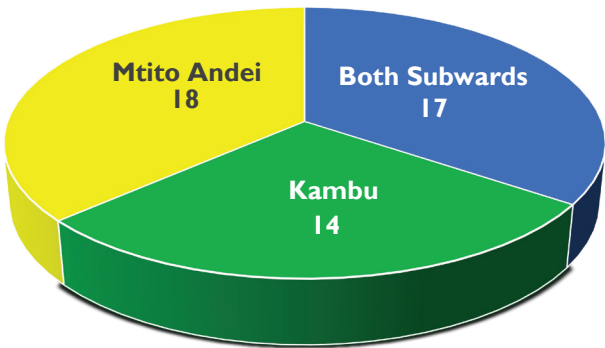
1.0 Introduction

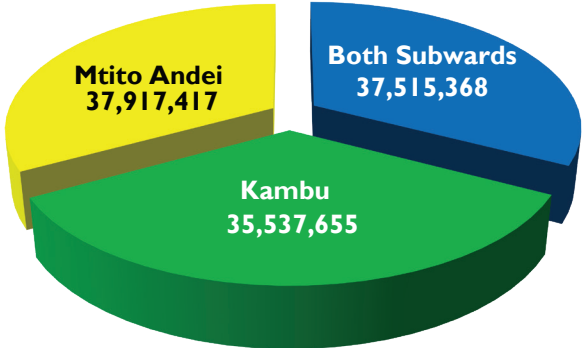

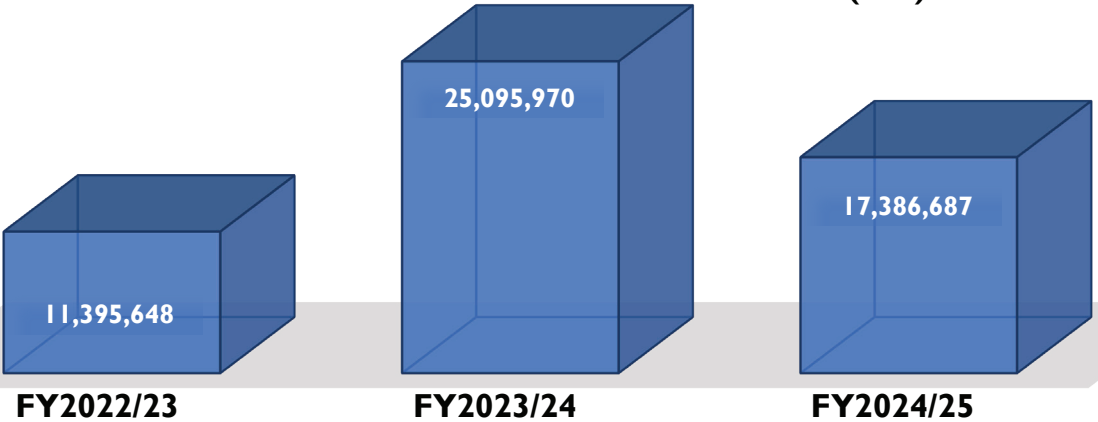
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access to water and reduce distance to water sources, the county government:

- Extended Ngai Ndethya river sump water to Nthunguni through a 6 km pipeline extension and installation of an elevated tank with three water points, benefiting approximately 600 households across three clusters.
- Rehabilitated Kambu-Kitegei Spring water project distribution line and tanks benefiting five village clusters.
- Distributed water from Kathekani borehole which has a yield of 5.5 m³/hr, through a 4 km pipeline extension to Mbetwani, benefiting over 400 households.
- Distributed water to Jua Kali village under KIBWAWASCO, serving over 350 households.
- Equipped and distributed Kwa Diana water project to Misuuni and Mavindini benefiting over 500 households.
- De-silted Kwa Kitwa earth dam and enhanced Ndauni dam, collectively benefiting approximately 400 households.

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government:

- Opened 36.9km of road, graded 101.1km and graveled 13km across the ward, improving connectivity to markets, institutions and villages.
- Installed drainage structures including eight meters of culverts and 20 gabions, ensuring roads remained passable during the rainy season.
- Excavated 2,466m³ of cut-off mitre drains, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure.
- Constructed two drifts along Kamulalani – Kalimani – Kitengei – Kilumilo – Yindundu – Athi-Makutani – Mikomani – Kambu River- Lukenya Junction – Ilikoni- Mwaani – Misani – Kamunyu – Ngiluni – Syusyani – Iviani road enhancing mobility and linking communities.
- Connected Lukenya University School of Medicine community to electricity through the REREC Matching Grant, enhancing access to reliable power and supporting academic, residential and institutional activities.
- Installed 15 solar market flood lights at Kyusyani, Mbeetwani, Songea, Kalimani, Mavindini, Makutano, Misuuni, Kwa Kinyuti, Nzoila, Mikomani, Kilumilo, Ngiluni and Iviani to enhance security
- Installed 84 streetlights at Kambu and Darajani in partnership with KPLC improving safety and security.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government:

- Vaccinated a total of 17,544 livestock and dogs, including 5,346 against CCPP (Contagious Caprine Pleuropneumonia), 3,136 against Lumpy Skin Disease, 1,672 against Rift Valley Fever, and 1,202 against Rabies, benefiting 2,214 farmers.
- Supplied 2MT of green gram seeds to 1,000 beneficiaries to cushion farmers on the high cost of seeds.
- Supplied 54 gallabucks to farmers
- Formed ward-based SACCO and awarded inclusion grant of KSh.1,000,000 to support farmers in saving and accessing credit.

Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Paid medical bills for the vulnerable population, enabling access to healthcare services and cushioning them against the burden of high medication cost.
- Conducted outreach campaigns on Non Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and provided medical services within the ward.
- Engaged 138 community health promoters in offering primary health care
- Operationalized the newly constructed Mtito Andei Andei Sub County Hospital built by Kenya Railways Corporation and equipped by David Sheldrick.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government:

- Constructed new classrooms for eight (8) ECDE centers (Kavungwa, Nzoila, Mavindini, Kathekani, Kilumilo, Yindundu, Mwaani and Silanga ECDEs), providing conducive learning environment.
- Converted 35 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 45 ECDE centres enhancing access to quality early childhood education.
- Achieved a 1.6% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,702 in 2022 to 1,729 in 2025, attributed to the ECDE interventions in the ward.
- Supported 960 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.
- Improved access to vocational training by equipping Mtito Andei Resource Centre and constructing a twin workshop at Ngwata CTTI.
- Increased access to ICT services through construction and operationalization of Darajani Community Information Center.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Supported 20 organized groups each with a tent and chairs for rentals enhancing socio-economic empowerment.
- Issued assistive mobility devices to 22 persons with disabilities to enhance self-reliance.
- Provided food and non-food items to 114 elderly persons along with medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5.2% of the ward's elderly population of 2,202.
- Issued dignity packs to 240 boys and girls promoting menstrual hygiene for girls and personal hygiene for the learners.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 145 school going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and interventions.
- Supported 31 ward teams to participate in 'Ligi Mashinani' ward league games and provided sporting items, enhancing sports development at grassroots level.

Security of Land Tenure

To promote sustainable land use, the county government:

- Resolved the long-standing boundary dispute between Makueni and Taita Taveta counties in Mtito Andei town, enhancing peace, inter-county cooperation, and revenue collection.
- Surveyed and beaconed public utilities in Mtito Andei town to reduce encroachment and pave way for urban development.
- Fast-tracked the excision of Ngai Ndethya Game Reserve to support human settlement, currently in progress

Public Sanitation

To improve sanitation and provide a conducive trading environment, the County Government;

- Engaged 23 cleaners to support market cleaning and waste collection across 5 markets.



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Facilitated the election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening coordination, citizen engagement, and service delivery.
- Responded to and mitigated two reported fire incidents, providing humanitarian support and enhancing community resilience against shocks and emergencies
