

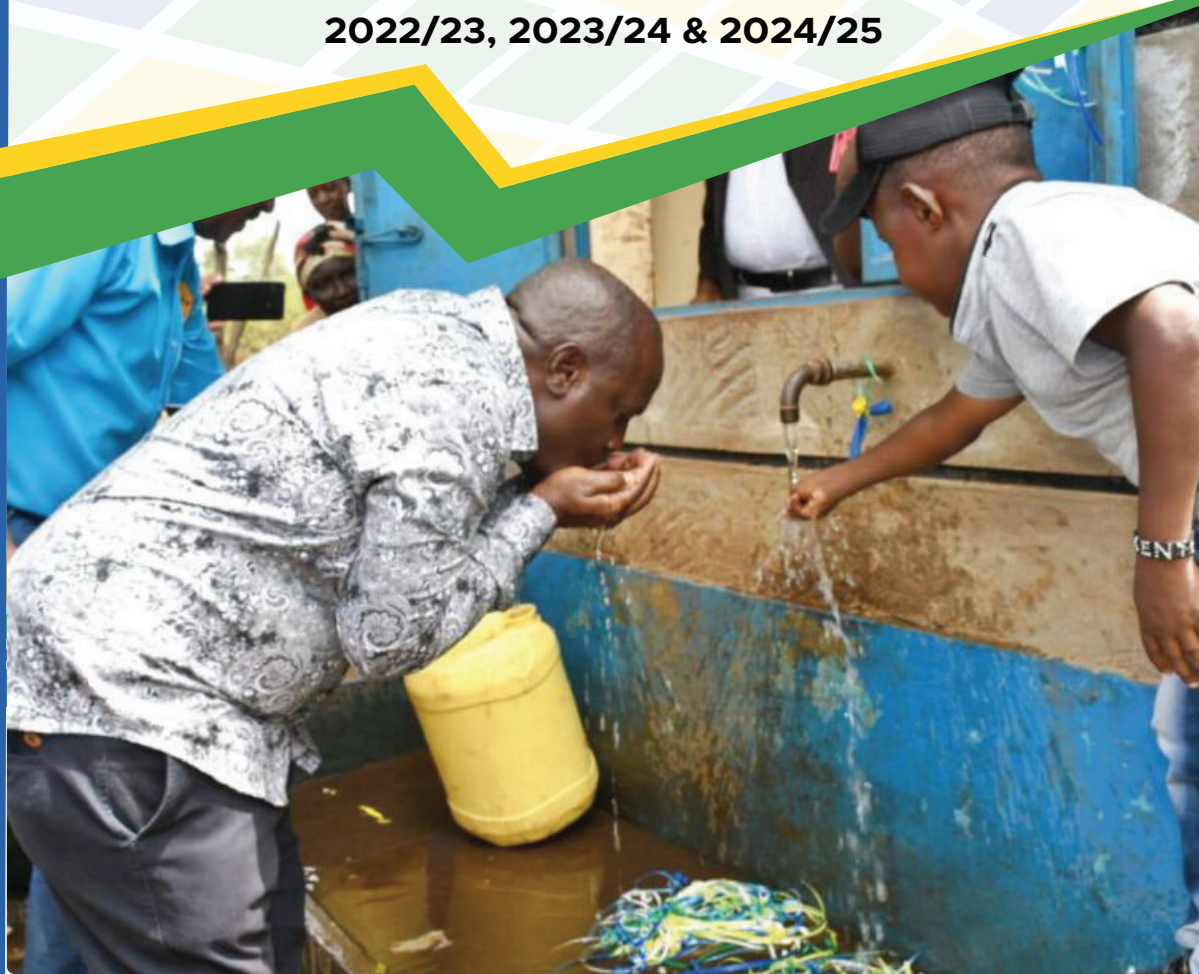

1.0 Introduction

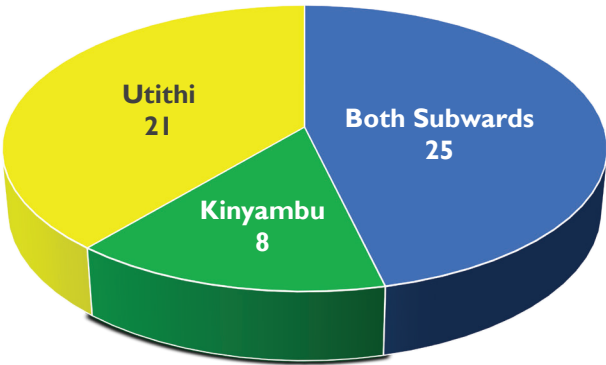

The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.

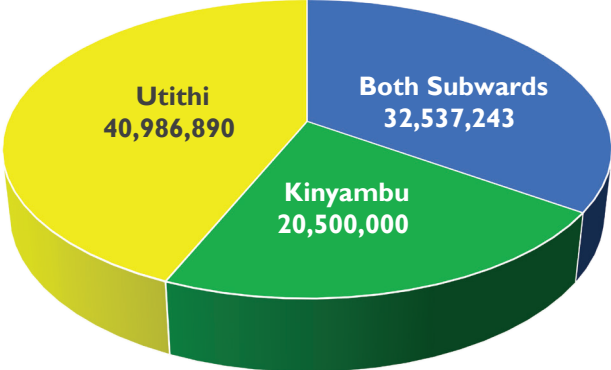

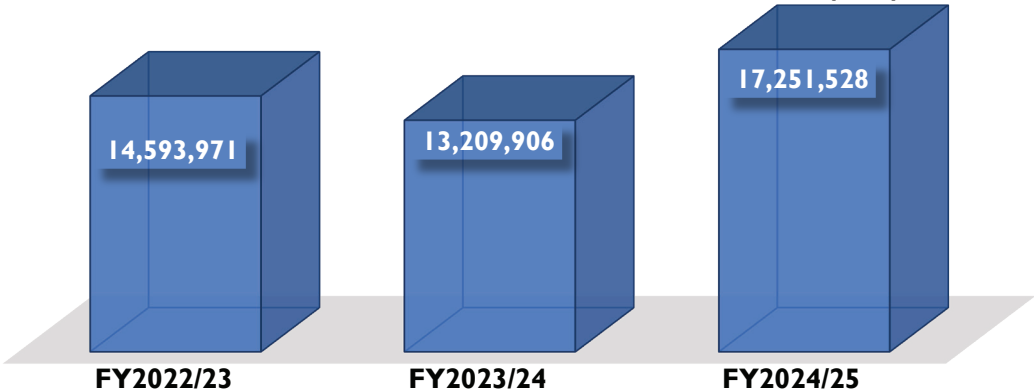
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

2.0 Achievements

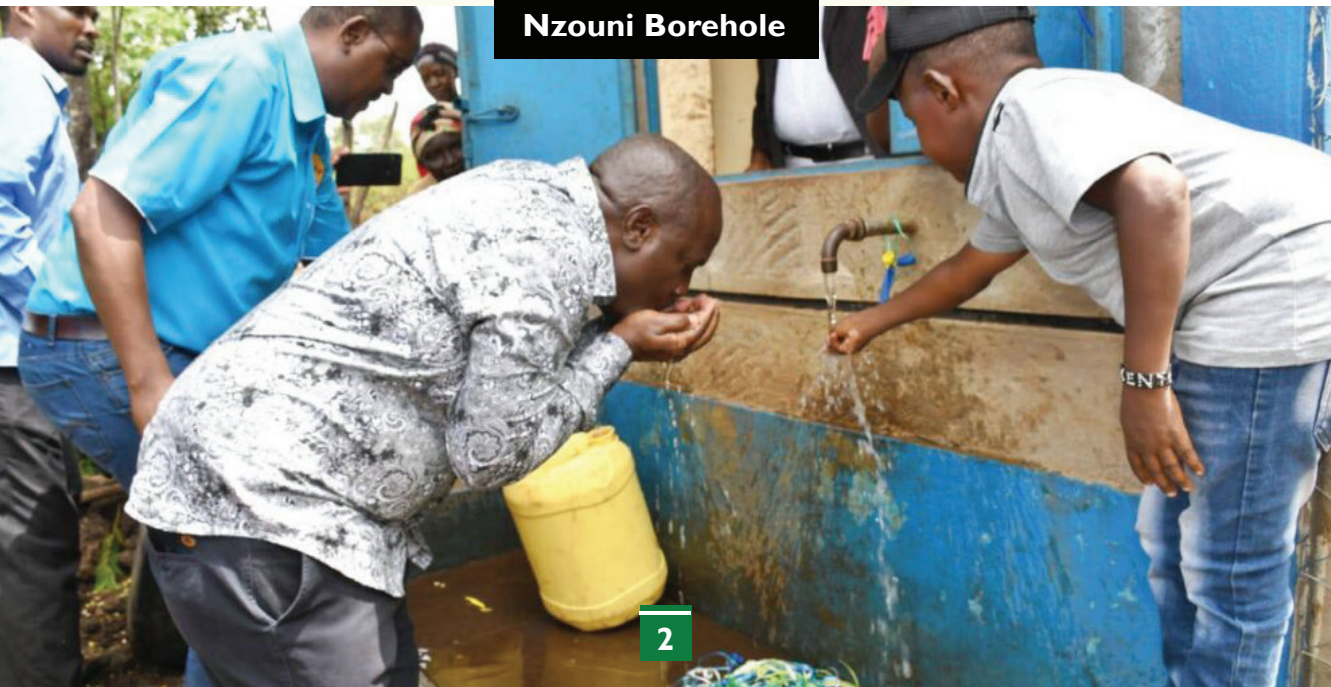


Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce the distance to reliable water sources, the County Government implemented the following interventions;

- Rehabilitated and solarized Ithayoni borehole which has a yield of $3.6\text{m}^3/\text{hr}$ with a pipeline extension of 5km, benefiting approximately 200 households.
- Distributed Mbulutini springs water project with a 4km pipeline extension, benefiting approximately 200 households.
- Enhanced Kikunduku borehole which has a yield of $5.6\text{m}^3/\text{hr}$ through installation of solar power and water storage tanks, improving water access for approximately 600 households.
- Drilled and equipped Nzouni borehole with a yield of $5.8\text{m}^3/\text{hr}$, benefiting approximately 60 households and Nzouni primary.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods, and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the County Government:

- Vaccinated 6,383 livestock and poultry against diseases, benefiting approximately 865 farmers.
- Supplied 58 Galla goats for breeding to 12 groups, improving goat breeds and enhancing livelihood.
- Distributed 2.464MT of certified green gram seeds to 1,232 farmers, helping cushion them against high farm input costs.
- Formed ward-based SACCO and awarded inclusion grant of Kshs. 1,000,000 to support farmers in saving and accessing credit.

Health Services

To enhance access to healthcare, the county government;

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Fenced and connected Ivoleni dispensary with electricity enhancing security and improving health services to the community.
- Upgraded Kibwezi Sub County Hospital through ground levelling, waste water management and equipping, enhancing service delivery to a catchment population of 29,611.
- Paid medical bills for vulnerable households, enhancing access to healthcare and easing the burden of high treatment costs.
- Conducted outreach campaigns for Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and medical outreach within the wards.
- Engaged 78 Community Health Promoters in offering primary health care.



Road Access and Connectivity

To improve road access and strengthen connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 29.5km of roads, graded 138 km and gravelled 30.5 km across the ward, improving accessibility to markets, institutions and villages.
- Installed drainage structures, including 198m of culverts and 10 gabion boxes, ensuring roads remained passable during the rainy season.
- Constructed a drift along Kwa Veneti road and installed 2 scour checks, enhancing mobility and road safety.
- Excavated 3,020m³ of cut-off mitre drains through the Community Driven Programme, transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure.
- Installed 13 solar floodlights at Kikunduku, Kyaani, Muusini, Kithasyu, Ngokolani, Kilungu, Kasasule, Maikuu, Ituumo kwa Luka, Kivoleni, Matulani, Yumbuni and Utithi markets to improve security in the shopping centres.
- Connected 180 households with electricity in Usalama market, improving living standards and boosting local economic activities by enabling access to power for homes and businesses.

Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed new classrooms for four (4) ECDE centres (Ngokolani, Nzouni, Thange and Kithasyu ECDE centers), providing a conducive learning environment.
- Converted 23 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable status, ensuring consistent access to early childhood education and improving their livelihoods.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 37 ECDE centers enhancing quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved a 3.9% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,377 in 2022 to 1,431 in 2025, following the ward's ECDE interventions.
- Supported 976 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 Form One entrants, improving retention and transition in learning institutions.
- Improved access to vocational training by equipping Kiumoni CTTI.

Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Supported 16 organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs for social and economic empowerment.
- Supported 199 young people under youth empowerment programme (45 in driving course training, 132 in Ajira Kwa Vijana programme and 22 under ujuzi teteteke)
- Provided food and non-food items alongside medical insurance subscription to 113 elderly persons, benefiting 5.4% of the ward's elderly population of 2,085.
- Organized safe spaces forum benefitting 184 school-going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention.
- Facilitated 44 ward teams to participate in “ligi mashinani” ward league games and provided sports items, enhancing sports development at grassroot level.
- Constructed Kyaani bodaboda shed protecting motorcycle operators from harsh weather conditions.
- Mapped and assessed 470 persons with disabilities to acquire certificates and enable them access essential services.

Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Facilitated the election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels, strengthening coordination, citizen engagement, and service delivery.



Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation and provide a conducive trading environment, the county government;

- Constructed public toilets in Kyaani market, Ngokolani market, and Kithasyu Library.
- Carried out cleaning across 27 markets, improving hygiene and overall market conditions.
