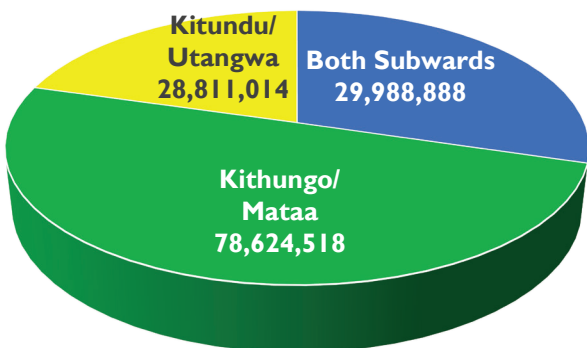

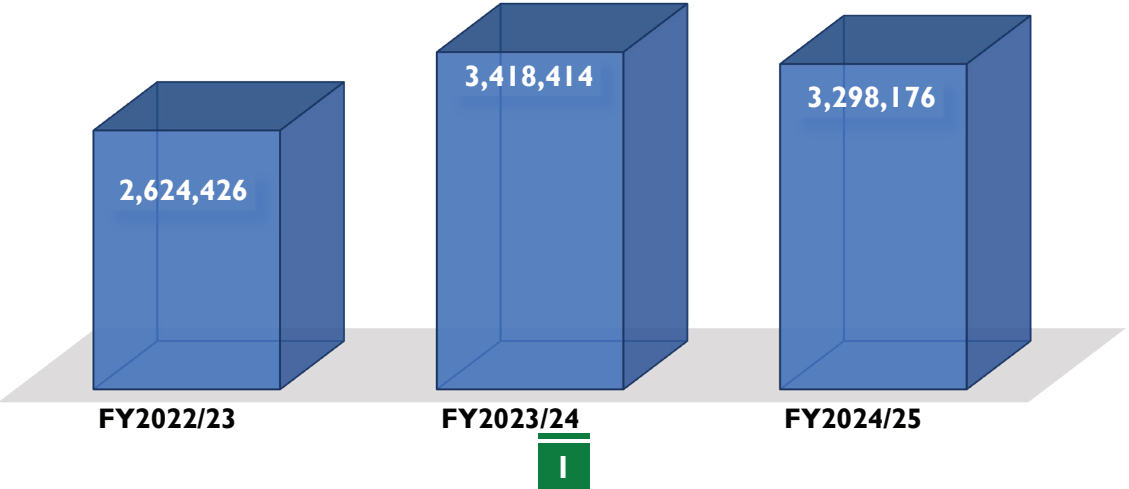
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

The County Government has enhanced access and reduced distance to water points through the following interventions:

- Extension of Kinyongo water project to Ngaani, Katunyoni and Kilenge primary school, benefitting approximately 500 households.
- Distribution and rehabilitation of Kiumi water project, serving community across 3 locations (Mataa, Kitundu and Kilyungi).
- Extension of Kyamuata water project, serving community across 3 villages (Kavukuni, Kyamuata & Kakuyuni).
- Rehabilitated Kitundu –Kilyungi pipeline, supplying water to two market centers, Kilyungi secondary school and Kilyungi primary school.
- Promoted irrigation through provision of pipes and fittings benefiting 10 groups, boosting agricultural production.
- Enhanced Isuuni/Kwa Kiseela water project through solarization, installation of pumping system, rehabilitation of pipeline network and construction of two communal points under Financing Locally-Led Climate Action program (FLLoCA).

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To boost food security, improve farmers' incomes, and encourage sustainable farming, the county government rolled out the following initiatives:

- Vaccinated 21,027 livestock, poultry and dogs against pests and diseases benefitting 560 farmers.
- Provided farm inputs at a subsidized price to 1,800 farmers, enhancing their productivity under KCEP CRAL program.
- Formed Ward-based SACCOs each awarded an inclusion grant of Kshs.1,000,000 to support their operations.
- Rehabilitation of Utangwa coffee factory serving approximately 150 coffee farmers.
- Established a model farm on Climate smart agriculture and issued 70 kitchen gardens start up kits to farmers under Financing Locally-Led Climate Action program (FLLOCA).

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government:

- Opened 42km, graded 281.5 km and graveled 6km of roads improving accessibility and linkage to markets, schools and health facilities.
- Installed drainage structures which include 225 gabions and 588m culverts to enhance drainage and protect road infrastructure.
- Excavated 11,562m³ of catch water mitre drains under the “roads for water” initiative, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure while enhancing water availability for agricultural production.
- Constructed Isuuni and Nyaa drifts, connecting institutions, markets and villages.
- In collaboration with REREC, connected 209 households enabling access to power for homes and businesses.
- Installed 5 grid-Powered floodlights at Yang’ang’a, Kyanzuki, katumani, Munyeetani, Muumani and 1 solar powered floodlight at Utangwa markets to enhance security and safety.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed two ECDE centres: Ngaani and Nzueni ECDE creating conducive learning environment.
- Confirmed 36 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education.
- Distributed teaching and learning materials to 41 ECDE centres enhancing access to quality education.
- Supported 635 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 new Form One entrants enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare the county government:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities enhancing healthcare delivery.
- Constructed and equipped Ngai health centre maternity wing.
- Constructed staff house at Utwiini dispensary.
- Renovated Utangwa dispensary.
- Engaged 82 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) to support primary healthcare across the ward.
- Organized a medical camp at Utangwa and a medical dialogue day at Kitundu, benefiting 700 households by providing essential medical services, health education, and promoting community health awareness.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Supported 6 organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for social and economic empowerment.
- Provided 10 youth with tools of trade under the ujuzi teketeke programme to start businesses.
- Supported 163 elderly persons with food, non-food and medical care subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 8.7% of the ward's elderly population of 1,881.
- Issued dignity packs to 74 boys and girls promoting menstrual hygiene for girls and personal dignity for the boys.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 114 school going children, identifying key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention
- Facilitated 34 ward teams to participate in Ligi Mashinani ward leagues promoting sports at the grassroot level.
- Levelled Kusyongali playground, providing a safe space for sporting activities.

Security of Land Tenure

To enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Conducted Legal advisory clinics focusing on land and succession matters reaching 467 People. 100 households are expected to benefit from the program promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes.



Trade Development and Public Sanitation

To improve public sanitation and create employment opportunities, the county government;

- Constructed two sanitation blocks at Kitundu and Kilyungi markets
- Engaged 9 cleaners to support market cleaning and waste collection across the markets.



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
- Supported the organization and elections of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels strengthening governance at grassroots level.
- Supported election of market committees responsible for the management of market activities.
