1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access and reduce distance to water sources, the county government:

- Constructed and distributed UYI earthdam in partnership with National Drought Management Authority (NDMA), with a capacity of 150,000m³. The project includes a water treatment plant, solar power installation, and a 5.5km pipeline extension, benefiting three shopping centres, two schools, and 11 villages.
- Enhanced Muliluni-Kiambani water project under FLLoCA through installation of a solar-powered Reverse Osmosis (RO) treatment system, providing clean and safe drinking water to the community.
- Extended Ngwata, Miami, kativani, and Yumbuni pipeline through KIBMAWASCO benefiting 8 villages.
- Enhanced Silimbi-Kalata water project through fencing and construction of Kwa Eliza kiosk benefiting approximately 8 villages.
- Improved Ovo Earth pan through fencing & levelling in order to continue supplying water to 16 villages.
- Upgraded Kiange/Kativani/Yumbuni pipeline through KIBMAWASCO supplying water to 8 villages.
- Rehabilitated 6.9km Ngwata water pipeline, benefiting a total of 19 villages in Miumoni cluster.
- Extended water Pipeline by 3.4Km from Masaku Ndogo to Mwaani, enhancing water supply to 6 villages.
- Desilted and expanded Ivuso earth dam enhancing water access to 12 villages.
- Extended Makutano-Makongeni-Masimbani-Mbondeni (Kwa Kalee) pipeline to Mwaani market by 6.3km, serving 16 villages.
- Extended Kyamulinzi pipeline by 3.5km, benefiting 10 villages
- Rehabilitated Ngwata borehole which serves 10 villages

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 5km of roads, graded 166.8km and graveled 32km improving road connectivity and accessibility within the ward.
- Excavated 1,963m³ of mitre drains, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure.
- Constructed Isunguluni–Cutline–Kyanguli–Masaku Ndogo road drift, connecting institutions and villages and installed 303m of culverts to improve drainage and ensure road remain passable during the rainy seasons.
- Connected 36 households and Mukaange Aggregation Center to electricity through REREC matching grant, improving access to reliable power and supporting local economic activities.
- Installed floodlights at Kativani, Kavatini, Makutano, Ndauni, Kithululu, Munyeze, Kithiiani, Kyanguli and Kiambani Markets to enhance security and extend trading hours.
- Installed 13 streetlights at Kativani Market in partnership with KPLC, enhancing security, visibility, and extended business hours for the local community.






Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government;

- Vaccinated 12,642 livestock against priority diseases directly benefiting 2,191 farmers.
- Constructed Ulilinzi livestock yard benefiting over 400 traders.
- Formed ward-based SACCO and awarded inclusion grant of Ksh. 1,000,000 to support farmers through saving and access to credit.
- Supplied 50 Langstroth beehives to two community groups in Muliluni Community Forest, along with 10 full sets of protective beekeeping gear and a honey extractor to enhance honey value addition and household incomes under FLLoCA.
- Advanced climate-smart agriculture (CSA) practices by establishing a 1/4-acre CSA demonstration farm, distributing 300 kg of grass seed for pasture improvement, and providing 100 kitchen garden units (50 vertical sacks and 50 conical gardens) under FLLoCA.
- Conducted farmer training and capacity-building sessions on CSA, pasture management, and apiculture, strengthening community resilience to climate change and supporting sustainable livelihoods under FLLoCA.

Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Constructed Ngwata maternity block, expanding maternity services and improving delivery outcomes for a catchment population of 7,153.
- Upgraded Kithyululu Model Health Centre through construction of a staff house and renovation of the maternity block, ensuring staff availability and improved services for a catchment population of 6,373.
- Fenced Katulye dispensary enhancing security with the facility serving a catchment population of 2,045.
- Paid medical bills for vulnerable households enhancing access to healthcare and easing the burden of high treatment costs.
- Engaged 128 Community Health Promoters in the provision of primary healthcare services.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:

- Constructed new classrooms for 5 ECDE centers (Ulilinzi, Yikitaa, Kiange, Kithito, and Kalima Koi), providing a conducive learning environment.
- Converted 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 41 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved a 5.4% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,514 in 2022 to 1,595 in 2025, attributed to the ECDE interventions in the ward.
- Supported 803 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 Form One entrants, improving retention and transition in learning institutions.
- Operationalized Utini CTTI enhancing access to vocational training.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Provided fourteen groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for rentals enhancing socio-economic empowerment.
- Issued 4 youth groups with pool tables, enhancing socio-economic empowerment among the youth.
- Supported 213 elderly individuals with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 9.4% of the ward's elderly population of 2,270.
- Trained and issued 15 youths with tools of trade under 'Ujuzi Teketeke' programme to start income-generating activities.
- Facilitated 43 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward league games and provided sports items promoting sports development at grassroot level

Public Sanitation

To improve sanitation and provide conducive trading environment, the County Government:

- Constructed public toilets at Makutano, Yumbuni, and Utini markets, providing clean and accessible sanitation facilities for traders and market users.
- Engaged 16 cleaners to support market cleaning and waste collection across 14 markets, enhancing sanitation while enabling them to earn an income and improve their livelihoods



Security of Land Tenure

To promote sustainable land use, the county government:

- Planned Kyumani Market enhancing orderly development.



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Facilitated the election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening coordination, citizen engagement, and service delivery.
