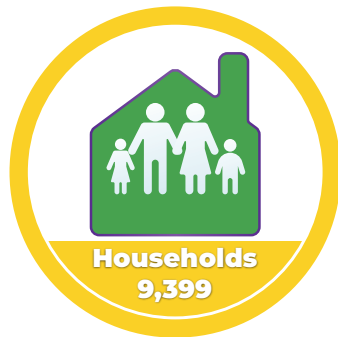

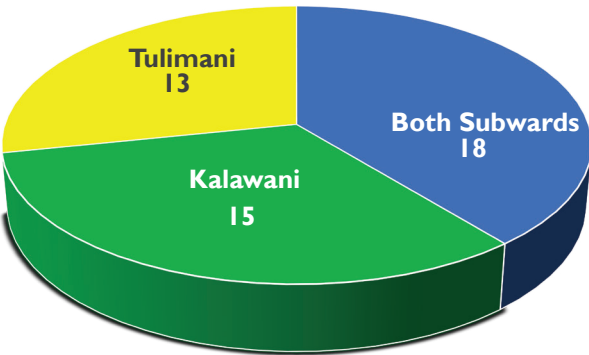
1.0 Introduction

It documents government interventions aligned with citizens’ development priorities, promoting transparency, accountability, and informed decision-making. The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.

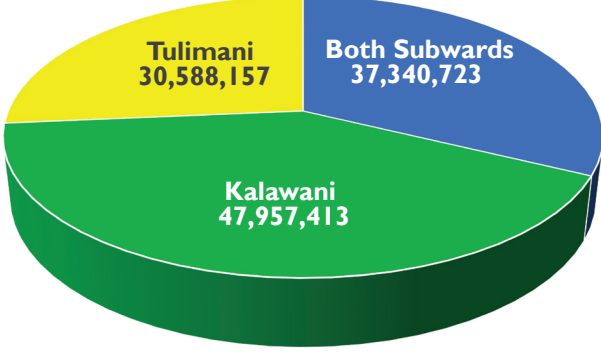

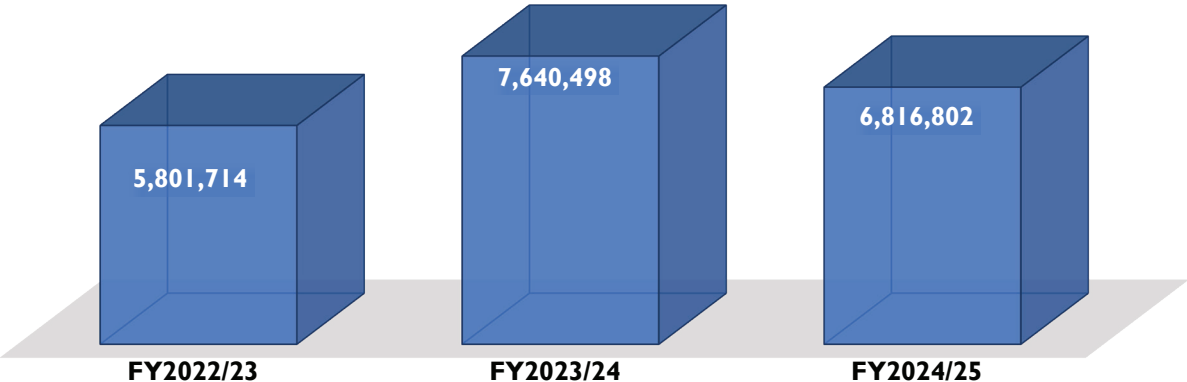
No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance access and reduce distance to water points, the county government:

- Constructed 7.2km distribution pipeline of Ikokani water project supplying water to 600 households, 3 schools, and 2 markets.
- Constructed Masyonyeki earth dam which has a reservoir storage capacity of 15,000 cubic meters, benefitting over 300 households.
- Desilted Kooi earth dam, benefitting approximately 280 households.
- Rehabilitated Kakima pipeline along Upper Ngwani Water Project benefitting approximately 400 households.
- Rehabilitated Lower Ngwani Water Project pumping system and Wanzauni-Kikima pipeline system, benefitting approximately 250 households.

Road Access and Connectivity

To increase road access and connectivity, the county government:

- Opened 20km and graded 151km of roads, enhancing access and connectivity within the ward.
- Installed 234m of culverts and 143 gabions which rendered the roads passable during the rainy season.
- Constructed four drifts across the ward: Ithitu-itetani road, Kyaviti and Ngwani drift connecting institutions, markets and villages.
- Excavated 5,982m³ of cut-off mitre drains, transforming roads into climate resilient infrastructure and improving agricultural production.
- Connected 147 households in Makuu village, Ivuvuka village and Mulooni primary with electricity through REREC matching grant to increase reliable and safe access to electricity.
- Installed 6 streetlights and 4 grid-powered floodlights at Iiani, Itetani, Wanzauni and Mavindu markets to enhance security, improve visibility, and support social and economic activities.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions:

- Distributed 1.798 metric tonnes of certified seed to 899 beneficiaries to boost legume production and improve household nutrition and income.
- Vaccinated 7,116 livestock, poultry and dogs against pests and diseases, benefiting 1,268 farmers for improved production.
- Distributed mango and avocado seedlings to 800 farmers, aimed at boosting fruit production and diversifying income sources.
- Supported 52 groups in tomato, mango and poultry value chains and provided agricultural equipment such as incubators, water tanks, generators and water pumps under NARIGP.
- Supported 41 groups through KCEP CRAL with subsidized farm inputs such as fertilizers and certified seed, benefiting 2,000 households. This has enhanced food security and strengthened resilience to climate change.
- Excavated four farm ponds and supported Kayamba group with a feed formulation mill.
- Constructed honey refinery factory to promote honey value addition in partnership with SIVAP.
- Distributed pasture seed to 30 farmers in collaboration with Master Card Foundation and FAO.
- Formed ward-based SACCO that was awarded an inclusion grant of Kshs 1,000,000 to support its operations.

Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare, the county Government:

- Constructed Uvaani staff house to ensure uninterrupted healthcare services for a catchment population of 1,614.
- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Engaged 147 Community Health Promoters (CHPs) in the provision of primary health care across the ward.



Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed classrooms in three ECDE centers i.e Wambuli, Kathokani and Kiatineni, providing a conducive learning environment.
- Converted 32 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms, ensuring consistent access to education.
- Distributed teaching and learning materials to 43 ECDE centres enhancing access to quality education.
- Supported 1,095 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to six (6) form one entrants, enhancing retention and transition to higher learning institutions.
- Equipped Wambuli and AIC Tulimani Vocational Training Centres with essential training tools to enhance skills development.

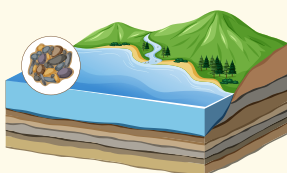




Public Sanitation

To improve public sanitation and create employment opportunities, the county government;

- Engaged 24 cleaners in market cleaning and waste management across 10 markets.



Mineral Prospecting

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Carried out geological mineral mapping in the ward identifying slates deposits of Tremolite in Ng'ele which are commercially and economically viable.



Governance

To strengthen governance and participation at the ward level, the government;

- Established ward sand management committee, ensuring sustainable sand conservation and utilization.
- Supported the organization and elections of development committees at the village, cluster, sub-ward, and ward levels strengthening governance at grassroots level.
- Supported election of market committees responsible for the management of market activities



Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government:

- Trained a total of 90 youth on driving course and issued with licenses enabling them to acquire transport related job opportunities.
- Supported 20 organized groups each with a 100-seater tent and chairs to start income generating activities.
- supported 113 elderly individuals with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscription for healthcare access, benefiting 3.6% of the ward's elderly population of 3,150.
- Issued dignity packs to 175 pupils supporting menstrual management for girls and promoting personal hygiene for all learners.
- Facilitated 39 ward teams to participate in Ligi Mashinani ward leagues and provided sports items, promoting sports development at grassroot level.
- Facilitated 1,650 individuals to acquire birth and death certificates to enable them access government services.

Security of Land Tenure

To enhance access to justice and safeguard inheritance rights, the county government:

- Conducted Legal advisory clinics, focusing on land and succession matters reaching 310 People. 50 households are expected to benefit from the program promoting access to justice and peaceful resolution of inheritance disputes.
