1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Road Access and Connectivity

The county government improved road network connectivity and electrification through the following interventions:

- Opened 45.6km, graded 117km, graveled 5.6km of roads to enhance accessibility and link markets, schools and health facilities
- Installed 64m of culverts and 31 gabions boxes drainage structures to improve storm water management and protect road infrastructure from erosion.
- Promoted “roads for water” initiative through construction of 420M3 of mitre drains, enhancing road resilience while supporting water conservation.
- Constructed Kwa Kitei, Mbulutini and Kwengala drifts connecting Mbitini and Kasikeu wards, thereby improving cross-ward mobility and boosting trade and access to services
- Installed Mutyambua market floodlight to enhance security and promote extended business working hours.

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access and reduce distance to water sources, the county government;

- Rehabilitated Ilengeni Water Project through construction of a treatment plant, installation of a solar-powered pumping system, and expansion of the distribution network from Ilengeni to Masue and Ngoto. It also supplies water to Kwothuku and Kwa Kiilu communal water points, serving approximately 300 households and 2 institutions.
- Drilled and distributed Mutyambua borehole water project in partnership with Water Mission Kenya.
- Enhanced Mbuthani water project through construction of reinforced concrete intake sump tank of 100 cubic meters, repair of pipeline to Kwa Mavoo and construction of a 6km pipeline to Mbuthani, Ndauni, Kasuvi and Ngese. Once complete it will benefit approximately 400 households and 2 institutions (Mbuthani primary and secondary schools).
- Planted over 200 trees at Muambwani Forest, Masue, and Kwa Mutisya to enhance environmental conservation and restore degraded landscapes.


Agricultural Production and Productivity

In efforts to enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions;

- Distributed 9.79 MT of certified maize seed and 600kgs of beans to 5,195 farmers in order to increase productivity.
- Vaccinated 29,328 livestock against pests and diseases, benefiting approximately 3,008 farmers.
- Provided 431 Artificial Insemination services to improve herd genetics and milk production.
- Formed a ward-based SACCO and provided seed capital of Kshs 1,000,000 to enable farmers access credit.
- Supplied pond liners with an average capacity of 800m³ under KCEP-CRAL to promote water harvesting and irrigation agriculture.
- 30 groups supported with demonstration materials for farmers' field school project, trained and sensitized to join SACCO under NARIGP.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:

- Constructed new classrooms in 6 ECDE centres namely: Mutyambua, Kyumbuni, Kavuthu, Ngoto, Yuuni and Kavuthu, providing a conducive learning environment.
- Converted 34 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 38 ECDE centres to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 1,006 needy students and full scholarships to 6 students joining form one to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Supported Masokani and Kithumani CTTIs with capitation and water harvesting equipment.

Health Services

To promote access to quality health care, the county government implemented a raft of interventions including;

- Distribution of essential medical commodities to all health centres across the ward.
- Construction of Mbitini dispensary outpatient block which has a catchment population of 1,469.
- Outreach campaigns contributing to improved health awareness and reduced maternal, infant, and child mortality.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Supported 16 organized groups with start-up kits comprising of tents and chairs for 12 groups and public address systems for four groups.
- Issued 22 persons with disabilities with assistive mobility devices to promote self-reliance.
- Supported 113 elderly individuals with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.1% of the ward's elderly population of 2,211.
- Levelled Mbeletu playground and supported 46 ward teams to participate in Ligi Mashinani ward leagues, promoting sports at grass root level.
- Trained and issued tools of trade under Ujuzi teke teke apprenticeship programme to 3 youth (1 salon kit, 1 tailoring Kit & 1 salon kit).

To enhance market sanitation and provide conducive trading environment, the County Government:

- Conducted market cleaning and waste collection initiative in six markets



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Supported the election of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels
- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand conservation and utilization.
