



1.0 Introduction



The profile provides a detailed record of projects implemented in each ward, including budget allocations, locations, implementation status, and the resulting community impact.




No of Projects for FY2022/23, FY2023/24 and FY2024/25

Water Access and Environmental Conservation

To enhance water access and reduce distance to water sources, the county government:

- Drilled and equipped 2 boreholes: Kilala borehole and Kyambalasi borehole with a yield of 1.7m³/hr and 24m³/hr respectively, serving approximately 400 households.
- Solarized Ithanzeni borehole which has a yield of 24m³/hr and distributed water through a 2.5km pipeline, benefitting approximately 800 households.
- Constructed Miting'ani sand dam, 100m³ sump tank, 50m³ reservoir tank, solarization and distribution of water through pipeline, benefiting 4000 people. This has been supported through Financing Locally-Led Climate Action programme.
- Enhanced Kyengeethe Water project through construction of a 100m³ sump tank, solarization and 1.5km of pipeline extension, serving approximately 500 households.
- Drilled and distributed Kithamba borehole with a yield of 17m³/hr benefiting 4,000 households.
- Solarized Itenge water project and constructed 2.5km of distribution pipeline extending to Makongo, Kyambalasi and Kilolo, benefiting approximately 300 households.

Road Access and Connectivity

To improve road access and strengthen connectivity, the county government;

- Opened 16km of roads, graded 171km and graveled 8.5km, improving accessibility across the ward.
- Installed drainage structures including 197 m of culverts, 54 gabions and 101 scour checks, ensuring roads remained passable during the rainy season.
- Constructed five drifts, including Nzouni, Mutambukoni, Kaumoni and Thangathi drifts, enhancing mobility and linking wards.
- Excavated 2,240m³ of cut-off mitre drains through the Miradi Kwa Jamii Programme, creating job opportunities for 200 community members while transforming roads into climate-resilient infrastructure and supporting improved agricultural production.
- Connected 215 households around Ukia Diary, Kinyongo West and Iuani cluster with electricity through REREC matching grant, improving living standards and stimulating local economic activities.
- Installed floodlights at Ikalyoni and Kyau market to enhance security, benefitting 500 traders.
- Installed 20-meter solar-powered high-mast floodlights in 6 markets, improving security, and business activities while promoting renewable energy.

Agricultural Production and Productivity

To enhance food security, improve farmer livelihoods and promote sustainable agricultural practices, the county government implemented the following interventions;

- Vaccinated a total of 11,092 livestock, including 3,449 against CCPP, 2,643 against Foot and Mouth Disease, 4,076 against LSD, and 924 against rabies, benefiting approximately 4,423 farmers.
- Distributed 500 bags of certified maize & beans seed to 500 beneficiaries.
- Distributed 21,500 certified Hass avocado scions for grafting, and provided extension services benefiting over 1,745 households.
- Promoted water harvesting for irrigation through excavation of 42 farm ponds, benefitting 60 households.
- Rehabilitated Kyamea water project under SIVAP enhancing water access for irrigation for 212 households.
- Formation of Ukia Ward Farmers' SACCO with an inclusion grant of one million shillings under NAVCDP



Access to Education

To enhance access to quality education and training, the county government;

- Constructed Kisungii and Mumbuni ECDE classrooms providing conducive learning environment.
- Converted 46 ECDE teachers to permanent and pensionable terms ensuring consistent access to education and improved livelihood.
- Provided teaching and learning materials to 50 ECDE centers to enhance the quality of early childhood education.
- Achieved a 13.3% increase in ECDE enrolment, rising from 1,659 in 2022 to 1,880 in 2025.
- Supported 1,074 needy students with bursaries and awarded full scholarships to 6 form one entrants, enhancing transition and retention in learning institutions.
- Equipped Ukaatuni Vocational Training Centre with training tools, enhancing practical skills training.
- Provided capitation to three Vocational Training Centres namely Ukia, Kyuasini and Ukaatuni.

Health Services

To enhance and increase access to essential primary healthcare, the county government;

- Distributed essential commodities and medical supplies to various health facilities.
- Constructed staff houses at Kyuasini health center, Nzouni and Nthangu dispensaries ensuring uninterrupted service delivery to the community.
- Conducted two medical outreach campaigns targeting Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) within the ward.
- Engaged 126 Community Health Promoters in provision of primary health care.
- Upgraded Kilala health centre through construction of an outpatient block serving a catchment population of 5,000.





Social Protection and Youth Empowerment

To improve the well-being and livelihood of the vulnerable population, the county government;

- Provided assistive mobility devices to 22 persons with disabilities to enhance self-reliance.
- Issued chairs to 12 organized groups for socio-economic empowerment.
- Supported 115 elderly persons with food, non-food items and medical insurance subscriptions for healthcare access, benefiting 3.9% of the ward's elderly population of 2,921.
- Supported 2 PWD institutions (Makongo and Kaumoni) with foodstuffs benefitting 85 persons.
- Organized safe spaces forums benefitting 76 school going children to identify key protection concerns for targeted follow-up and intervention.
- Facilitated 49 ward teams in various disciplines to participate in ward league games enhancing sports development at grassroot level.
- Levelled Kwa Kamoli playground to provide conducive space for sporting activities.



Governance

To strengthen coordination, citizen engagement, and overall service delivery, the government;

- Facilitated election of development committees at village, cluster, sub-ward and ward levels.
- Initiated formation of Ward Climate Change Planning Committees for enhanced coordination, planning, and implementation of locally-led climate actions at the ward level.



Urban Development & Public Sanitation

To enhance sanitation and provide a conducive trading environment, the county government;

- Operationalized Mukuyuni Business Hub, expected to spur business and income generation.
- Renovated Mukuyuni green grocer market, enhancing trade operations and benefiting 150 market operators.
- Promoted public sanitation through market cleaning and waste collection in six markets across the ward.
