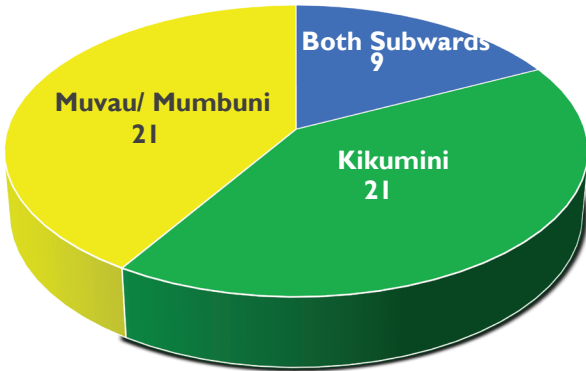
1.0 Introduction

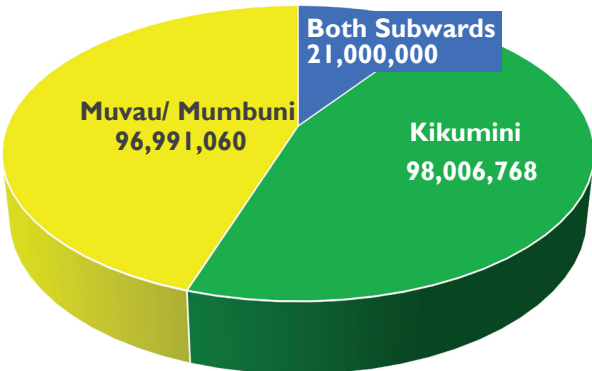

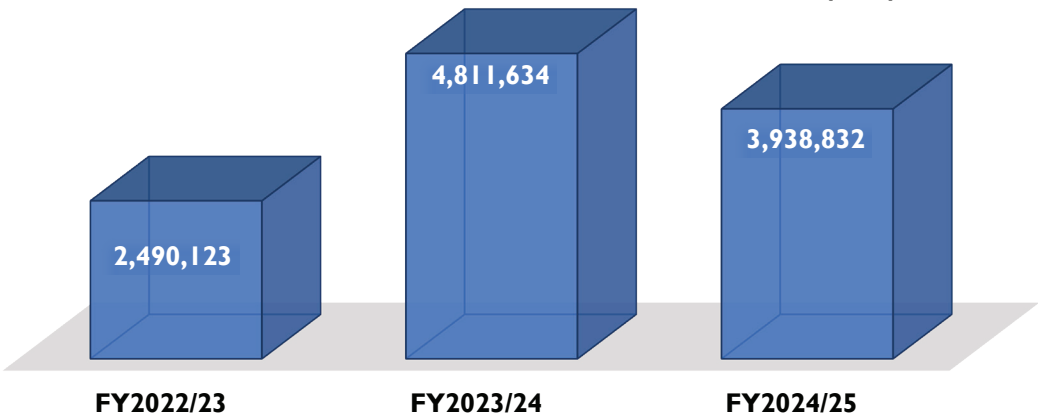
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

2.0 Achievements



Water Access and Environmental Conservation

The County Government has enhanced access and reduced distance to water points through the following interventions:

- Desilted Ndukuma earth dam restoring the reservoir storage capacity of 365,000 cubic meters and rehabilitated the existing pipeline reaching 3,500 households.
- Enhanced Kwa Malombe earth dam with a capacity of 5,500 cubic meters, serving approximately 160 households
- Constructed and distributed Thwake water project from Kwa Nguuta to Kwa Kasaka, benefiting approximately 500 households.
- Expanded the distribution network of ENI borehole which has a yield of 6.2m³/hr, serving Kwa Kathoka market, Kambi Mawe dispensary, and 3 learning institutions around Kwa Kathoka market.
- Solarization of Itaa borehole which has a yield of 14m³/hr, benefiting 300 households, 2 schools and 1 market.
- Drilled, equipped and distributed Kwa Mutemwa borehole with a yield of 5.5m³/hr, benefitting approximately 500 households
- Solarization and distribution of Kwa Mwenga borehole with a yield of 14 cubic meters/hr, benefiting approximately 200 households, Kivani and Muambani shopping centers
- Under environmental conservation, supported 5 community groups in establishing tree nursery enterprises

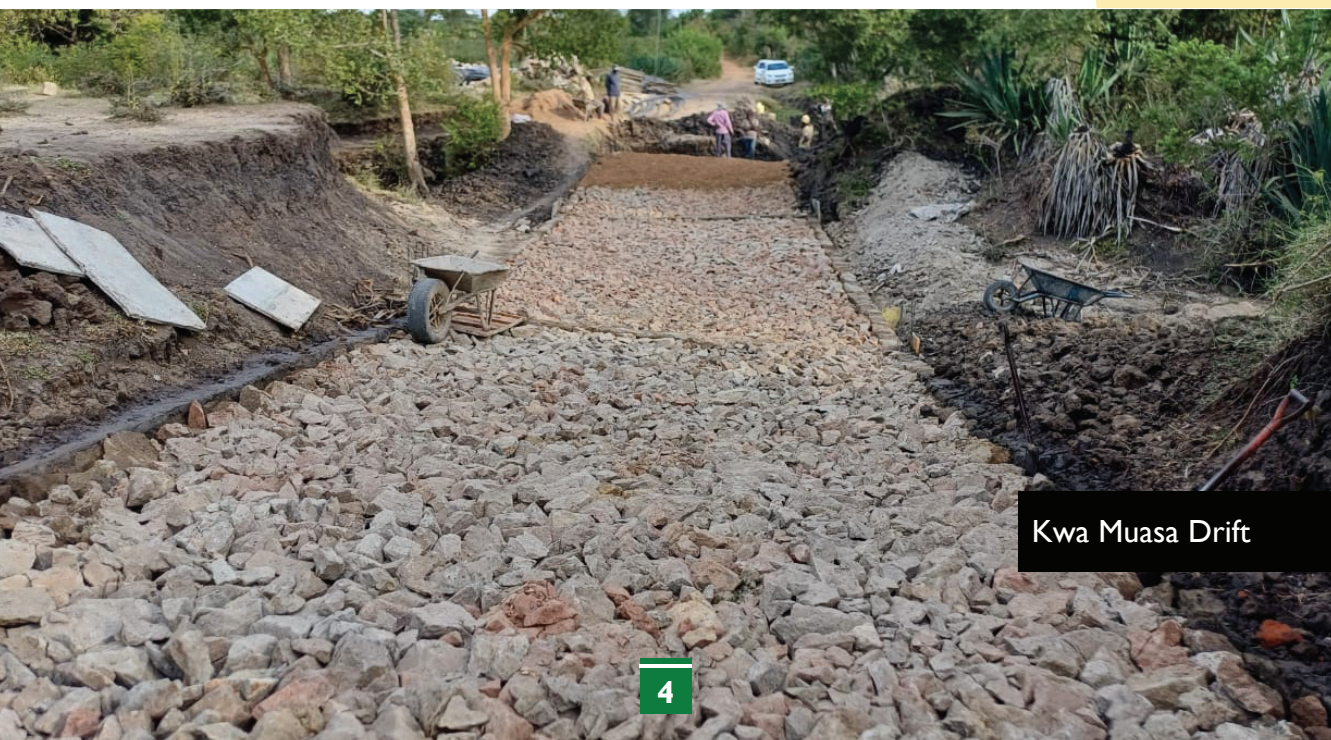




Road Access and Connectivity

The county government improved road network connectivity and electrification through the following interventions,

- Opened 25.5km, graded 203.4km and graveled 5.8km of roads, enhancing connectivity to markets across the ward and improving mobility for residents and traders.
- Installed 96m culverts and 13 gabions, ensuring roads remain passable during the rainy seasons.
- Constructed 596m³ of catch water mitre drains, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure and supporting improved agricultural production.
- Constructed Kwa Kateli and Mangauni drifts, connecting five institutions and 4 villages, thereby stimulating economic development in Kitonyoni, Sia and Kavingo shopping centres.
- Partnered with REREC to connect 76 households in Nyunzu village to electricity, enabling access to power for homes and businesses.
- Installed solar-powered high-mast floodlights at Kwa Kathoka, Kikumini and Sinai markets, improving security, extending business hours, and promoting the use of renewable energy use.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To boost food security, improve farmers' incomes, and encourage sustainable farming, the county government rolled out the following initiatives:

- Provided 1,912 farmers with green gram certified seed to enhance crop production and productivity. Additionally, Mapped, trained and issued farmers with fruit-fly control baits and solar bags, creating low pest zones.
- Promoted the dairy value chain by providing Artificial Insemination (AI) services to 115 farmers through cooperatives.
- Profiled 5,496 farmers, and facilitated the formation of Muvau-Kikumini ward-based SACCO, which benefitted from a Kshs 1,000,000 grant under NAVCDP.
- Vaccinated 1,726 cows and 982 goats against diseases
- Trained 60 learners across the county on dairy, poultry and horticulture value chain at ATC Kwa Kathoka.
- Drilled Kaseve borehole under KCEP-CRAL programme, providing a yield of 2m³/hr and serving approximately 240 households.
- Supported 49 groups with demonstration materials for farmer field school project, trained and sensitized to join SACCO under NARIGP

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed 5 ECDE centers namely; Kyaka, Kambi Mawe, Ndukuma, Kimuumo and Kithoni, providing conducive learning environment.
- Converted 24 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to quality early childhood education and improved livelihoods for teachers.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 24 ECDE centres, enhancing the quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved a 0.9% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,006 in 2022 to 1,015 in 2025.
- Supported 802 needy and bright students with bursaries, and full scholarships for six form one entrants, enhancing retention and transition in learning institutions.

Health Services

To enhance access to health care, the county government:

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities
- Constructed three new outpatient blocks at Kambi Mawe, Mumbuni, and Kikumini health centres, serving a combined catchment population of 8,753 people.
- Engaged 52 community health promoters to support the provision of primary healthcare services.
- Conducted two outreach campaigns: one on Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) at Kwa Kathoka and a medical outreach. These initiatives contributed to reduced maternal, infant, and child mortality, and improved health awareness.
- In Partnership with ENI, constructed a modern toilet and equipped the maternity block at Kambi Mawe dispensary

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Supported 22 persons with disabilities with assorted assistive mobility devices to promote self-reliance.
- Trained and issued tools of trade under Ujuzi teke teke apprenticeship programme to 17 youth (Tailoring kits 3, salon kits 3, Masonry kit 3, Barber kit 3, Welding 1, Carpentry 2, Plumbing 2).
- Benefited 108 elderly persons, representing 6.2% of the ward's elderly population of 1,755 through provision of food, non-food items and medical insurance subscription.
- Mapped and assessed 432 persons with disabilities to facilitate certification and enable access to essential services
- Facilitated 28 ward teams to participate in Ligi-Mashinani ward league games, enhancing sports development at grassroot level.

Public Sanitation

To improve public sanitation, the county government;

- Facilitated cleaning of 5 markets, improving waste management in markets.



Security of Land Tenure

To promote urban development, access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights the county government:

- Prepared Kwa Kathoka physical development plan, improving planning to boost local trade, create jobs, and support economic growth.
- Surveyed and beaconed the 58-acre Ndukuma dam site, planted trees along the riparian area to promote environmental conservation and ecosystem restoration.
- Conducted Legal advisory clinics focusing on land and succession matters, reaching 418 People. Through this programme, 100 households are expected to benefit from improved access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Established the ward sand management Committee, ensuring sustainable sand harvesting and conservation.
- Supported the organization and elections of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels strengthening governance at grassroots level
- Supported election of market committees responsible for the management of market activities
