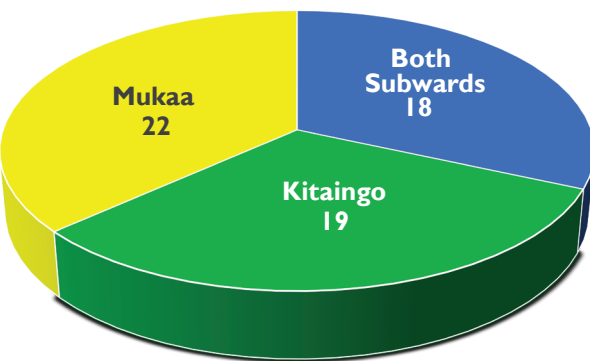
1.0 Introduction

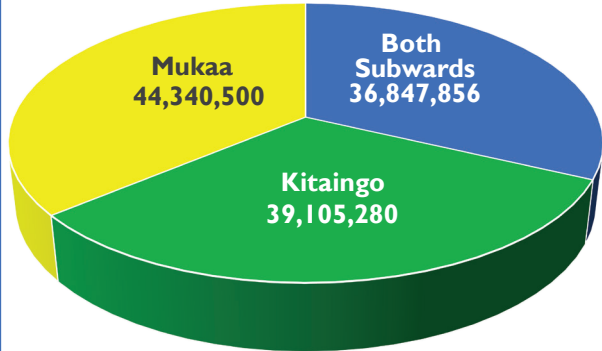

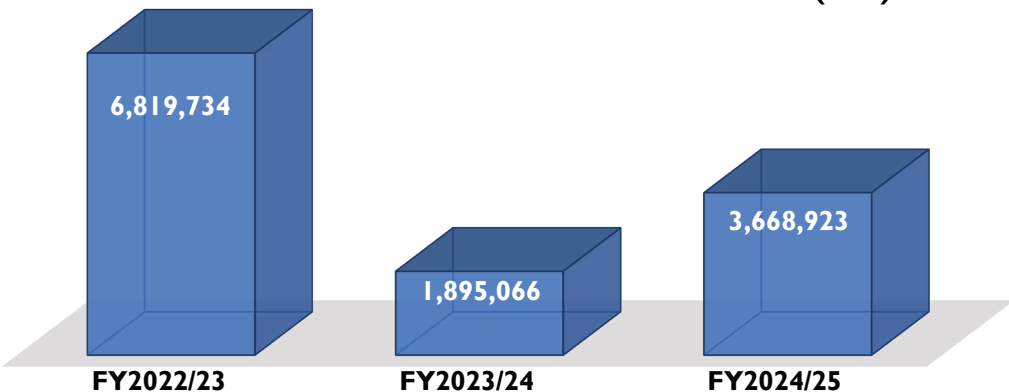
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25



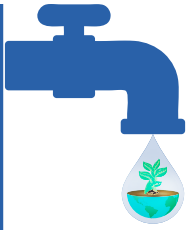
Budgets Allocation for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25 (Ksh)

2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access to water and reduce distance to water sources, the county government;

- Desilted and expanded Kwa Kakui earth dam by 8,000m³ and constructed a solar-powered treatment plant through Financing Locally-Led Climate Action program, benefiting approximately 300 households.
- Enhanced and distributed Kaketa Water Project, benefiting approximately 400 households by providing water for domestic use, livestock, and irrigation.
- Rehabilitated Kwa Muulu water project and distributed water benefitting approximately 350 households across 10 villages.
- Distributed Kamuthini borehole, which has a yield of 7.2m³/hr to Katalani and Muthitha increasing access to clean water for 350 households, Kamuthini primary and secondary and Muthitha primary school.
- Rehabilitated and distributed Kyanzisi sand dam water project including construction of a 50m³ sump and a 2km pipeline, supplying water to approximately 350 households.

Road Access and Connectivity

To enhance road access and improve connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 102.5km of roads, graded 147.5km and graveled 6.5km, improving access and enhancing road network connectivity within the ward
- Installed 136m of culverts and 30 gabions to manage storm water and prevent flooding, enhancing road safety and accessibility during the rainy season.
- Excavated 2,450m³ of cut-off mitre drains through the Miradi Kwa Jamii programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure and providing income-generating opportunities for 1,680 community members.
- Installed 6 solar floodlights in different markets across the ward i.e. Kamuthini, Kiongwani, Kyandue, Kyangala, Mutiluni, and Maiani, enhancing security and extending trading hours for vendors and residents.
- Connected 63 households with electricity in Muthitha village, improving living standards and boosting local economic activities.



Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation within market places, the county government:

- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection initiative in eight markets, engaging 13 local residents across the ward
- Constructed Kilome Market sanitation block, improving the trading environment and access to sanitation facilities.



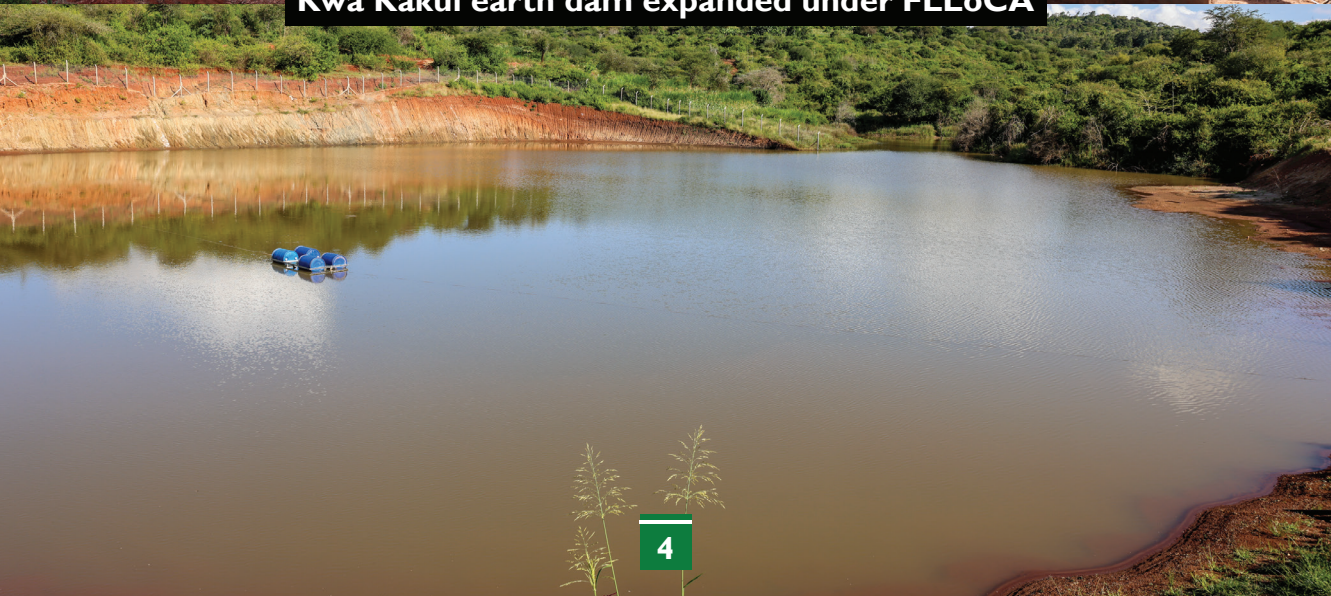
Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions;

- Vaccinated 1,791 cattle against pest and diseases, benefitting 1,526 farmers.
- Distributed 1.768MT of maize seed to 884 farmers, resulting in the production of 5,304 bags (90kg each) valued at approximately Kshs.23.9 million.
- Formed Mukaa ward-based SACCO and provided seed capital of Kshs 1,000,000 to enable farmers access credit.
- Distributed 2,500 high-value agroforestry seedlings (citrus and avocado) and planted soil-stabilizing grass splits along Kwa Kakui earth dam, promoting environmental conservation and sustainability.

Health Services

To enhance access to health care services, the county government:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities
- Renovated and equipped Uvete Health Centre, serving a catchment population of 7,000 and handling an average monthly workload of 1,478 patients.
- Completed Kamuthini dispensary injection room and equipped the maternity wing serving a catchment population of 1,100 with an average workload of 327 patients.
- Fenced Mutiluni health centre and equipped the maternity wing, ensuring security and rendering services to a population of 3,800.
- Renovated Enzai health facility serving a catchment population of 2,200 with an average monthly workload of 515 patients.

Access to Education and Training

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed new classrooms in four ECDE centres, namely: Kyandue, Kwa Kaseke, Uthini and Kwa Muatha, providing conducive learning environment for the learners.
- Converted 38 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 46 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Supported 722 needy and bright students with bursaries and full scholarships to 6 Form One entrants to enhance retention in learning institutions.
- Supplied training tools to Kitaingo CTTI to equip trainees with practical skills.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Supported 10 organized groups each with a 100 seater tent and 100 chairs for income generating activities.
- Provided assistive devices to 22 persons with disabilities to enhance self-reliance
- Benefited 113 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 5% of the ward's elderly population of 2,238.
- Organized Safe spaces forums for school going children reaching 105 (55 boys and 50 girls) to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention
- Facilitated 24 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in ward league games and provided with sports items promoting sports development at grassroot level.
- Levelled Uvete playground with construction of a toilet providing a sporting facility to nurture talents.
- Mapped and assessed 229 persons with disabilities to acquire certificates and enable them access essential services.

To enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Conducted a legal clinic and succession rights awareness campaign, reaching 100 households and initiating succession petitions

Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Responded to emergencies by assisting in the rescue of individuals in two reported drowning incidents.
- Facilitated election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward and ward levels enhancing coordination and service delivery.
